Earthquake Aftermath

When the great earthquake of September 1, 1923 had destroyed a large part of Tokyo and we had no Missionary to do our part of the rebuilding, and since we had an unusually large number of new Missionary in Fukuoka since 1921, it seemed to Maggie Lee and me that we ought as a Mission, to do something in Tokyo, we volunteered to spend a year in Tokyo—summer of 1924 to the summer of 1925. We built for the Mission a dormitory for students.
