

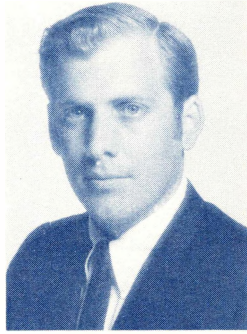
## CONFERENCE LEADER

A political science and law degree graduate of the University of Texas, Mr. Strickland has co-authored the book *How to Fight the Drug Menace*, and is a contributor to two other books, *Politics: A Guidebook for Christians* and *Invitation to Dialogue: The Professional World*.

Strickland, as a lay person, attended Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary and is a member of the American, Texas, and Dallas bar associations and of the Academy of Political Science. He was assistant to a former Texas Lieutenant Governor.
