1 FRIDAY

Got up started fire. Edmund & Helen gave father present also Maude gave me a nice present in mother. The Wellinghams were still with us. We had a happy day. It was my 36 ~~year~~ birthday. We visited the Mills for a few minutes. But the main part of the day was spent quietly.

2 SATURDAY

Woke at 7 am. Took cold bath. Dress Read Bible. Breakfast. Went to tell Herbert Walde goodbye. Spent the rest of the morning in reading & think of talk for prayer service. Took nap after dinner. Shmoe Sam called. We called on Moris. Went to see Mrs. Walne. Ate supper. Wrote letters. Read part of Robert's life. Have been very sleepy all day.

3 SUNDAY

2 AFTER CHRISTMAS

Rose early. Went to Sunday school & Church. Had a good services. Came home. Mrs. Walne & T. J. took dinner with us. After dinner I took a nap & read part of Robert E. Lee's life. Did not eat supper. Had my class of young men as usual at Church. Had a good service afterwards. Crowd not so large as usual.

4 MONDAY

Read Bible. Ate breakfast. Cleaned stove pipe. Worked on talk for prayer service Wednesday night. Mrs. Mills called to ask me about writing an account of the memorial services held in our home for Dr. Wellingham. Wrote it. Young men called & told him of Christ. Ate dinner. Went to y. men's meeting. Came back ate supper. Went to noon prayer service. Packaged for Mrs.

5 TUESDAY

Read Bible. Ate breakfast.  
Change my book case &  
desk. Studied on a talk  
for tomorrow night after  
dinner. Ate part of life of  
R. E. Lee. Had attacks of indigestion  
caused by eating  
meat. Took a walk. Came  
home & rested. Went to the  
evening prayer meeting at  
the First Methodist Church. There  
came the meeting to break  
up. Came home took a dose of oil.

6 WEDNESDAY

Spent Morning in Bible  
Study & on prayer meet-  
ing talk. Ate dinner  
till 3 P.M. studied on  
prayer meeting talk.  
Received letter from Dr.  
A. B. Ray authorizing us in  
starting the Boys' School.  
Will have to get busy. Went  
to tea at Methodist Girls School.  
Came back home & went to  
prayer service. Had house  
full. Good meetings.

7 THURSDAY

Spent the morning in  
Bible Study & working  
on sermon. Calling  
Studied on sermon  
in afternoon. Wrote letter  
in morning also.  
Went to prayer meeting  
at night. Much rain but  
good crowds.  
Have given much time  
to silent prayer about  
the Boys' School for which  
we have gotten permission's.

8 FRIDAY

Spent the morning in  
discussion the Boys' School  
with Kawakatsu & son.  
Afternoon spent  
in shopping and in  
studying on sermon.  
Went to prayer meeting  
at Congregational Church.  
Had fine crowd & good  
talk & good prayers.

9 SATURDAY

Spent the morning & a good portion of after-noon in preparation of sermon for Sunday. Took a walk out in the mountains to see the grave of Shimozé Sais children. Came home read a little & went to prayer meeting. This has been the best week of prayer I have known since coming to Japan.

10 SUNDAY

1 AFTER EPIPHANY

Preached sermon on Christ & prayer. Had freedom of expression. Christ went with me to church. Good crowd at services. The people listened with interest. After dinner wrote letters & rest. Went to church taught class. Rowe came.

11 MONDAY

Spent the day till P. M. discussing with Committee plans for boys school. P. M. Took train for Kokura. From 8 till 11:30 spent in talking to two members of Moji Church about union church. They desire to have us quit work in field of labor & get the union church.

12 TUESDAY

Continuation of discussion of last night. Com. went to see the pastor of Moji Church. He is opposed to our union proposition. We had a long talk. Spent after-noon & night at Shimozé with the Rays. A full day. Many very big problems to settle. We pray God to bless.

13 WEDNESDAY.

Was at Rays for breakfast.  
After breakfast in driving  
snow with Ray & Rowe.  
Went to Station to meet Walne.  
Had wait hour before ferry  
would cross. Got to Wittingham's  
house about 1 P.M. Had discussion  
of Walne's plans. After dinner  
took up question of opening boy  
school this April. Both groups of  
positions from two members of  
the mission that we decided  
to wait another year in order

14 THURSDAY

to have more time.  
Reached home late Wed. night.  
Thurs. Spent in discussion of  
plans with Japanese. They wish  
an early opening. Spent the  
after noon in reading &  
thinking quietly of plans  
for future. Wrote three letters.  
Went to musical at night  
given by Methodist Mission  
basis for King sufferers.  
Good concert. Fair ground  
dispute weather

at night over 30 men present

January

I refused to act for reconsideration  
at 5 P.M. FRIDAY

Spent the morning in Bible  
study & going to the bank &  
in a short visit to Goto  
& Co. After dinner called  
to see Mr. Scott of Nagasaki  
School to discuss the school  
question. Found his ideas were  
like mine. Wittingham called  
for me. He came to offer to have  
a reconsideration of school  
question if I go desired. Spent  
the day with him & Walne & Co.  
High school began new session

16 SATURDAY

~~Later~~ Spent morning  
in talking to my teacher  
about Boy's School plans.  
Wrote letter or two about  
to see Mr. Walne.  
After-dinner went to the  
Sunday School lectures.  
Took supper with the  
speakers. Went to the  
Sunday school lectures.  
Five meetings.

January

All the meetings have  
been fine,

17 SUNDAY

2 AFTER EPIPHANY

Went to S.S. and Church.  
Mr. Mito, a S.S. worker, preached  
for us. Mr. Aoki sang for us.  
Took dinner with them at  
the pastors. Went to S.S. mass  
meeting at 2 P.M. House full  
of children. Good speeches.  
Had the three speakers & the  
pastor for supper. At night went  
to union service at Methodist  
Church. Mr. Kurazumi & Mr. Mito  
spoke. Mr. Aoki sang fine service.

18 MONDAY

Read Bible had my  
usual devotions. Ate  
breakfast. Wrote card.  
Read morning mail. Went  
to enquire about land for  
boys' school in case we  
should change. Spent after-  
noon in reading & medi-  
tation.  
Went to night school after  
supper. Taught two hours.  
Only five men present.

January

19 TUESDAY

After breakfast seal estate  
agent called. While talk-  
ing to him, note came  
from Mrs. Walne calling  
me to see Mr. Walne. Had to  
go to Court House on business.  
Sent telegram to Rowe.  
After luncheon went in search  
of suitable house for S.S. at  
Dippo. Where I got from  
the barber was here  
for consultation. Wrote letters  
& postals. Went to night school  
for 3 hours.

20 WEDNESDAY

Read my Bible & had  
prayer. Prayer before  
breakfast. After breakfast  
went to see Got. San then  
to Court House. Took dinner  
with The Mills. Had a con-  
sultation about station.  
Went to see Got. San who is  
rich. Went to prayer  
meeting. Had consultation  
with pastor. and Igawa  
San.

21 THURSDAY

Read Bible & devotions after breakfast called to see how Goto San was. Came home to study but pastor called & then also their man. After dinner went to look after land for boy's school. Came home read 2 lbs of Bee & Slater's Images Christi. Mrs. W. called. Taught three hours in the night school. Fine crowd of men. Chapel full. Got to bed about 11 P.M.

22 FRIDAY

Read Bible & Prayed. Spent good part of morning reading Japanese. After dinner went out for a walk & looked for land suitable for school. Read part of Robert's life. Taught in Night School. Read Bee's life.

23 SATURDAY

Read Bible & had devotions at breakfast. Studied on talk for to-night. After dinner went for a short walk & called on Goto San. Came home finished my talk for the dedication services of the yochien. Taketa San called to over land proposition. Went to church meeting and dedication services.

24 SUNDAY

PETER EPHRAIM  
After breakfast went to Kurume where I preached. Came home at 2:20 P.M. Had call. Wrote my mother. Went to English meeting at the church. Stayed for preaching service.

25 MONDAY

Read Bible + Devotion  
 After breakfast went  
 to see the Army officer  
 in charge of prisoners  
 about one of the prisoners  
 wives coming to see her  
 husband. After dinner  
 went to mills for soap. <sup>Round</sup>  
 came we talked tonight  
 in night school. Talked to  
 Rowell late.

26 TUESDAY

Spent day in committee  
 meeting + Mission Meet-  
 ing. <sup>Decided</sup> to ask Board  
 to let us sell Dainyo  
 Mahi property of a like-  
 ble land could be found  
 elsewhere at one third  
 price of present school  
 land. Had committee  
 meeting at night  
 after looking through W.S.

27 WEDNESDAY

Spent the morning in  
 committee meeting +  
 framing a letter to  
 the Board. Went to train  
 with Rowe Ray + Wallingford  
 Came back by the Walmes  
 they were nicely packed  
 with view of going to  
 Tokyo. Went to prayer  
 meeting + far well meet-  
 ing for the Walmes.

28 THURSDAY

The Walmes spent the night  
 with us. After breakfast  
 talked with the teacher +  
 went to bank + kaimono  
 after dinner went to train to  
 see Walmes off for Tokyo.  
 Regret seeing off our teacher.  
 Came home + went over  
 our present house with  
 land lord. Went to Walmes  
 to see about repairs. Did  
 in night school. Will move  
 to Dainyo Mahi.

29 FRIDAY

Spent good portion of day talking to the Carpenter about repairs on Darrings Machin house. Was not but all well, the weather is cold. Taught in Night School.

30 SATURDAY

Bible & devotions  
Went to Darrings Machin house to talk to Carpenter also down town to buy mallets, and then to the Electric Company and after dinner went to Darrings Machin house & then to Jiggs to look at a house at S.B. there

31 SEPTUAGESIMA SUNDAY

Was unwell Saturday but did not stop going. Went to station to take train for Krumme but was too late. Came back to church here. In talking to Mills about young lady playing organ for the English meeting got provoked. Lost my temper, sorry after dinner took cut-throat sick lady. Wrote letters. Went to English meeting & stayed to church.

1 FEB MONDAY

After devotions  
Went to 10  
Darrings Machin  
to over see  
repairs on  
house before  
morning in  
taught in night  
& school

February

1915

2 TUESDAY

Devotions

Spent day as  
I did yesterday  
overseeing repairs  
Went to hear <sup>Rev.</sup> D. Ebyne  
at night. Took Night  
School pupils with  
me.

3 WEDNESDAY

Again over saw  
repairs work.  
Pulling in electric  
lights  
Went to Union  
Prayer Meeting

February

4 THURSDAY

Spent day over-  
seeing workmen.  
Taught 3 hrs. in  
Night School.

5 FRIDAY

Over saw Repairs.  
Taught one  
hour in Night  
School.

6 SATURDAY

After devotional  
 went to over-see  
 the carpenters.  
 Spent the watching  
 carpenters, talamaya  
 San Plasterers.  
 Painter etc.  
 Went to young men's  
 meeting at night.

7 SEXAGESIMA SUNDAY

Spent the day at home  
 as I was left by the  
 train. Went to services  
 both morning & night  
 taught English class  
 as usual at night.

8 MONDAY

Began moving to  
 105 Dainyo Maghi  
 after dinner. The car-  
 penters & plasterers  
 & painters were at,  
 the house working.  
 Taught in house  
 in night school.

9 TUESDAY

Finished moving  
 our furniture  
 from Yoha no cho to  
 Dainyo Maghi.  
 Paid landlord three  
 months' rent as  
 we left without giving  
 him notice.  
 Taught three hours  
 in night school.

10 WEDNESDAY

Spent the day watching  
carpenters, plasterers  
and workmen & in  
straightening out  
furniture. Have  
found it very tiresome.  
Went to prayer-meeting  
as usual to night.

11 THURSDAY

Day spent about  
as yesterday over-  
saw workmen  
to do it is holiday  
so did not have  
to go to school to-  
night. Spent most of day  
visiting Gov. Mayor, Judge

then for  
lawyer about  
my case

12 FRIDAY

Again spent my  
time helping  
arrange furniture  
and overseeing  
workmen.  
Taught one hour  
in night school.

13 SATURDAY

Finally got part  
of the house finished  
& furniture straighten-  
ed out. Will get  
all finished by  
Monday night.  
~~Worked till late~~ called  
to night to see three men  
to ask them to come to court

Went down  
to court

14 QUINQUAGESIMA SUNDAY

Went to Sunday School  
and Church services  
Spent the after-noon  
quietly at home  
at night Mr. Mills  
gave his illustrated  
life of Christ with negro  
tales.

15 MONDAY

Spent the day busily  
getting ready for the  
Dr. Shaelter Matthews  
who is to speak here  
tomorrow. Have been  
very busy.  
Taught one hour  
in night school.

16 SHROVE TUESDAY

After reading Bible  
& devotions went shop-  
ping. The Wellingshires  
called. Dr. Shaelter Matthews  
& Dr. Chiba came on Express  
train. Spent after-noon  
at meeting for Dr. Matthews.  
Gov. Judge D. J. Mayor. Several  
others took dinner at  
out house with Dr. Matthews.  
He spoke to about 1000 or more  
people at night at City Hall.

17 ASH WEDNESDAY

After breakfast went  
to train with Dr. Matthews.  
Came home went back to  
town for meat. Read to  
slaves. The Wellingshires  
& Mrs. Ray came for dinner.  
After dinner went to the  
station with them.  
Came back by train.  
Wanted cooking class  
gone. I took up meat  
travels. Went to prayer  
meeting at night.

18 THURSDAY

Spent the day in writing letters + entertaining callers. At night I taught three hours in night school. Had letter from home telling of my brother's baby's birth.

19 FRIDAY

Spent the morning in hanging pictures in my study. + in reading. After dinner worked on sermon for a while + then took my tools + did several needed things around house. Taught one hour in night school.

20 SATURDAY

Spent the <sup>morning</sup> day in study and working on sermon. After dinner read + worked in yard + garden some. Was glad to have one night at home as I am usually away.

21 SUNDAY

IN LENT

Went to Kierume in the morning. Only three at service because of examinations in school. Got home about 3 P.M. Wrote mother. Had callers. Went to Bible class but only one came on account of examinations at school. Good crowd at church.

22 MONDAY

Worked in my study all morning after taking Helen to see the doctor. Wrote letters & tried to get up with my overdue letters. I have been too busy to write recently. Taught one hour in night school.

23 TUESDAY

Spent the morning in study of Japanese. It has rained all day practically. Wrote two letters after dinner. Home mail came. Dr. Kuniyaga called to ask me to teach in his dental college. Taught 3 hrs. in night school.

24 WEDNESDAY

Study Bible & had devotions & then spent morning working on sermon. After dinner went to call on Governor's wife to express sympathy on death of his mother. Came back by the Bulls. Taught the Babbers at my home. Prayer meeting not our home at night.

25 THURSDAY

It rained all the morning. Spent morning in study. After dinner Goto Sae called. Then had an evening experience with a drunk man who has called frequently. Finally called policeman. Worked in flower garden. Taught ~~three~~ three hours in night school.

26 FRIDAY

Bible + Devotion  
& daily paper

Spent the morning in study as usual. After dinner went to the gas company to see about a stove. Came home took a nap. After which thought on sermon topic. Taught the banker again today. Dr. Kubo called. Taught an hour in U.S.

27 SATURDAY

Bible, Devotion  
& daily paper

Spent morning in study of Japanese. After dinner went to hear Salvation Army officer speak.

Fourth year men & night school teachers were with us for the evening.

28 SUNDAY

2 IN LENT

Very stormy. High wind & snow. Children & I went to church. After dinner wrote letters. Went to church at night 17 present. High wind & snow.

MARCH MONDAY

wrote letters

Weather moderated some. Spent the day in reading & dickering with a man over trees. He sold for about half what he asked, at first. Taught in night school. Went to pastor's conference after dinner.
