Took Helen to doctor. Came home and wrote postal cards in answer to Nees years greetings. After dinner continued to write till three P.M. Went to Millers & Joneses for visit. Came home, wrote cards to Rowe and Wellingham. Went to prayer meeting. Came home. Wrote card to Miller & Co.

4 Tues. Read Bible & had devotion.

Went to Bank & then to Kencho to see about getting permission to open our boys school. After dinner had callers and went to musical at the Jones. Went to church at night.

5 Wed. Read Bible had devotions

Went to Kawakatanami before breakfast. Went to train to get to Chofu but missed it. Am train came home read caught 10:55 AM train. Reached Koiwai about 11:30. Talked to Wellingham & then went to Shinjima-zaeki & from bank to Chofu to see Mr. Inagawa. Saw about becoming one of our teachers. He again spent night on train. Reached Koiwai at 6

6 Thurs. Read Bible. Ate

breakfast. Went to Kawakatanami Saito & Saito Saito. Went from there to Kiyushu Gakuen. Saw the plant. Then to Saito Saito for dinner and then to the train. Got home about 7 PM. Ate supper & read a paper or two & went to bed tired.

7 Fri. Read Bible & had devotions

Worked on organizing of desk for school. Went to see a doctor & expected to study on sermon afterwards but Mills called & stayed till almost dinner time. After dinner went to the bank & to do some paper work. Bought books for messengers work. He called & came home & had callers to supper here with study. Went to pastor's conference. Came home & worked till 10 P.M. on sermon.

8 Sat. Read Bible & had devotions

Spent most of the day in working on sermons. Had callers. Maude was in bed all day with bad head & back. Studied till nearly ten o'clock.

Warm, humid & rain

9 Sun. Got up rather late as

Maude was not well. Went to church and preached. Pastor had a little baby girl to arrive at his house at 9:15 AM. So all service fell on me. After service had committee meeting. connection with kids & dividends. Went
shopping. Got home at 5 P.M. Went
to dinner at King's. Then to P.M. went
to the Mills for meeting social
evening with the young people.

16 Sun. Read Bible. Went to S.S. & Church
and had service. Methodist Pastor
preached. Had good crowd.
After dinner went around
collecting money for kids & dividends
Have collected it all over \$7.00 I have
it right now extra promise. Went

18 Tues. Went to prayer service at 7 PM. Also breakfast. Drove after fence building & Catholic building. Also went to Mrs. Jos. for a consultation. Went home about 5 PM. Some came to talk. Went for this that I like. After dinner watched workmen. Had Kawakalei, Dan. had supper. Helped milk, put song. Some in the lot school.

19 Wed. Read Bible & had devotions. Watched workmen & also helped Kawakalei. Saw about to do his of school. After dinner went to Kawaho. Watched workmen. Read book. Went to prayer meeting. Got home about 8 PM. Read till 10 P.M.

20 Thurs. Read Bible & had devotions. Watched workmen & read. Went to Mrs. Jos. & Mrs. Sani. Some home and looked after workmen. After dinner oversaw workmen. Went to the Prefectural Office for consultation about school. Bought 2 lbs in request school.

21 Fri. Read Bible & had devotions. After breakfast, went to see about workmen. Spent morning in working over estimates for school running expenses for five years, ages. After dinner spent in working on school plans & watching workmen. Went to night school for 3 hrs.

22 Sat. Read Bible & had devotions. Went to the bank. Came home and looked after workmen. Also went to see about house. Went to the Prefectural Office. Ate dinner. Read looked after women. Went to meeting of working men of church. Came home about 8 PM. Read till 9:30.

23 Sun. Had Bible reading & prayer as usual. Went to Sunday School & church. After dinner went to Mr. Mori's & the Millers. Had Jones & Miller called. Wrote letter to Mamma to supper for a young man called O. O. Marshall.

Jan Memo. Spoke Kabanaka helped us on our registration. very kind. The Prefectural authorities are very kind to us.

24 Mon. Read Bible & had devotions - worked on school books. Had many callers. Rowe came about 11 AM. Had more all morning. At two o'clock went to Takahara. Had no Fukuma's. In evening we walked. Had meeting at Takahara at Takayama. I walked back to Takahara about 8 PM. Rowe came home with me. Wilbur came. Ojaki says went to Takahara. Home about 11 PM.

25 Tues. Read Bible & had devotions. Spent whole day at school books. Had experienced worker to help me. When night came I was tired. but went to Public Hall to the meetings. Had about 700 people present. Mrs. Kuroki & Mr. Maudet Presiding. Spoke Fine service. Reached home about 11 PM.

26 Wed. Read Bible & had devotions. Looked out workmen to work. Went to see Mrs. J. Davis home. Spent the rest of the day working on ~~records~~ registration of the school. Also oversaw workmen. Had guests. Went to Takahara. Went to Takahara. Had a very good meeting. Reached home about 11 PM.

27 Thurs. Read Bible & had devotions. ate breakfast. Went to see how the workmen were getting on with the building. Spent practically the whole day on to doki for boys school. Went to Takahara at night. Helen was sick all day. Am very tired.

28 Fri. Read Bible & had devotions. Spent practically all day in getting registration of school in shape to present to Prefectural authorities. Went to see head man about 10:30 AM after dinner. Had callers along with other business. Went to church at night. Had good service. Good crowd. Takahara church.

29 Sat. Read Bible & had devotions. Spent morning in entertaining my guests & making out monthly statement to Rowe. After dinner had a number of duties. Watched Helen. Had no guests. Went to church at night. Had good meeting.

30 Sun. Had breakfast. Went to S. & church. After dinner wrote letters about work to friends at home. Wrote to my mother. Went to Miller's. Went to church. Had very good crowd.

Memo. The Prefectural officials have been very kind to us. But to register a school in Japan is a very difficult thing to do. There is very much red tape to go through. I have been on a very hard struggle. The Evangelistic Campaign has been well attended.

JANY. FEBRUARY 1916.

31 Mon. Read Bible & had devo-
tions. Spent the entire day
working with Clerk work-
ing on the school registra-
tion. Taught two hours
in the Night School.

1 Tues. Read Bible & had devo-
tions. Spent the day in look-
after building & with Clerk
working on school registra-
tion. Also read papers from papers.
Took courage when read of letter
times at home. Taught in. Went to

club. Paid out two hrs. wages.

15 Tues. Read Bible and had
devotions. Ate breakfast. Went
to see Mr. Jo. Looked after work -
men on ~~at~~ ^{at} Gymnasium.
Worked on school problems. After
dinner went to see about chairs &
also to see property for sale. Was
tough thro' in night school. Was
tired out when night came.

16 Wed. Read Bible & had devotions.
After breakfast looked after
matters pertaining to the school.
After dinner officed from the
office. A letter office came to
inspect the school buildings. Went
to city office & got governor's license
for kids to begin the school.

Thurs. Read Bible & had devotions.
Went to station at 8:30. Called at the

Ate breakfast. Spent the morning
in visiting primary school.
After dinner was tired. Best callers
came. I spent till four P.M. Got
paid about very grave questions of
money. Parted with some report
on school. Some looked over book
ing. Had to talk straight to prefect
West for social exercises. Got to bed.

20 Sun. Went to church. S.S.
Went for medicine. Took
Edwin to Joneses for S.S.
Called at Pool Yanaquas to
express sympathy that upon the
death of his father I went by Mr.
Jelmin's task about regarding
of a group to general. Came by
Memo.
Recorder. Mr. Ishwarar
called. Went to church
at night.

28 Mon. Read Bible & had devotions
Dreary weather. Spent the morn-
ing in writing letters. Discus-
sing school problems. Went to
sleep after dinner for awhile.
Wrote program & lessons for students class
or grade. Taught two hours in night school.
Had five to day. Made out report to Board

29 Tues. Read Bible & had devotions
Spent morning, in writing
letters to the Board of Man-
agers about getting a clean
for the boys school. After din-
ner, read & looked after matters
pertaining to the boys school.
Taught three hours in night
school. Some home work to do.

1 Wed. Read Bible, had devotions
New case of Row's baby having
diphtheria. Also letters from
other member of Board of Managers
agreeing to my selecting a teacher
after dinner. Read. Went over
to the school. Cold worse. Went
to church. Read till 10.
to make children

2 Thurs. Read Bible & had devotions
All are better but as it is snowing
and raining none of us dare
go out. Spent day in reading
and working on something
for boys Bible study. Taught two
hours in night school

3 Fri. Read Bible & had
devotions. As it was clear
went out to see workmen
spend a good part of the day
that way. Went to bank &
by the Post office. Sent money
for Miller to Dr. W. value. Had call
in the afternoon. Went to night school
and rest of the day.

4 Sat. Spent the day in
bed with cold.
Temperature up to 100°
Made read to me most
of the afternoon

5 Sun. Spent the day in
bed. Got Sam, Kambakaten Sam
& Kaminnuma Sam called
after church on their way
from church.
