19 Sun. Went to church. Ate dinner read. Wrote letters. Went to English service & then had boys forgoing practice.

22 Fri. After breakfast. Led chapel. Taught three hours of Culture. Went to Tinsdgerger. Had Xmas after dinner. Took supper with the dormitory boys. Went to see a Gogak of Xmas entertainment at night.

23 Sat. After breakfast. Went to school. Had the closing exercises of the school. Spoke to the boys. Had announcements of the terms work. Worked on getting Xmas presents ready. Went shopping. To a Xmas entertainment at night. <sup>24 Sat.</sup> Went to church. 8:08. After dinner. Went to mission and children's entertainment. Went to church at night. Helped get decorations ready for Xmas night.

25 Mon. Had Xmas at home. Many friends were kind to remember us. After breakfast. Went to see about repairs being put on school room. To the church spent rest of day entertaining the workers. Went to church Xmas celebration. ~~Went to church Xmas celebration.~~

26 Tues. Spent the day at home or at least the greater part of it & went over to the school to see about work. but as it was snowing fearfully. No carpenter came. 28 Thurs. Xmas entertained. Spent morning in working on monthly financial report of Sunday department. Left at 12:30 P.M. for Nagasaki. Reached Nagasaki at 5:10. Went to Powers. Held meeting of Shadan Hoppin at night. Talked till 10 o'clock about other business matters.

DECEMBER 1916.

29 Fri. Got up late. Worked on auditing Treasurers Books before breakfast till 12. M. ate dinner & left by 2 P.M. train for home. Was out by 2.30 min. Unusual for Japanese train. Got home at 8:30 P.M.

30 Sat. Spent the morning in entertaining guests & welcoming new school teachers. Looked after some financial matters pertaining to school. Went to bank. Wrote letters. Went to see Mr. Shivers of N.S. Bld Co. off.

31 Sun. Got up late. Went to church. Spent the after noon in talking to guests & in thinking about talk for the New Year for the Seinan Ekumen. Went for medicine. Then wrote letters. Went to church and then came home & wrote Memo. To home & finished putting in figures for Annual report. It has rained all after noon. Will have sloppy New Year's day.

The year had been the  
busiest of all the years  
of my life in Japan.

The year witnessed the  
opening of the Seiyun  
Bank & this has  
meant many added  
responsibilities.

The Kindergarten has  
been on Maudie's  
shoulders & we have  
both been exceedingly  
busy.

But we are very thankful  
for the health of the  
children and our  
own health. We feel  
that the year has been  
one full of many  
blessings. It marks the

of my life. When tomorrow  
dawns I shall be 38 yrs
