Golden Spike Congregations Located by Census Tract

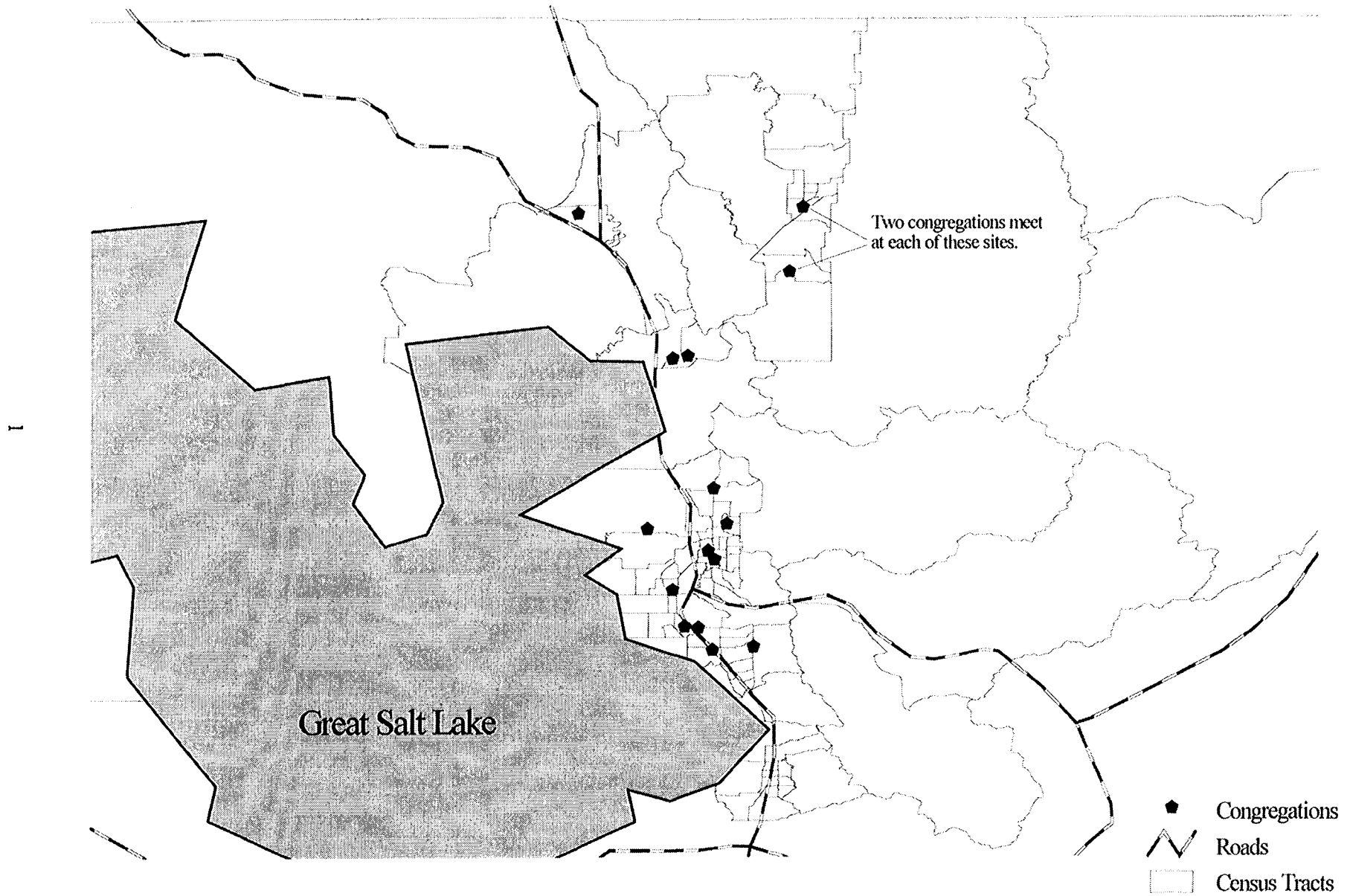

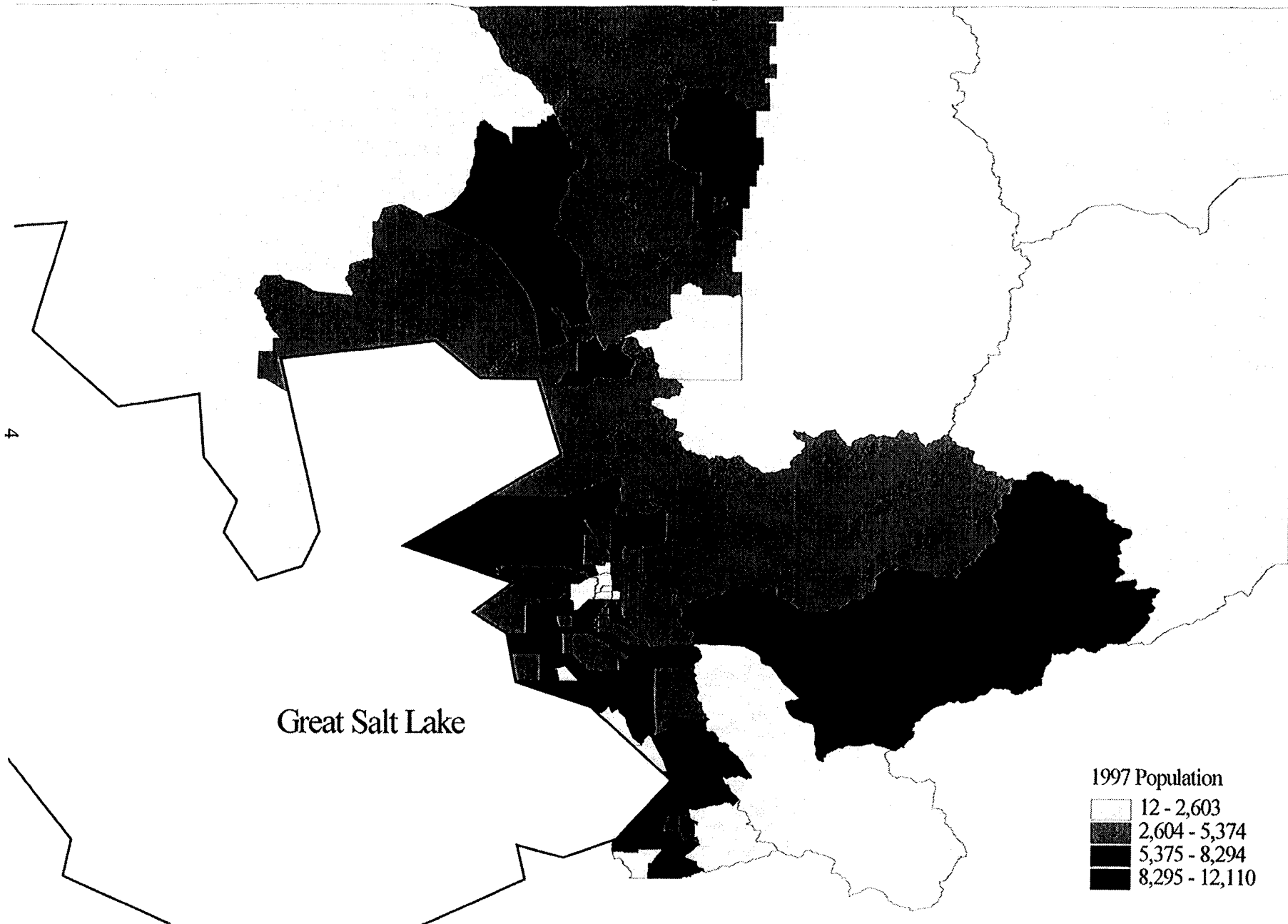

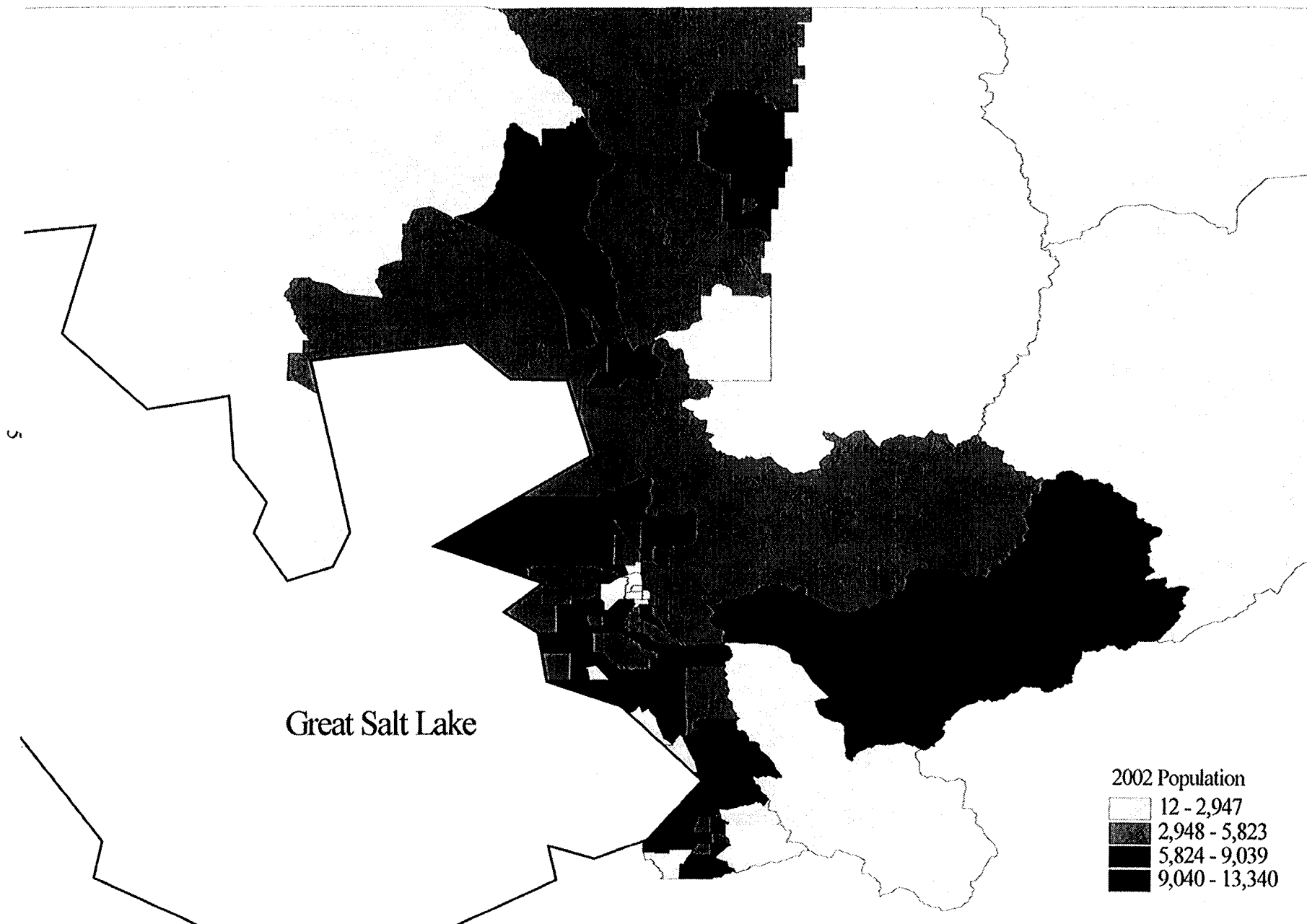

Estimated Total Population, 1997



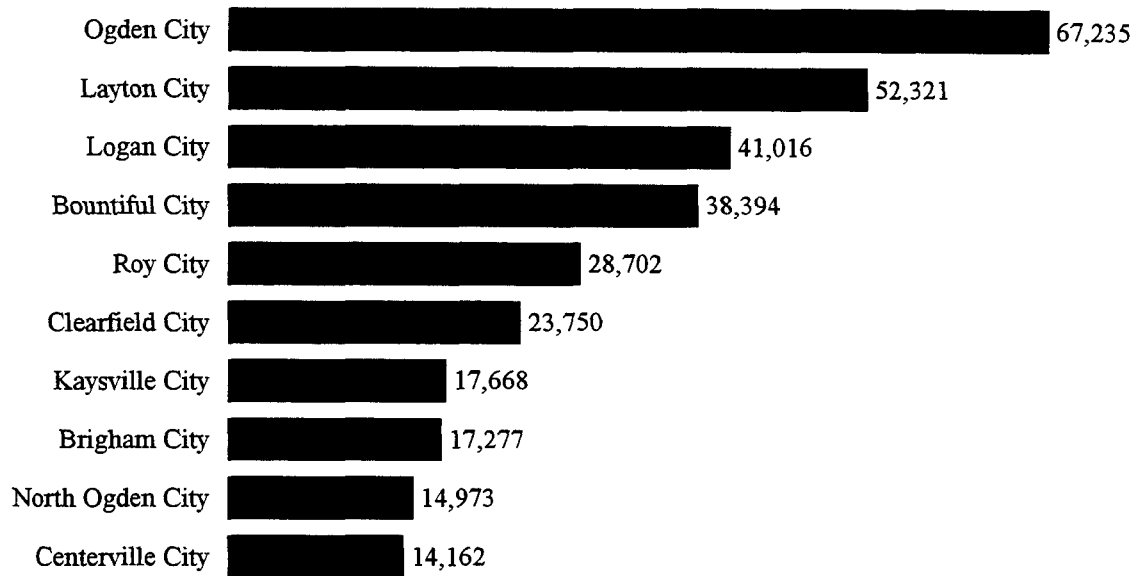

Projected Total Population, 2002



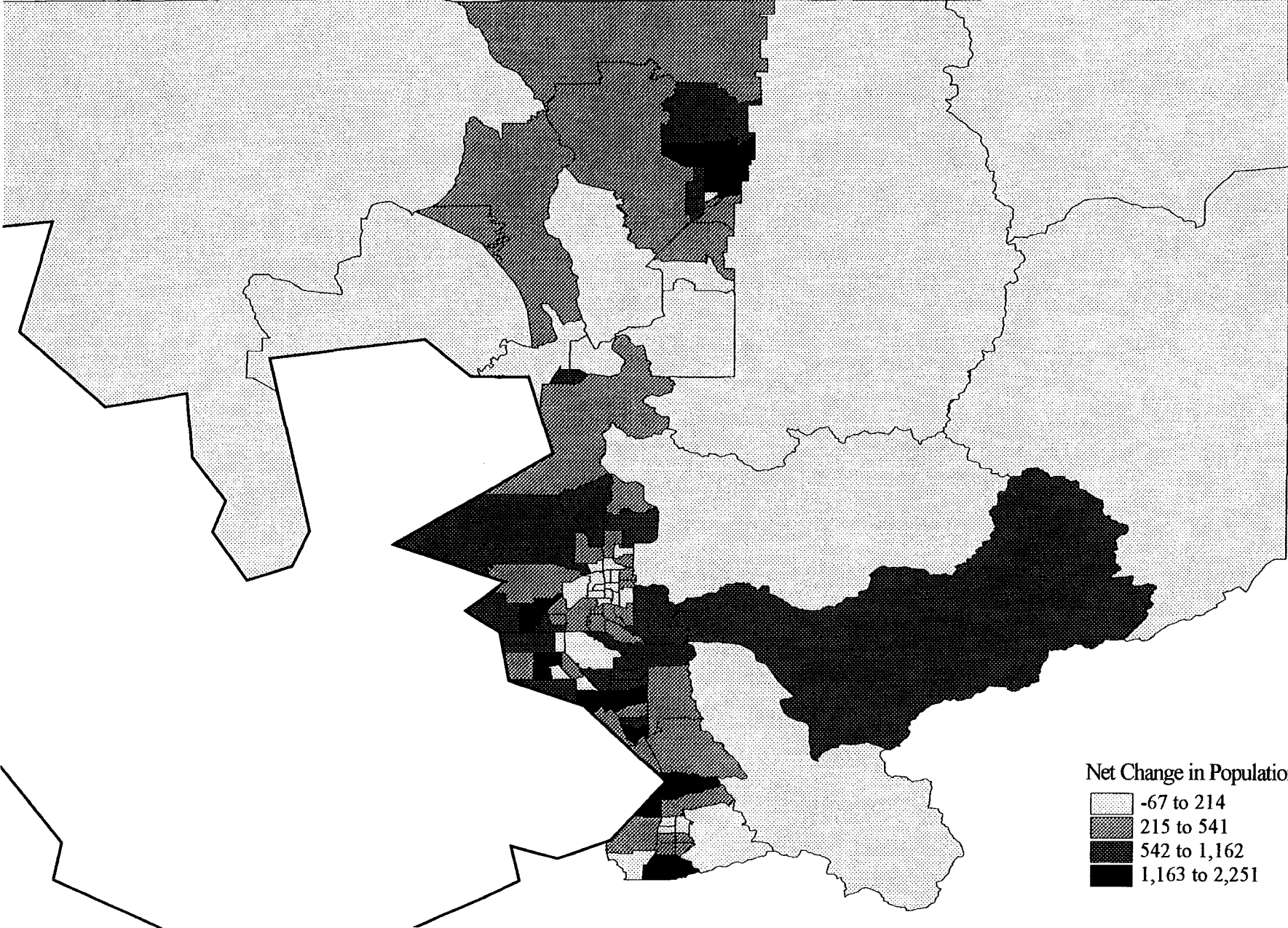

Projected Net Change in Total Population, 1997 to 2002

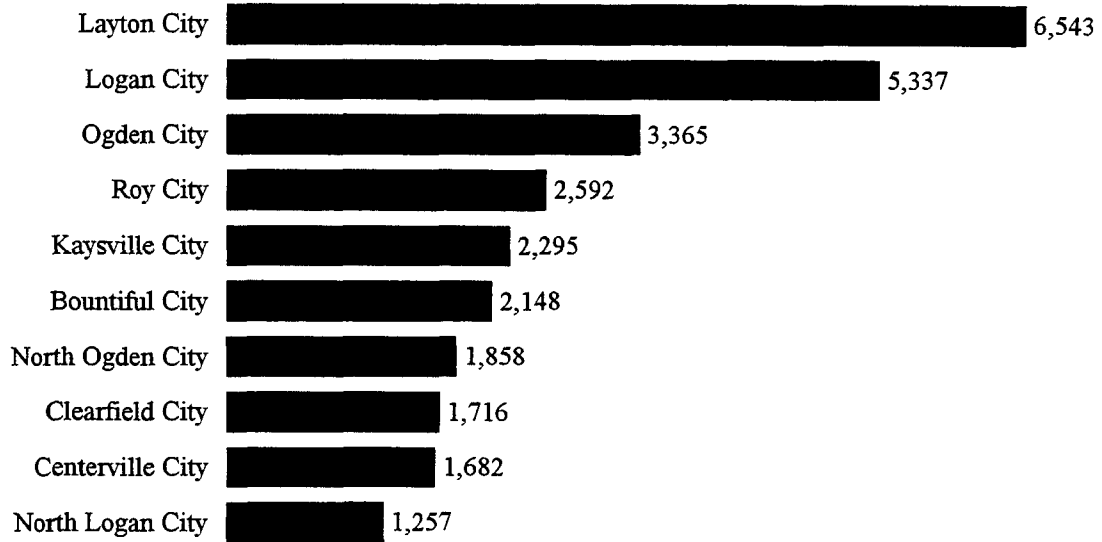

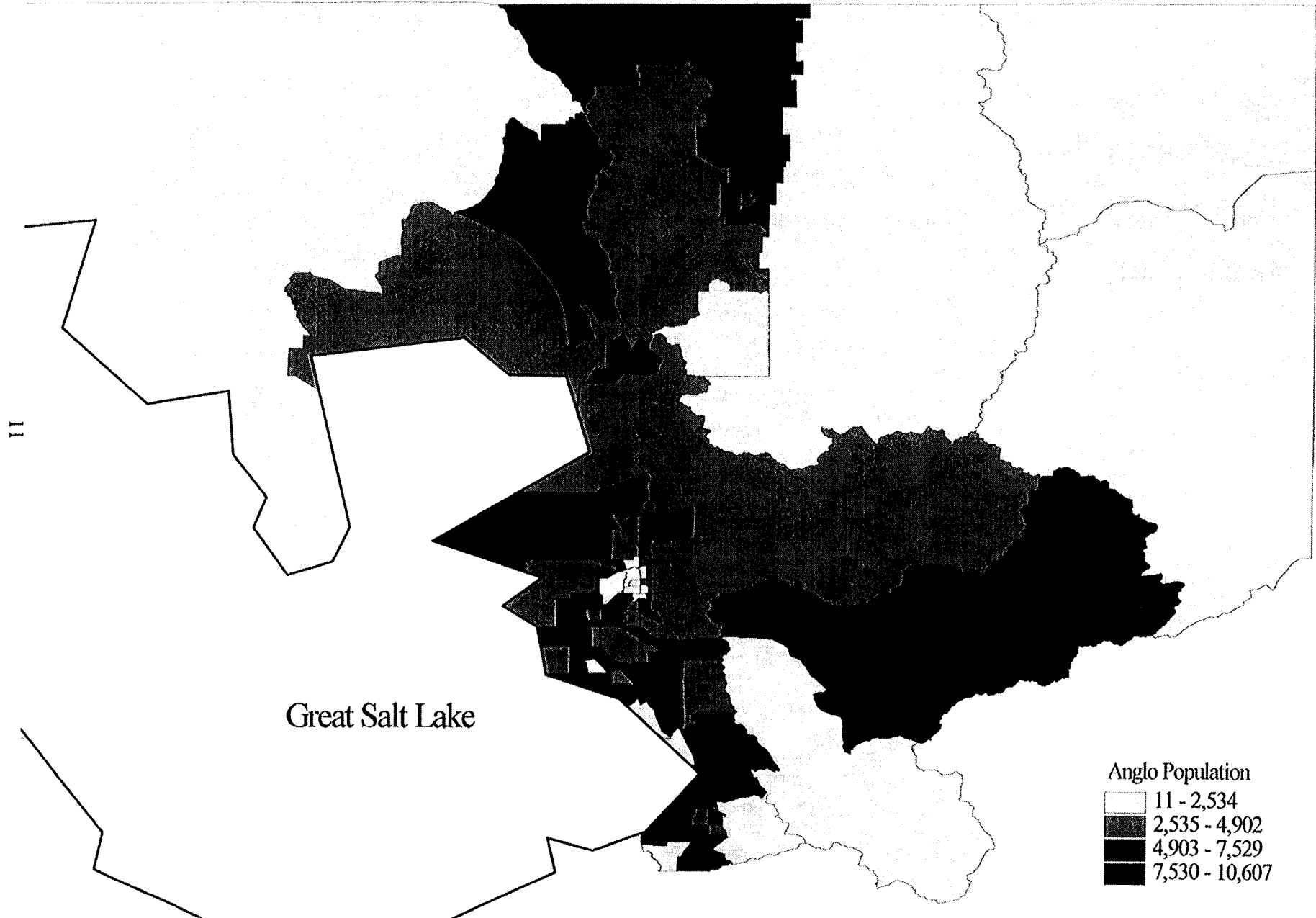

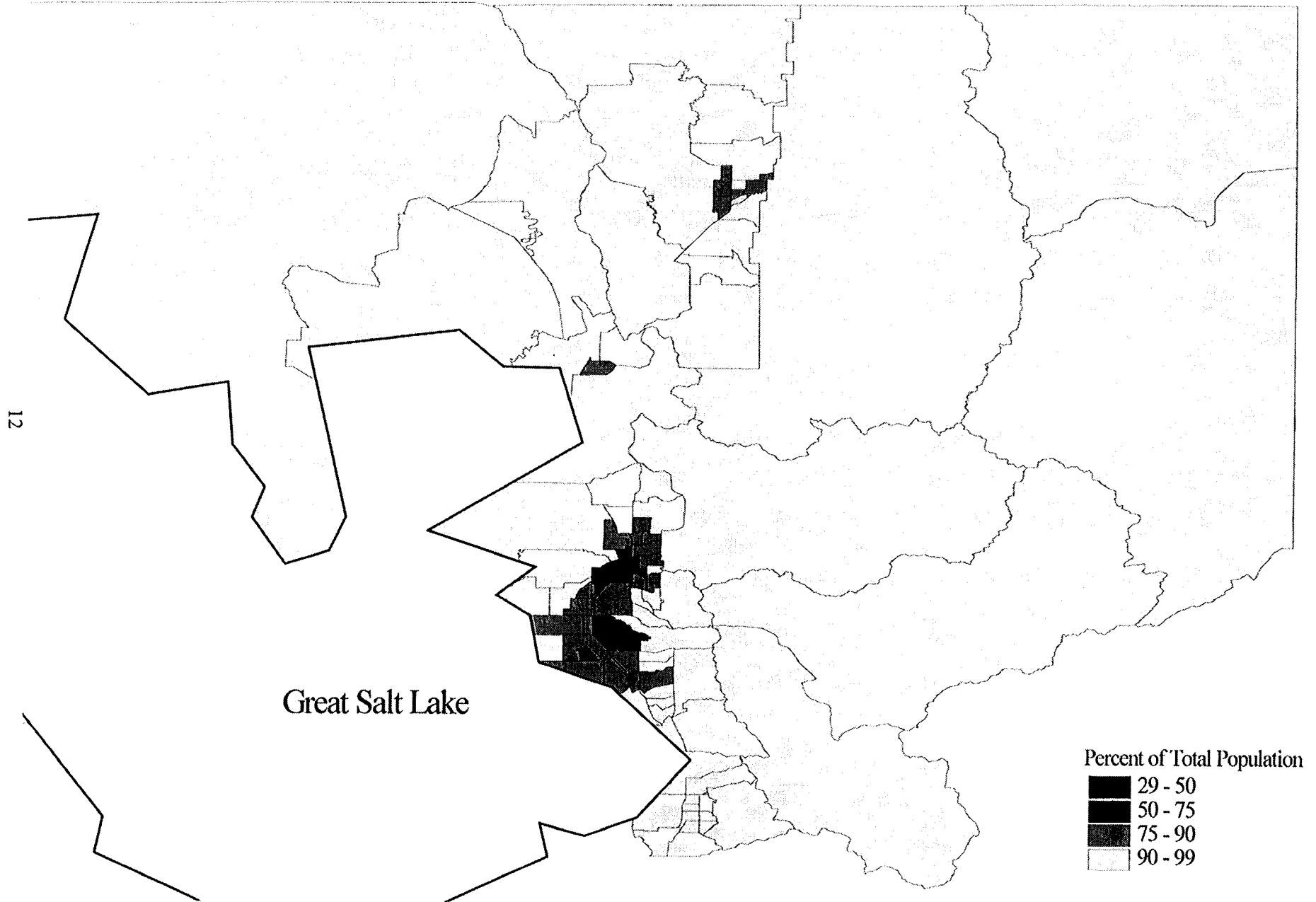

Estimated Anglo Population, 1997



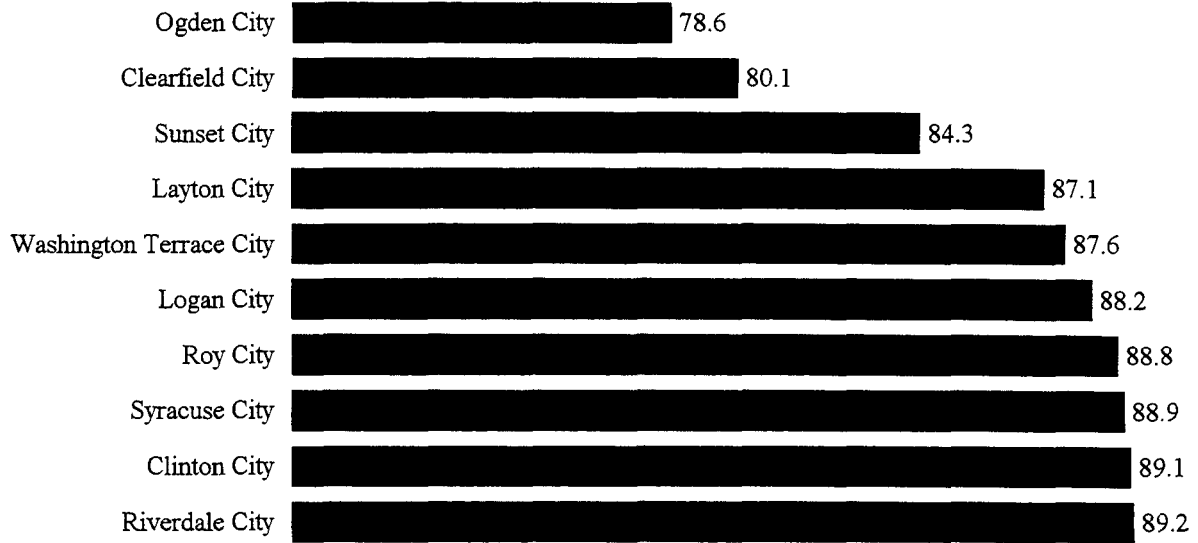

Estimated Anglo Population as a Percentage of Total Population, 1997



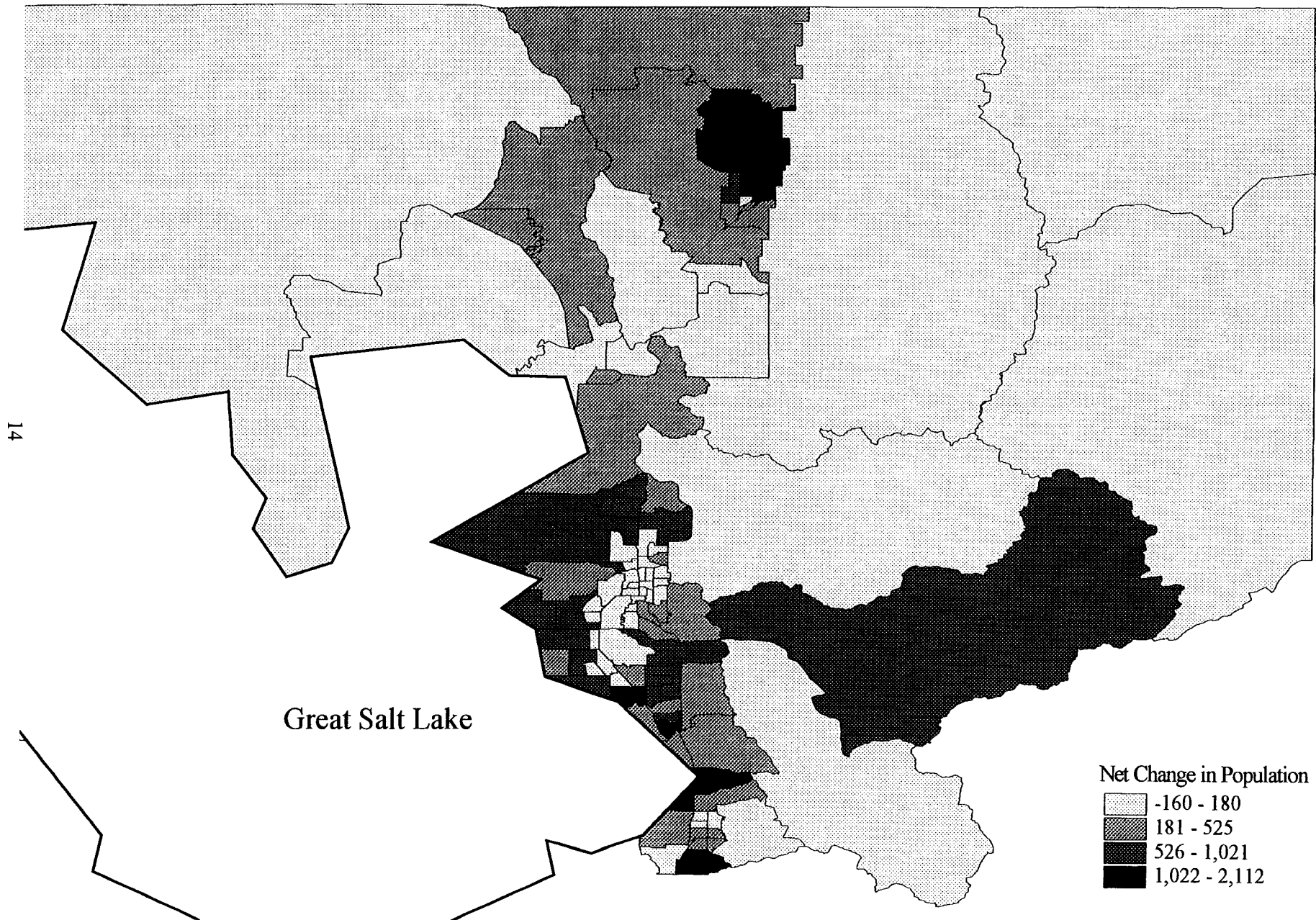

as a Percentage of Total Population, 1997



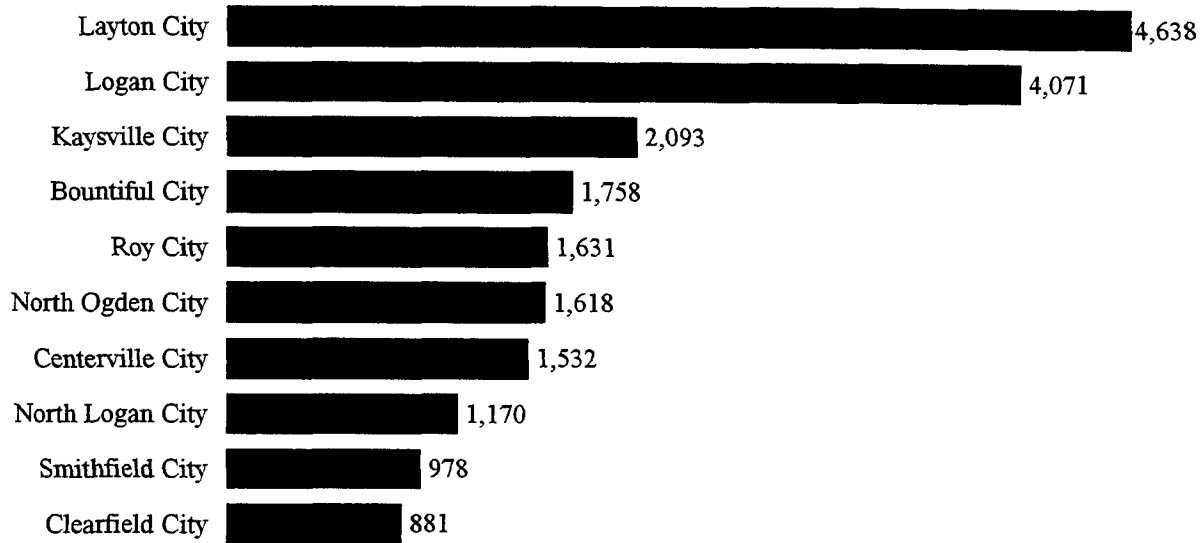

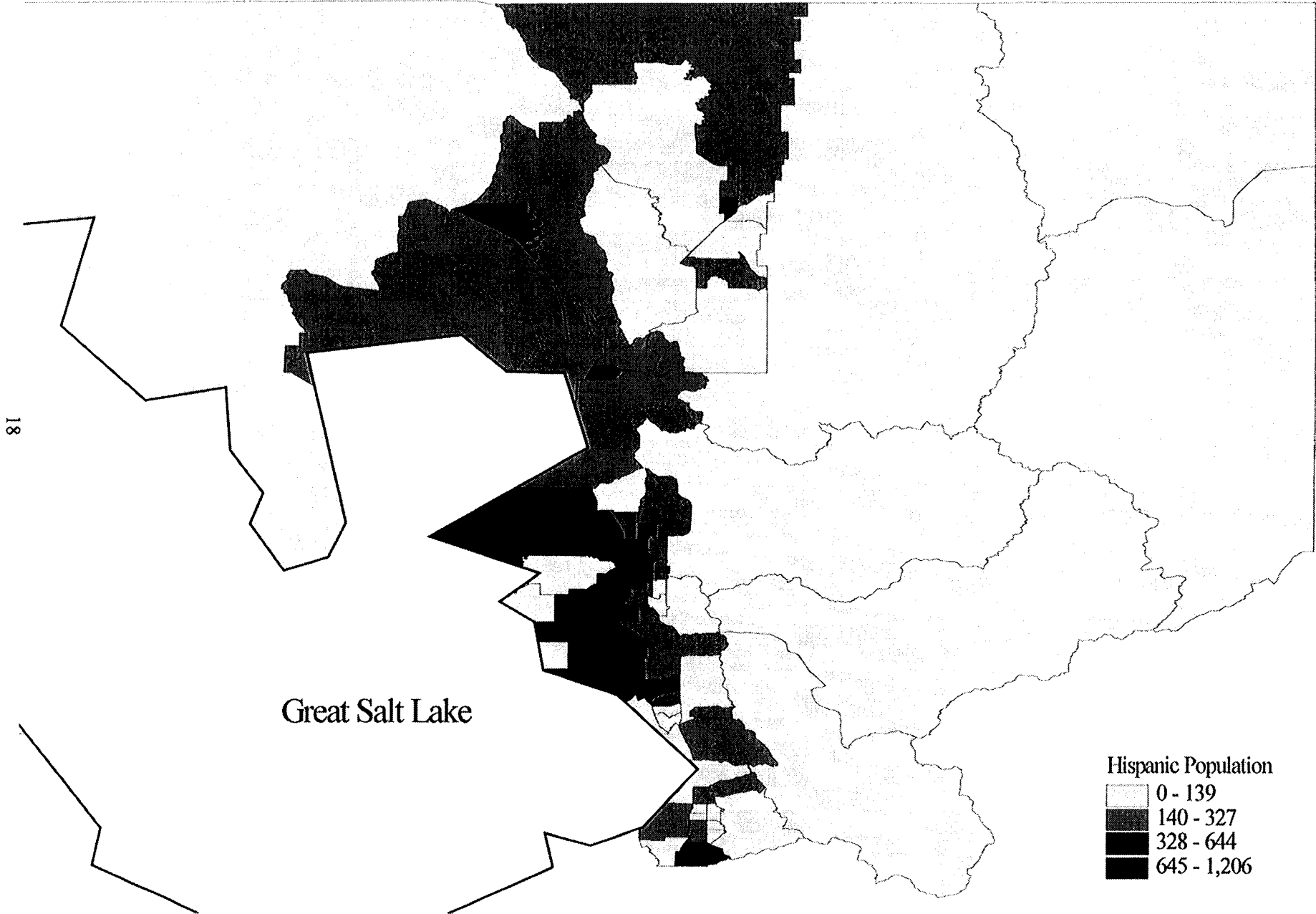

Hispanic Population, 1997

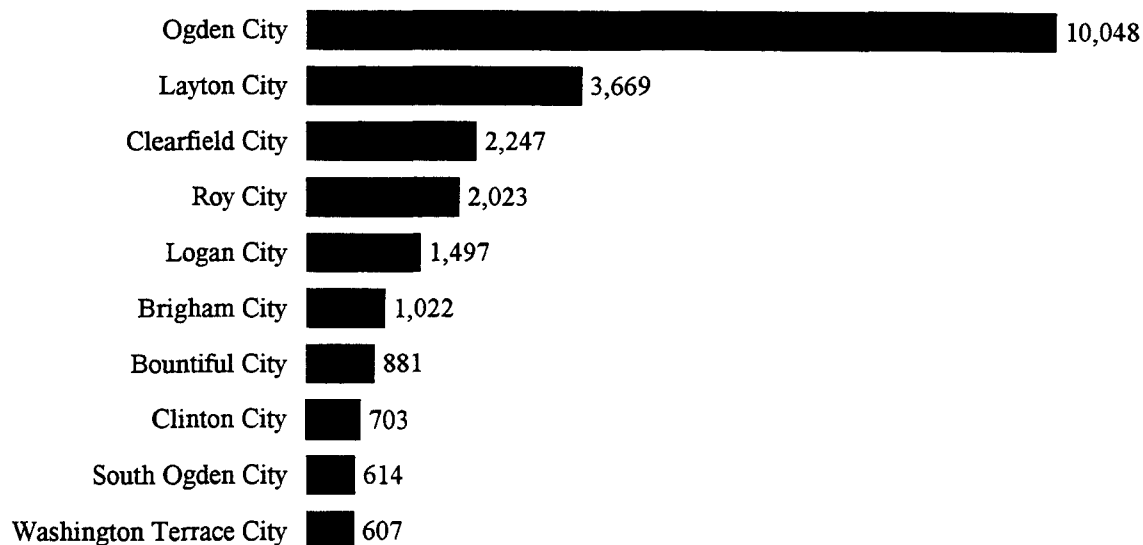
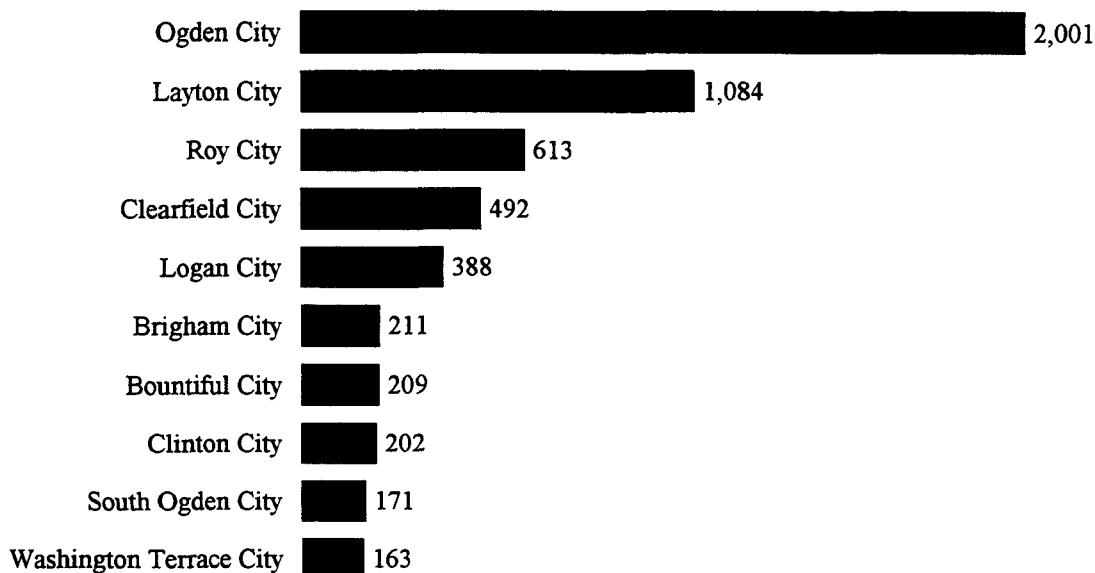

Ten Places With the Largest Estimated Asian and Pacific Islander Population, 1997

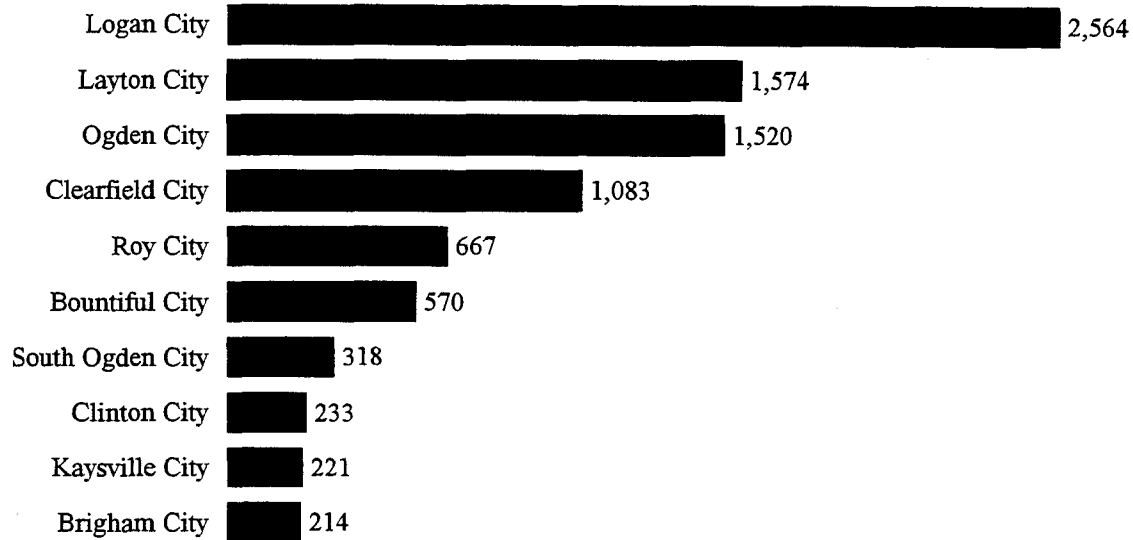
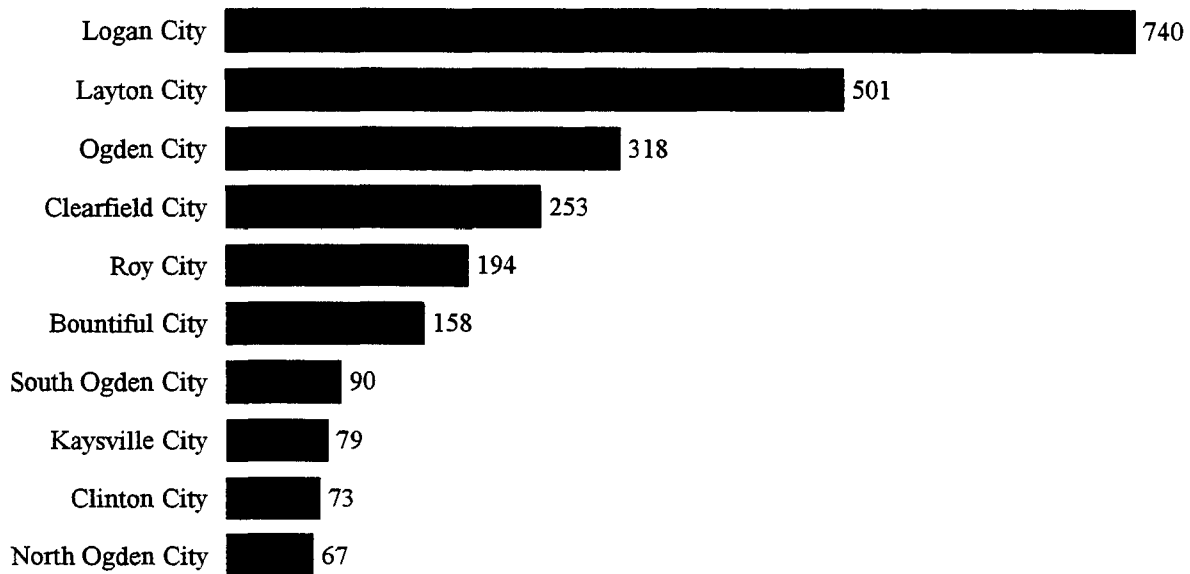

Ten Places With the Largest Estimated Black Population, 1997

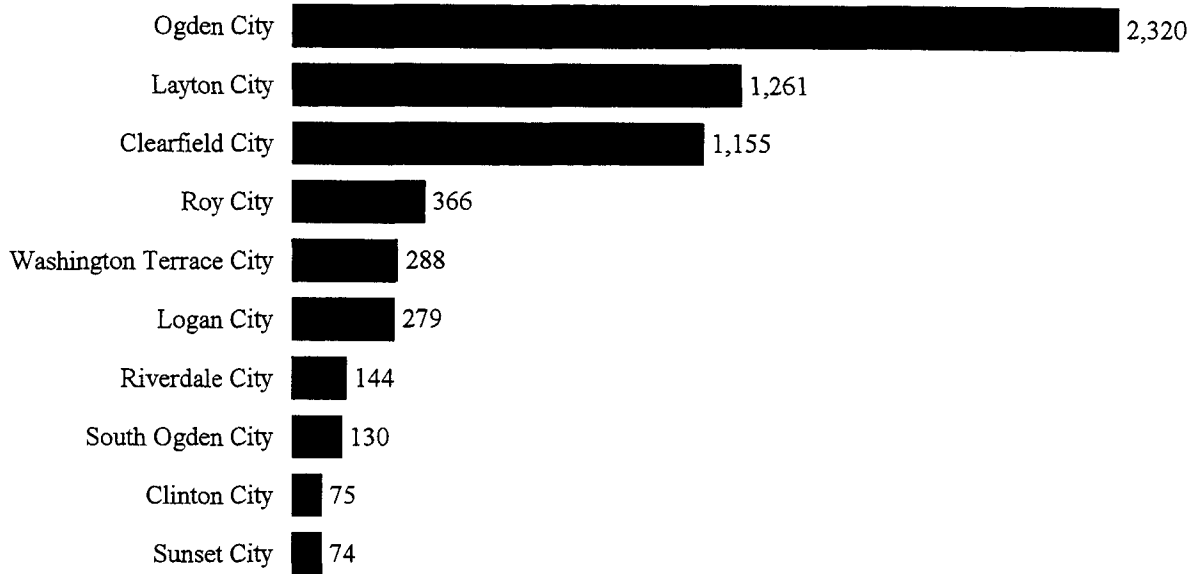
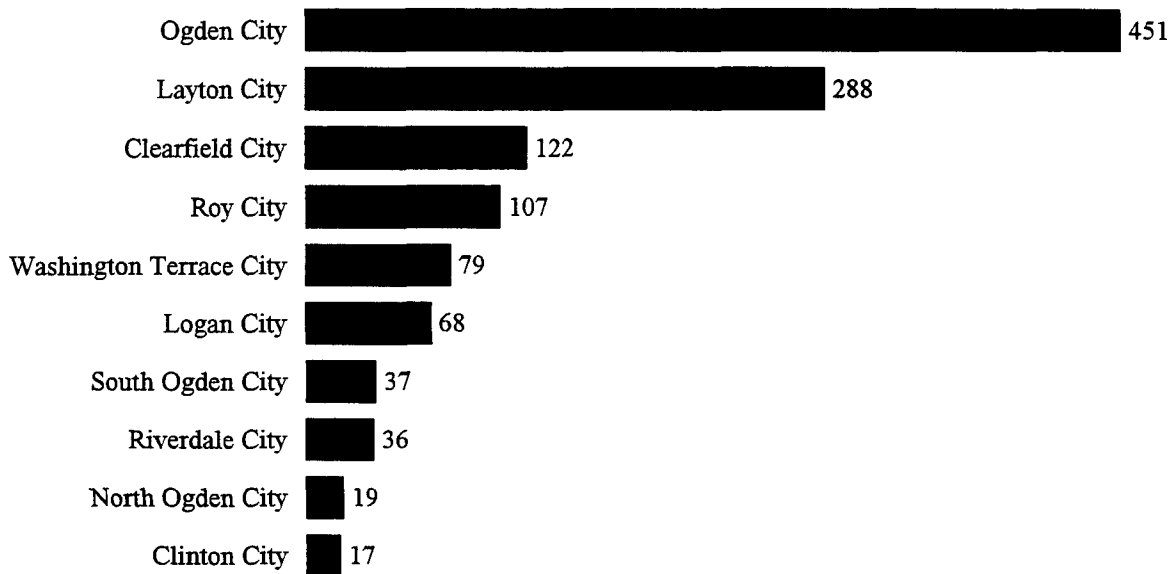

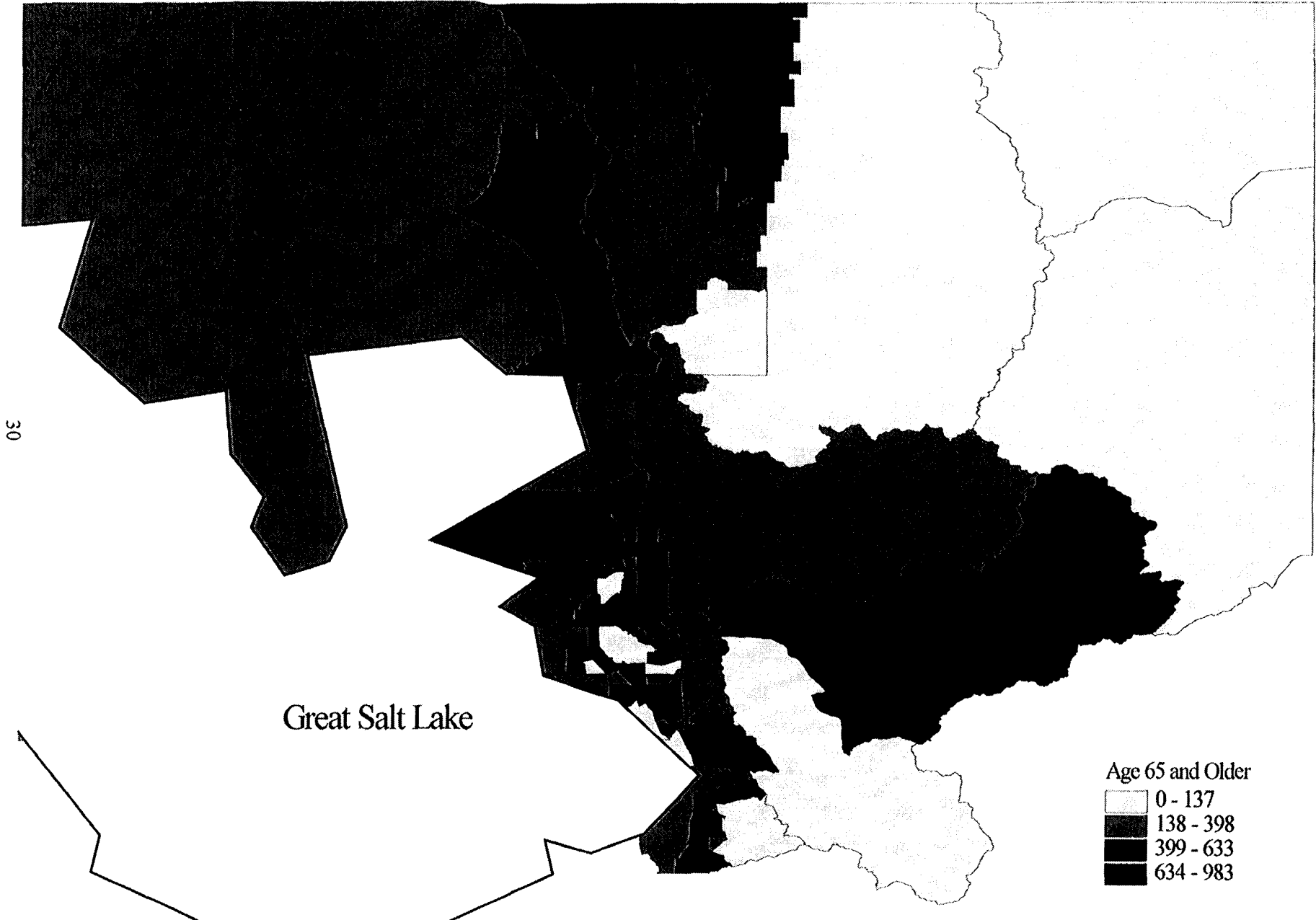

Ten Places With the Largest Estimated Age 65 and Over Population, 1997

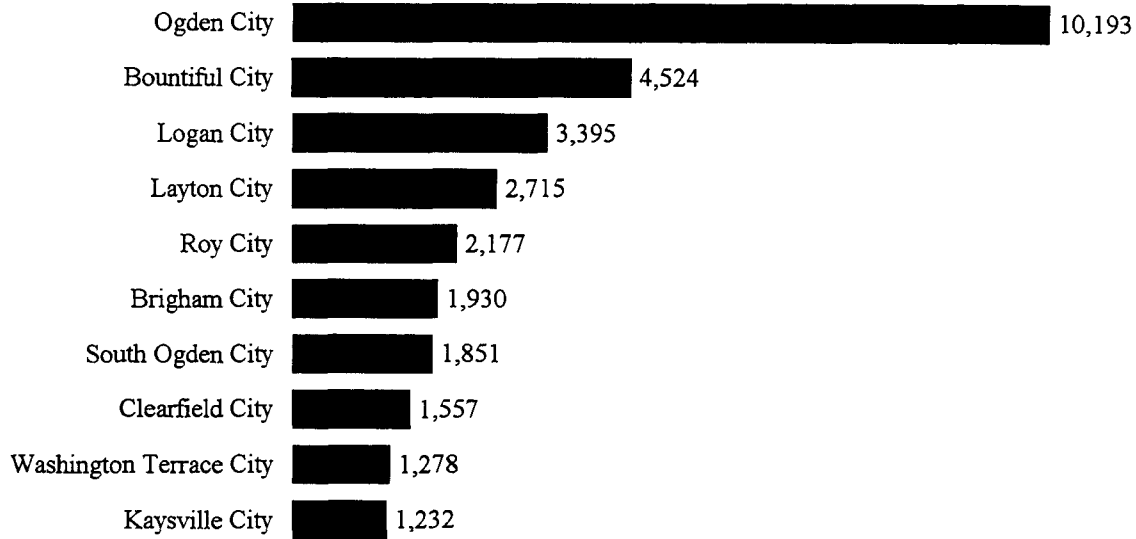
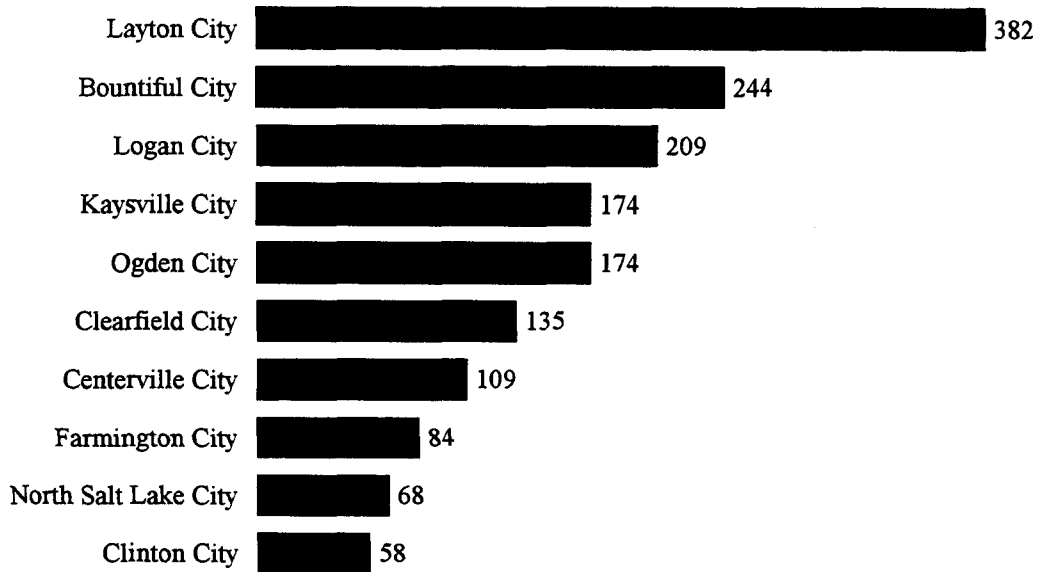

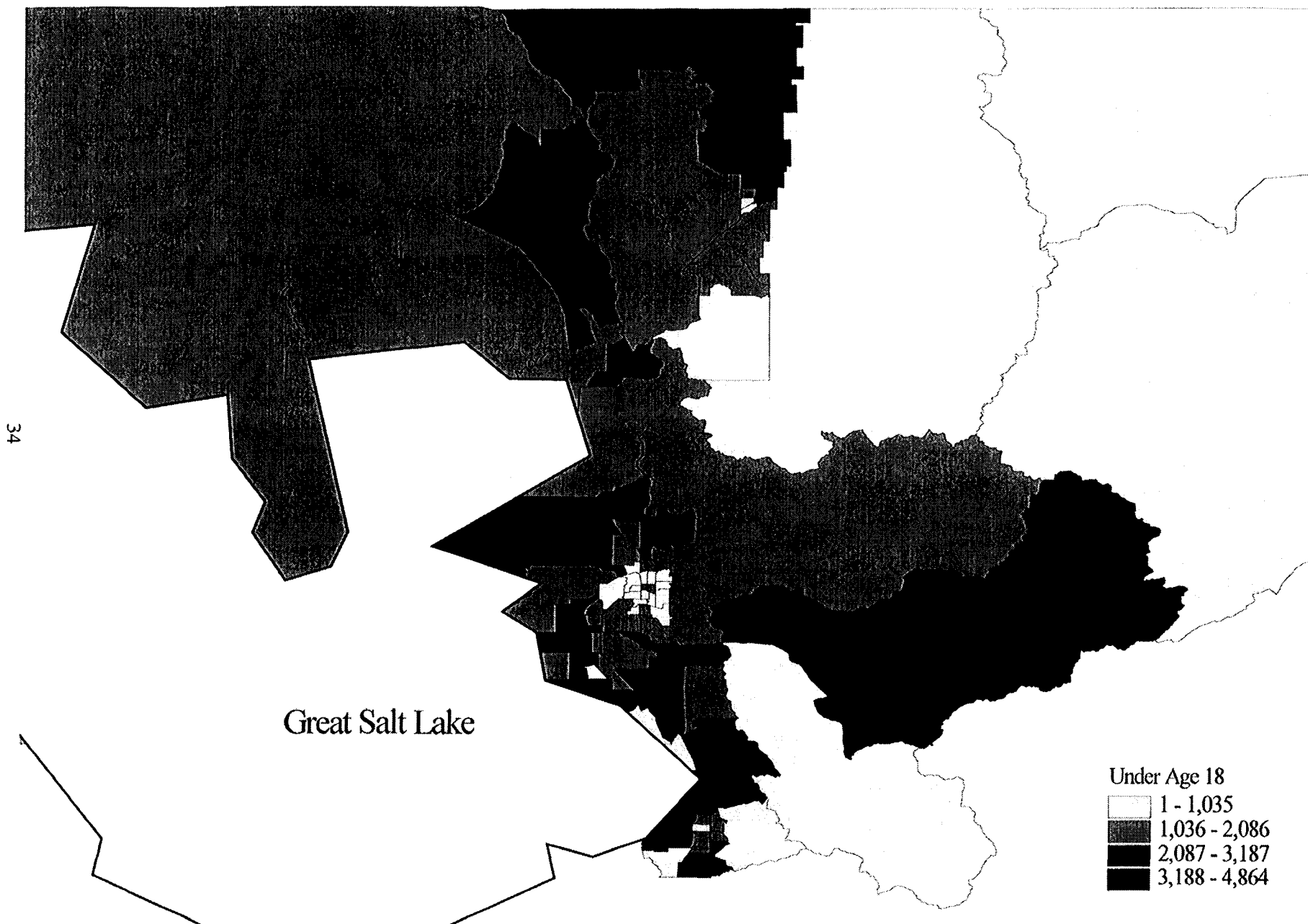

Under Age 18 Population, 1997

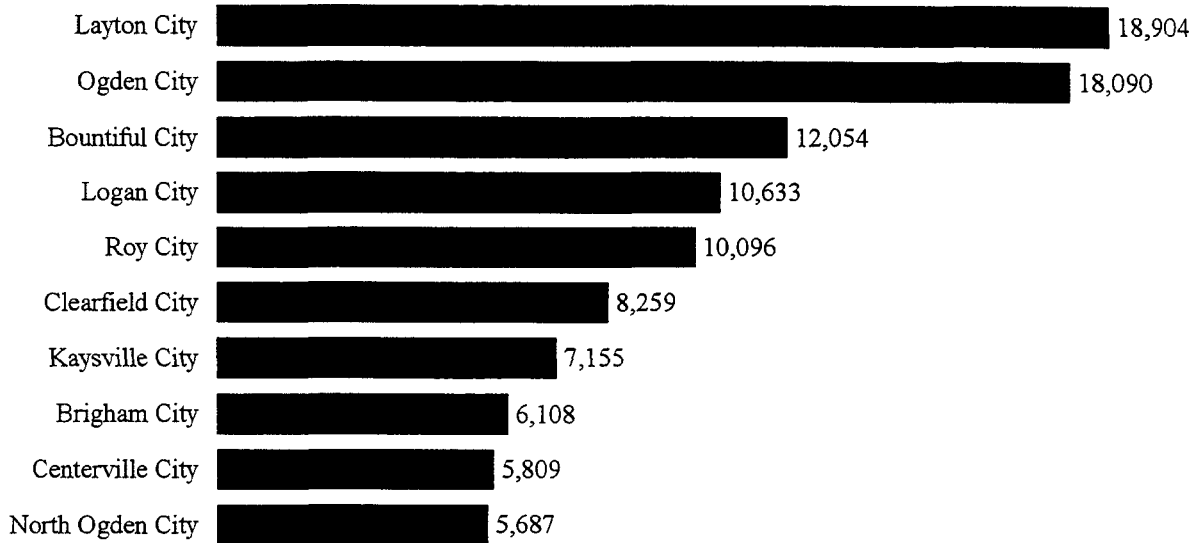
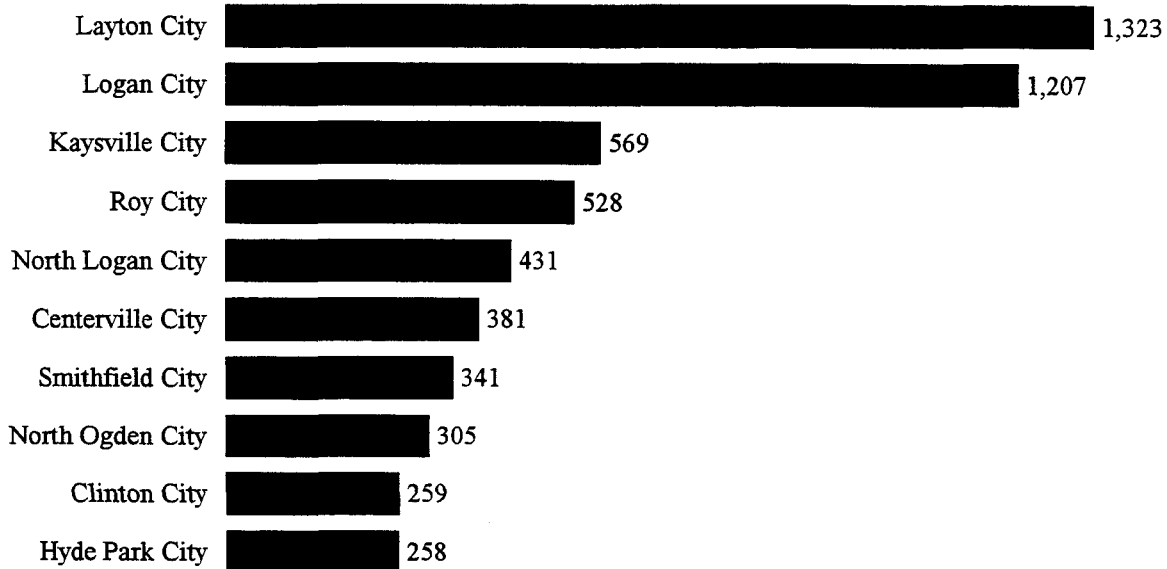

Ten Places With the Highest Estimated Median Age, 1997

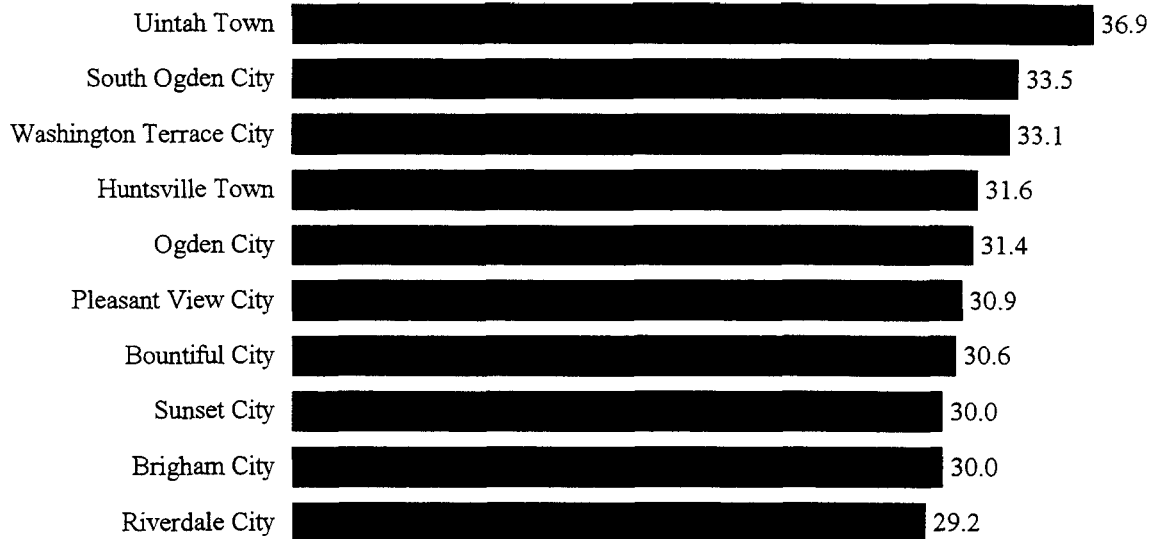
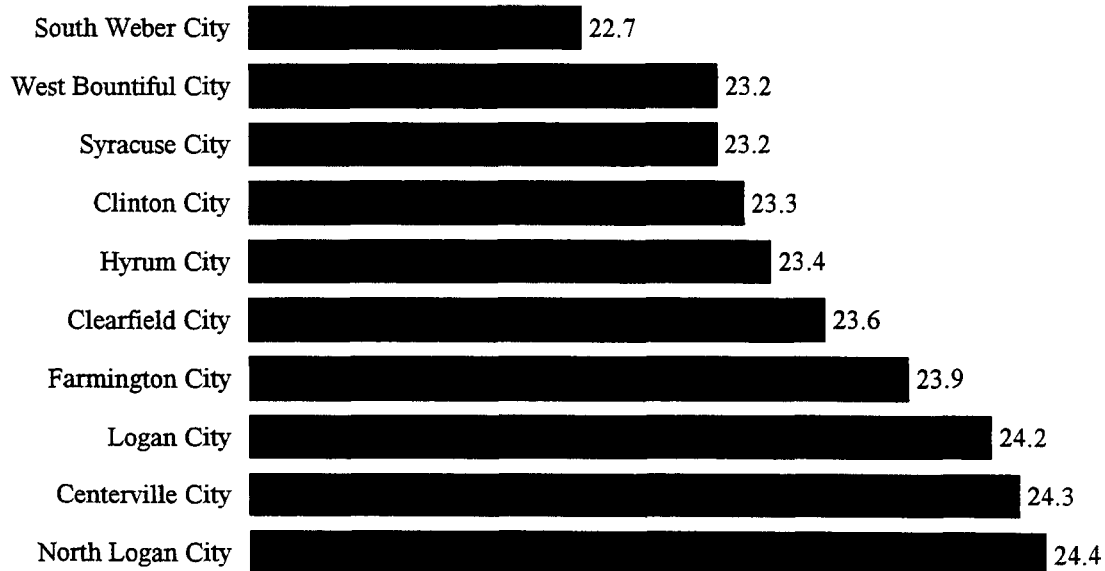

Family Households, 1990

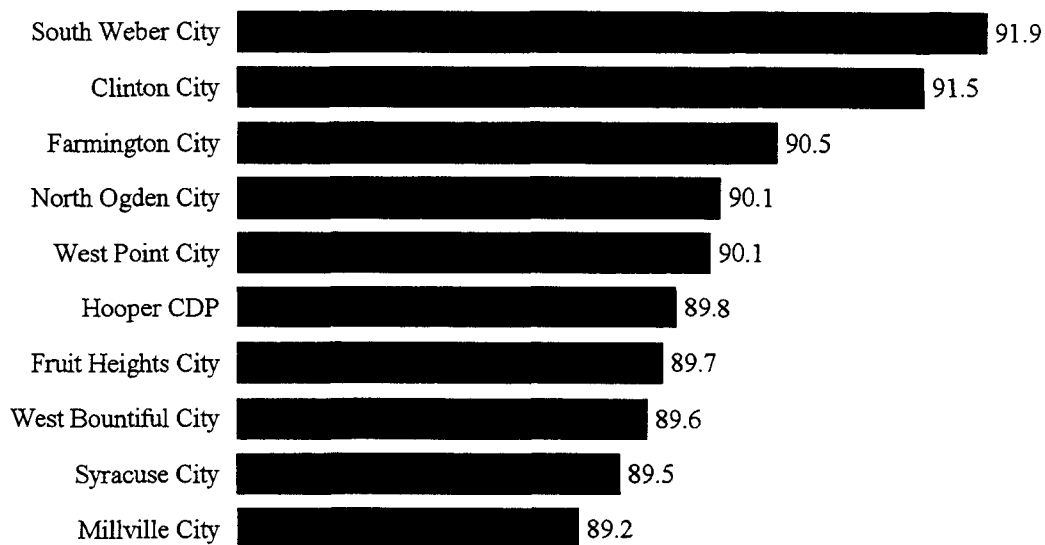
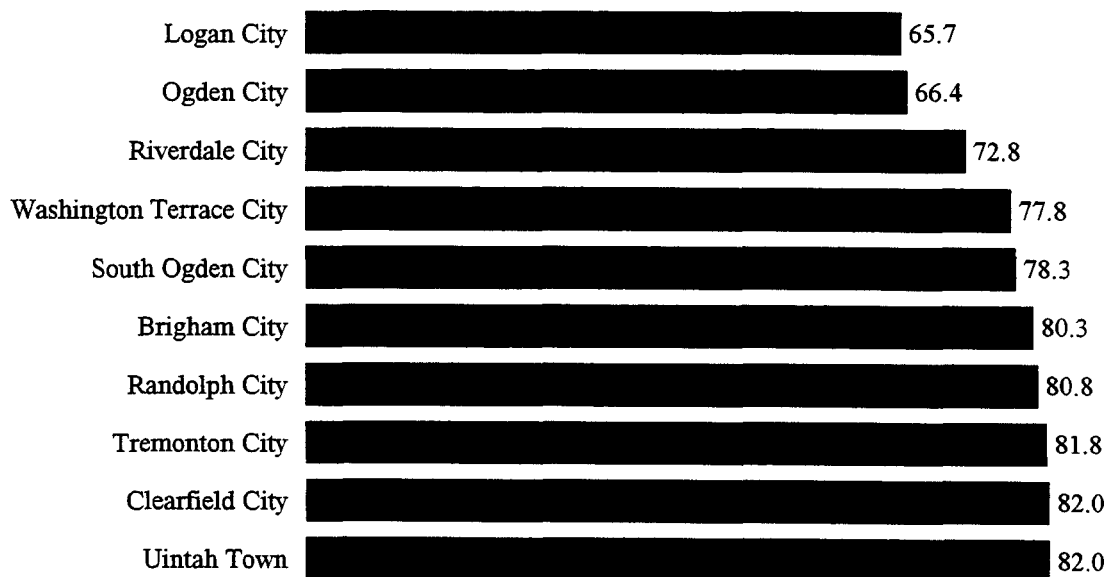

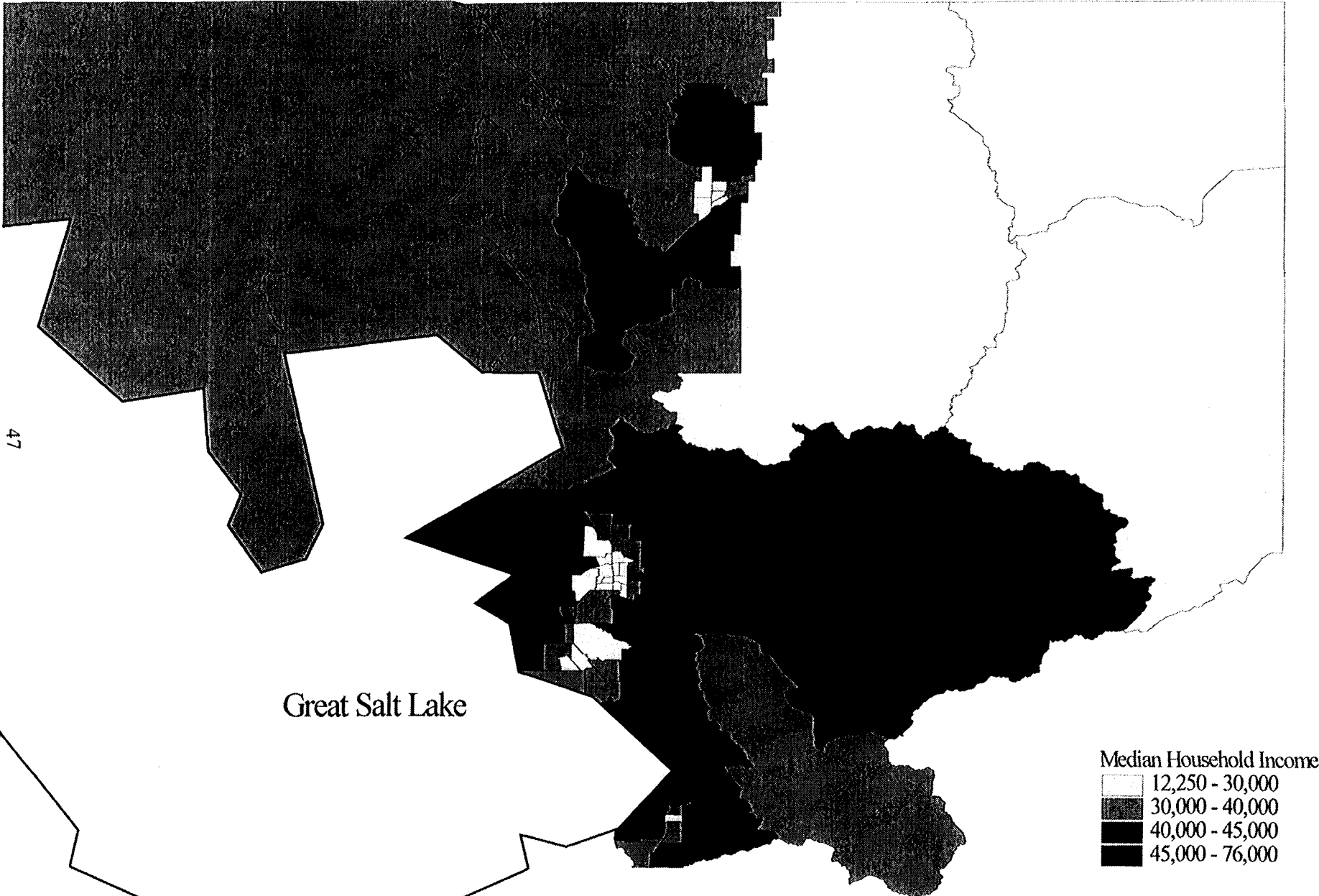

Less Than \$15,000, 1997

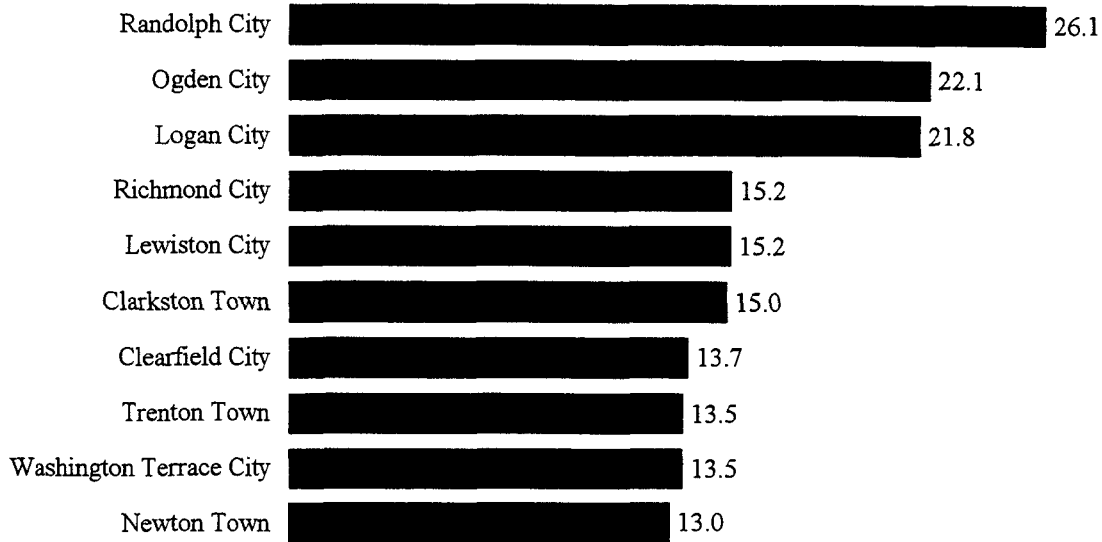
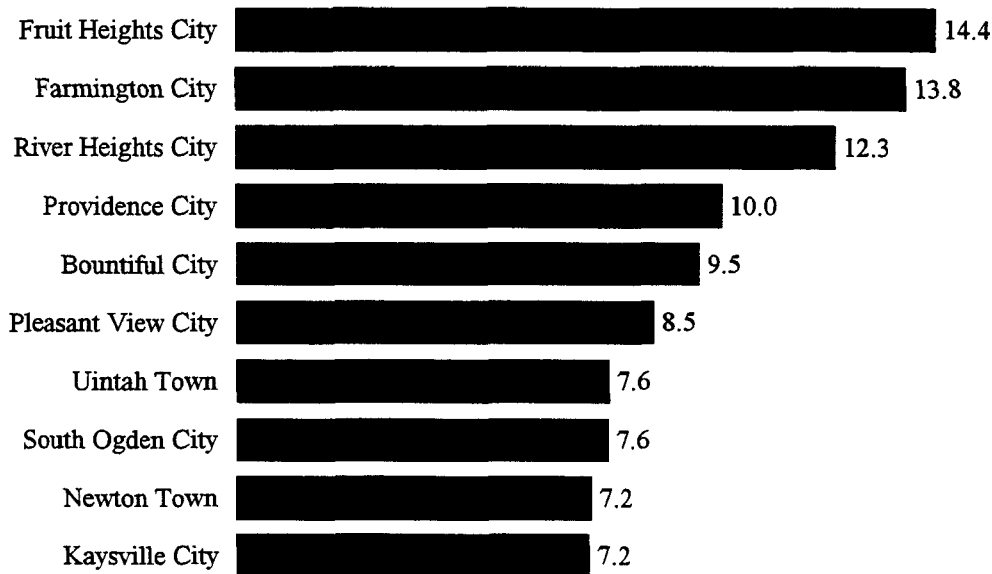

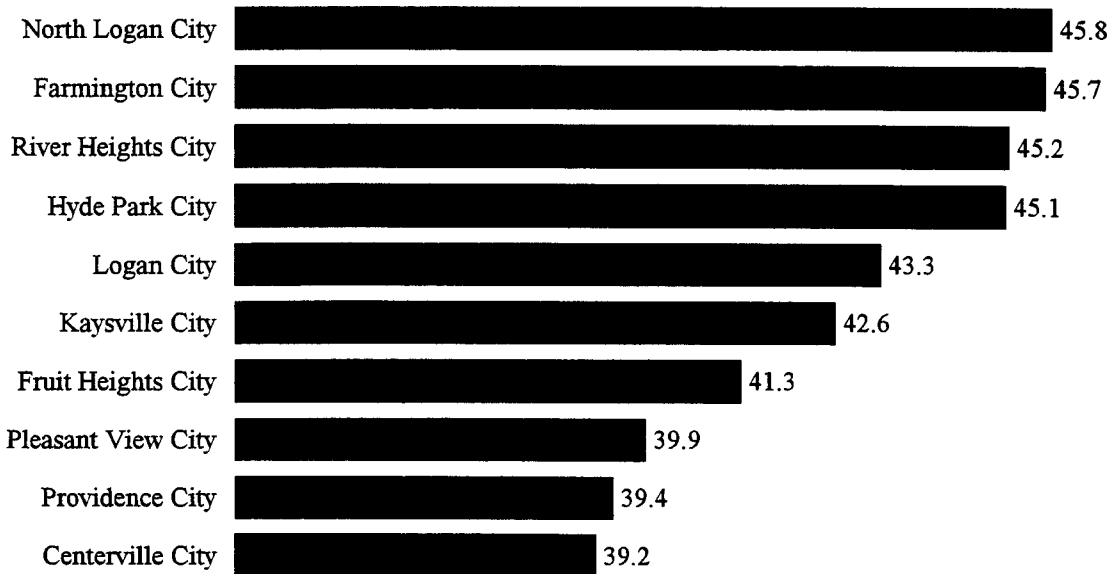

Multiple Housing Units, 1990

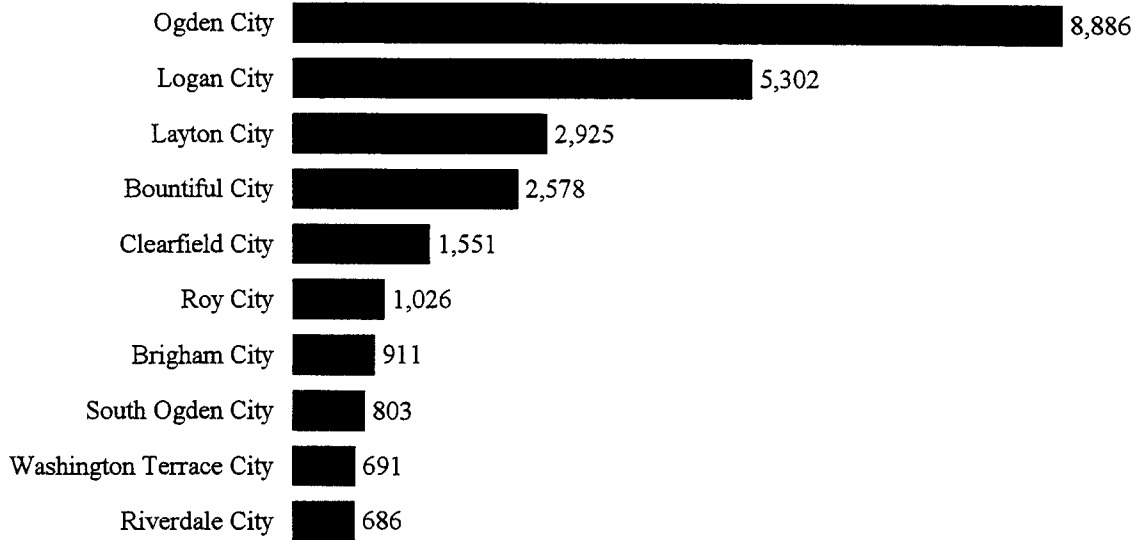
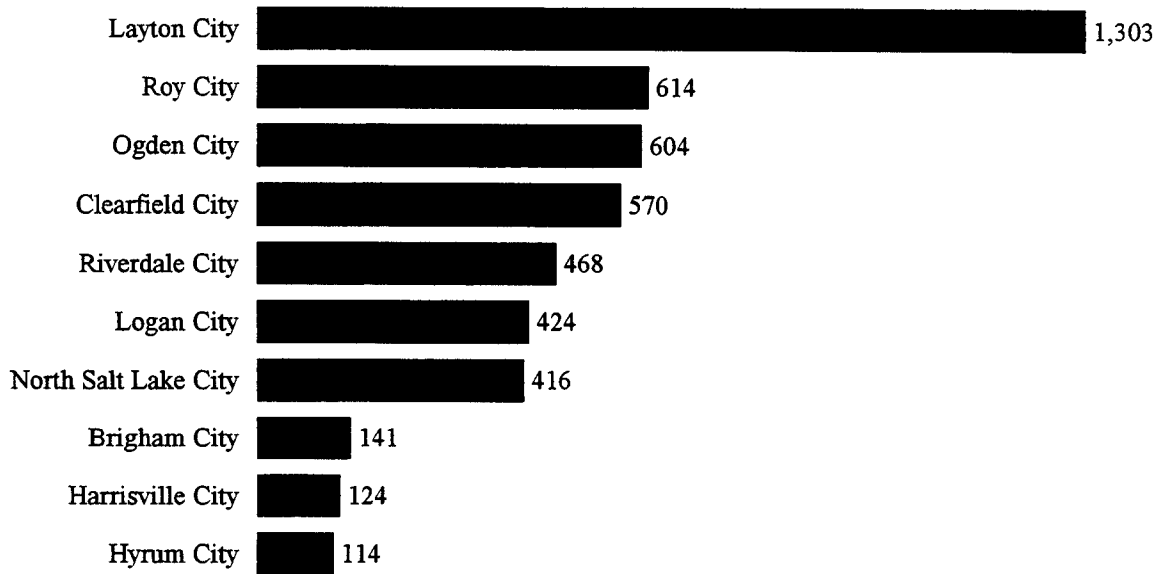

Counties in Golden Spike Association, Utah

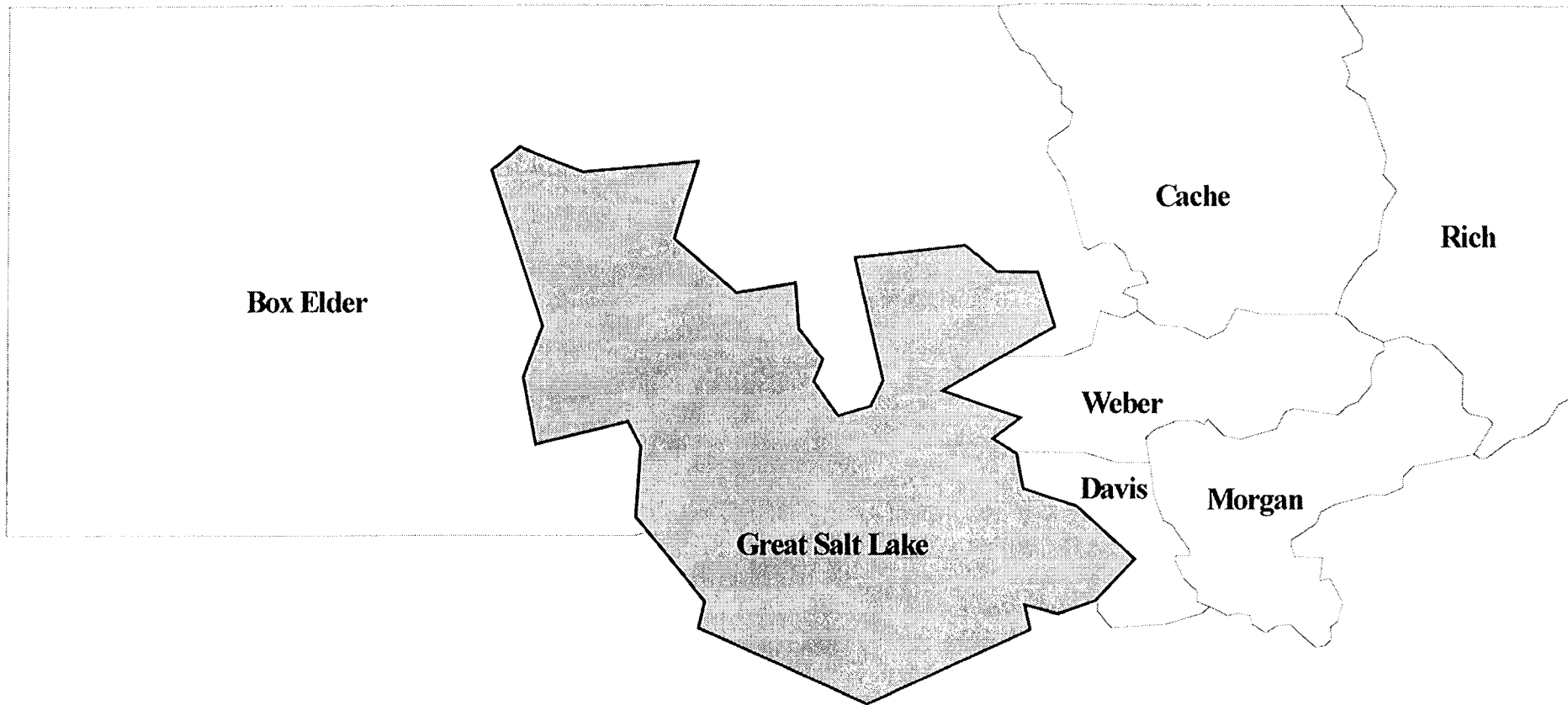

Census Tracts in Box Elder County, Utah

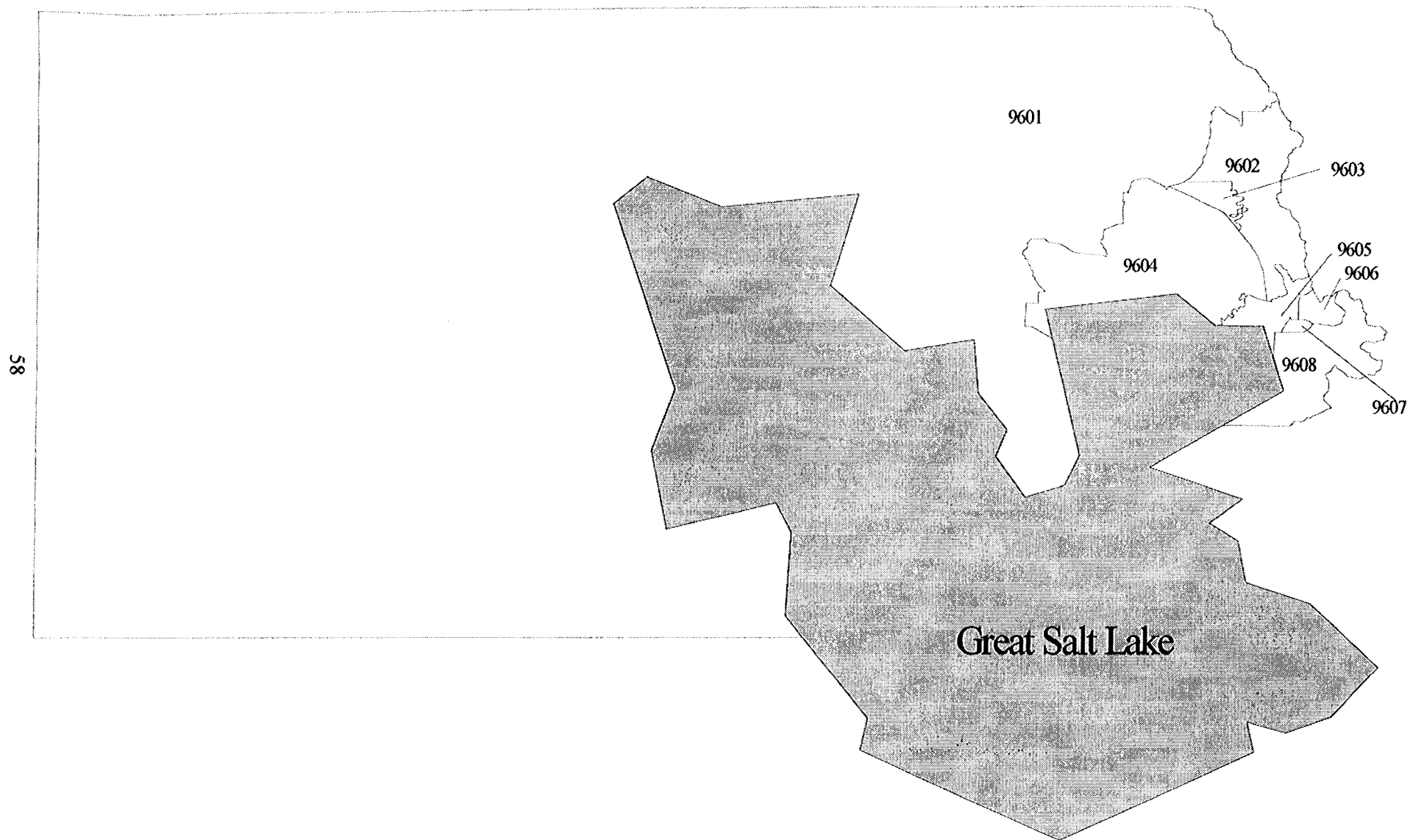

Census Tracts in Cache County, Utah

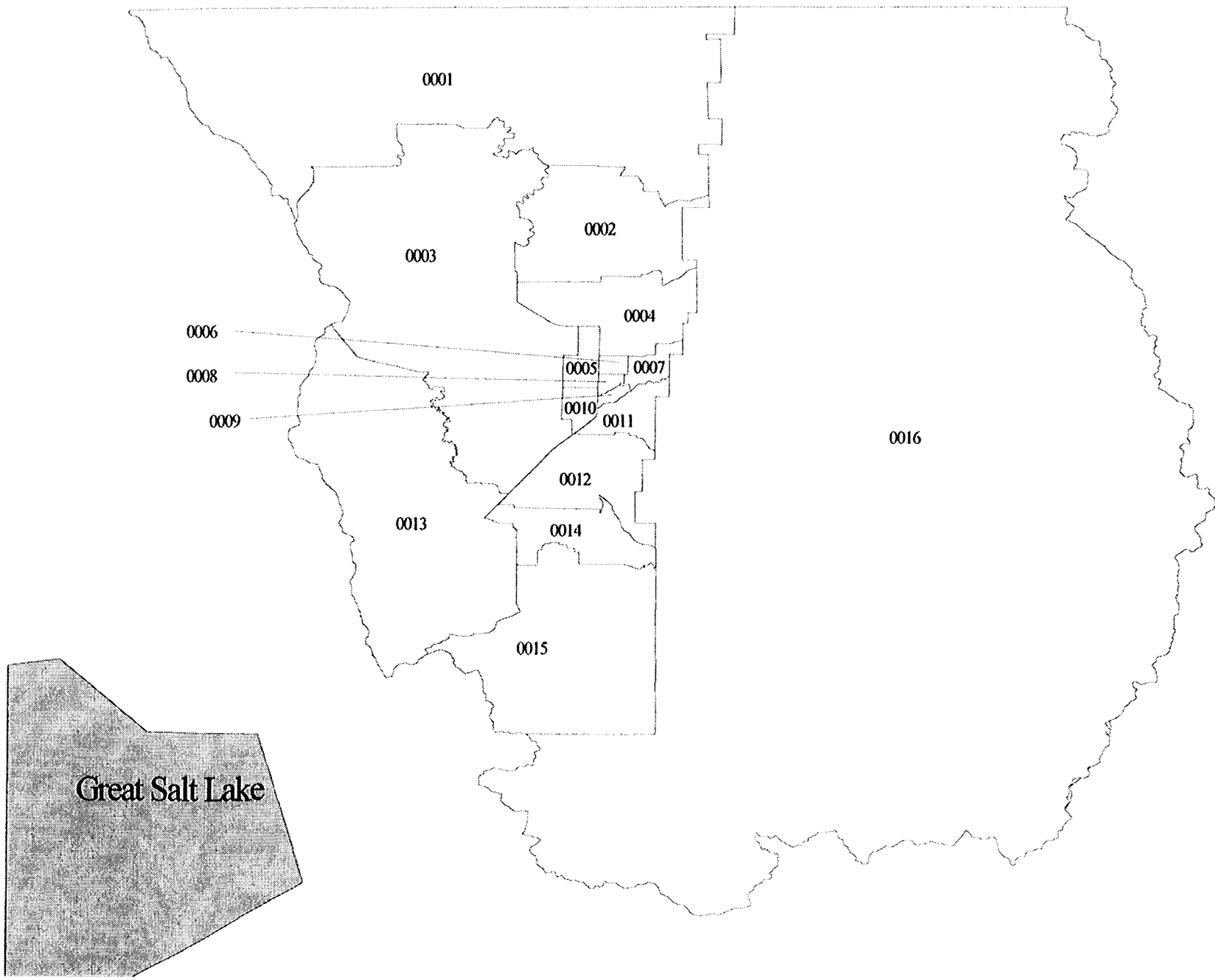

Census Tracts in Davis County, Utah

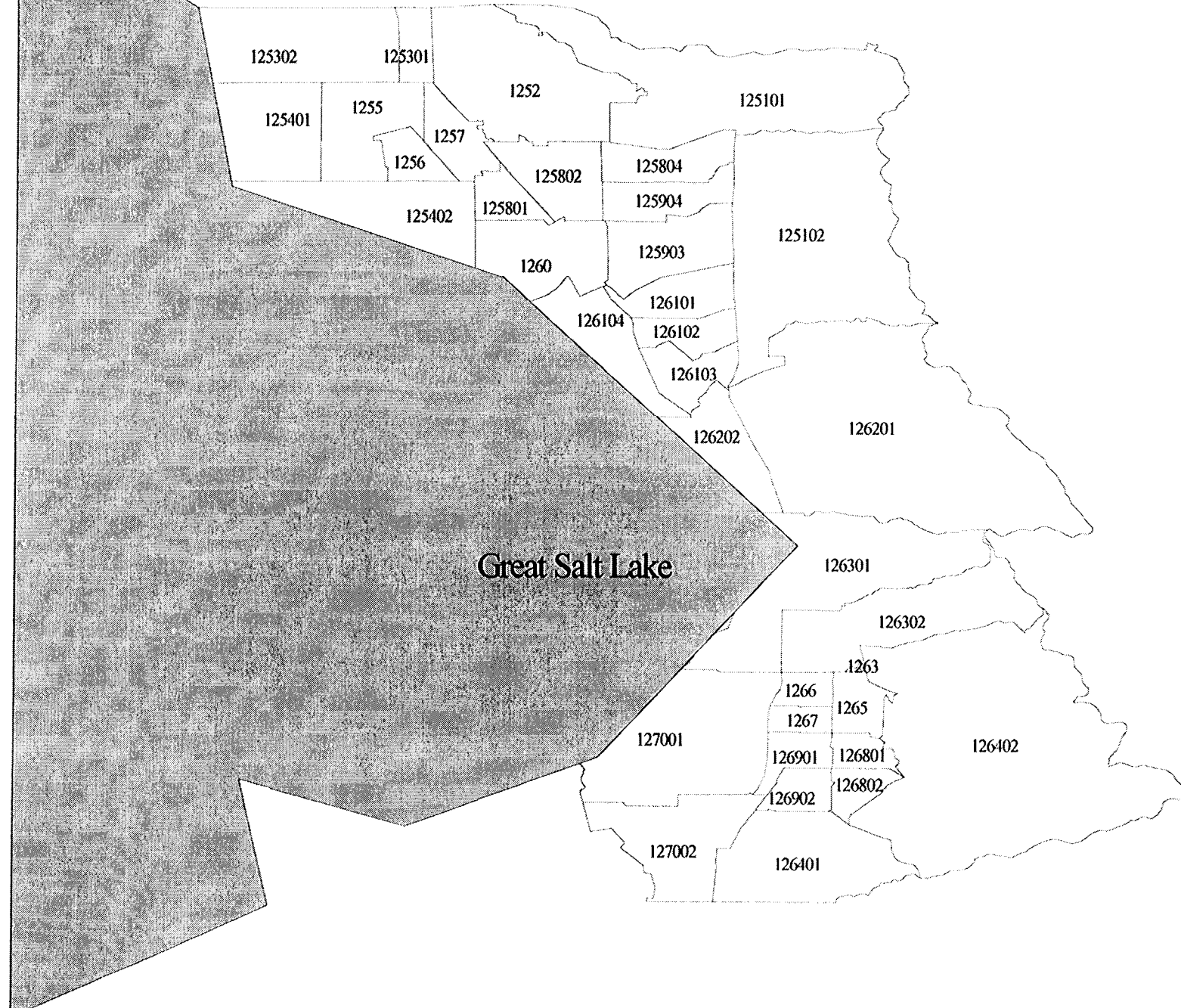
