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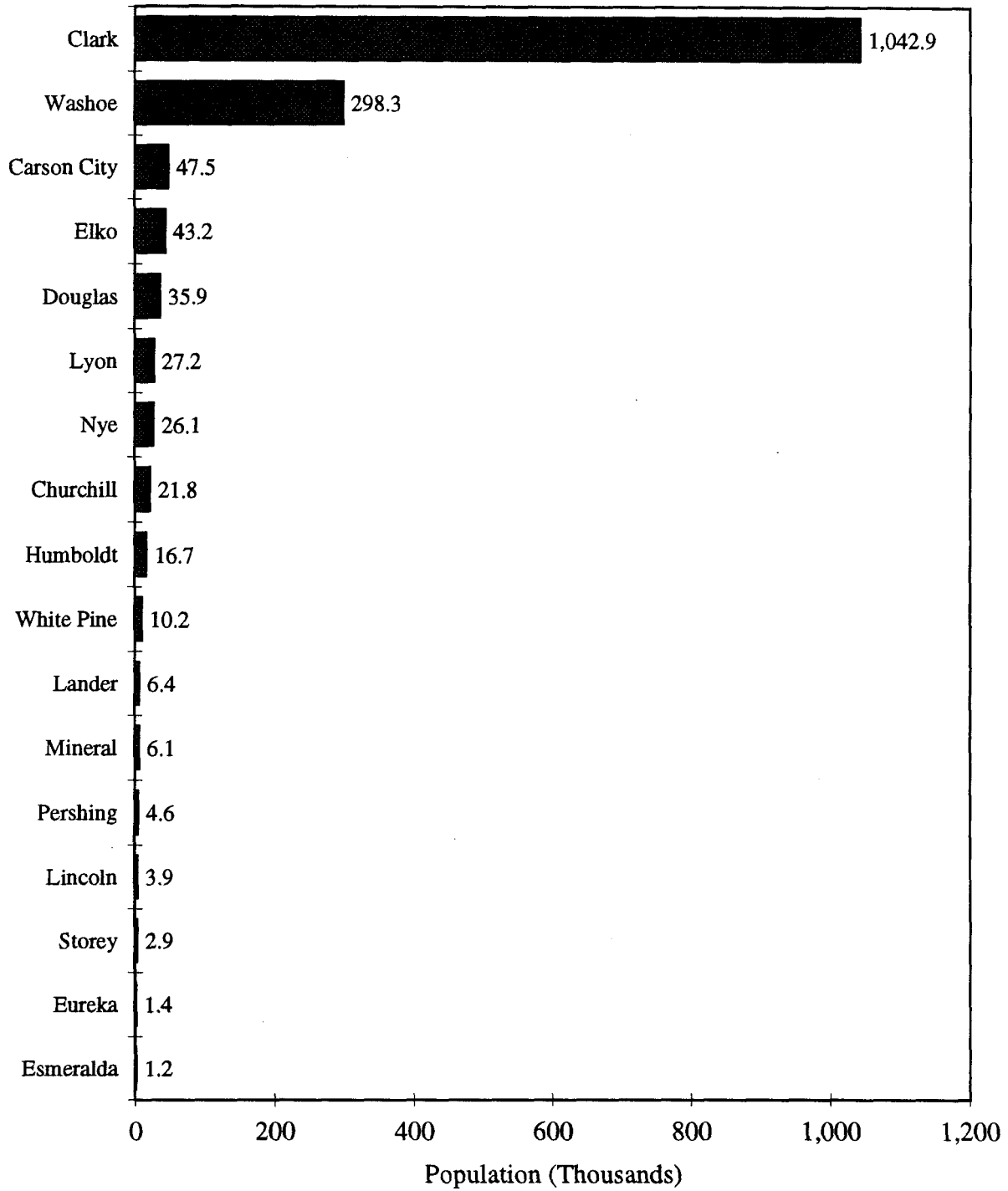

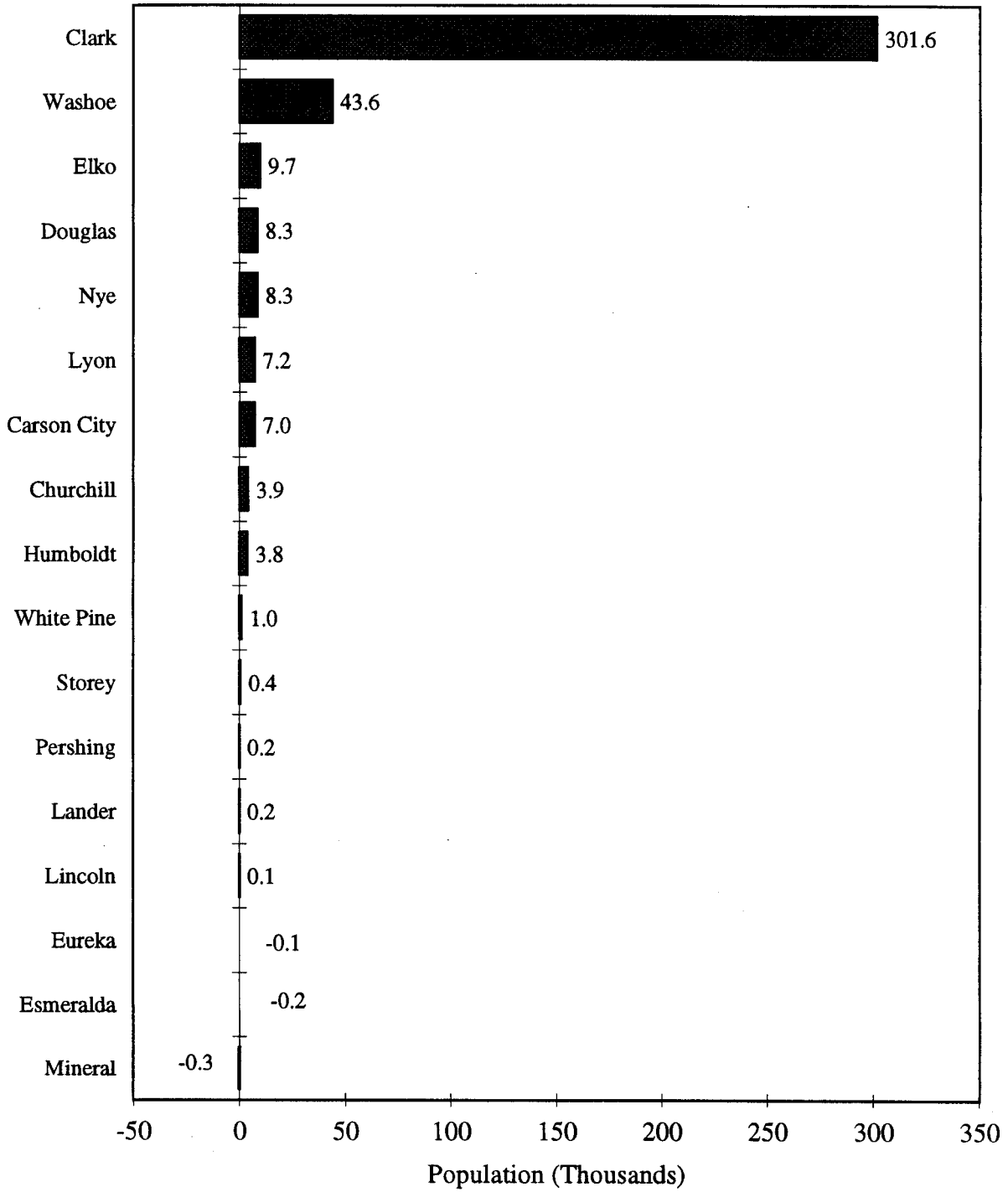

Population 1996



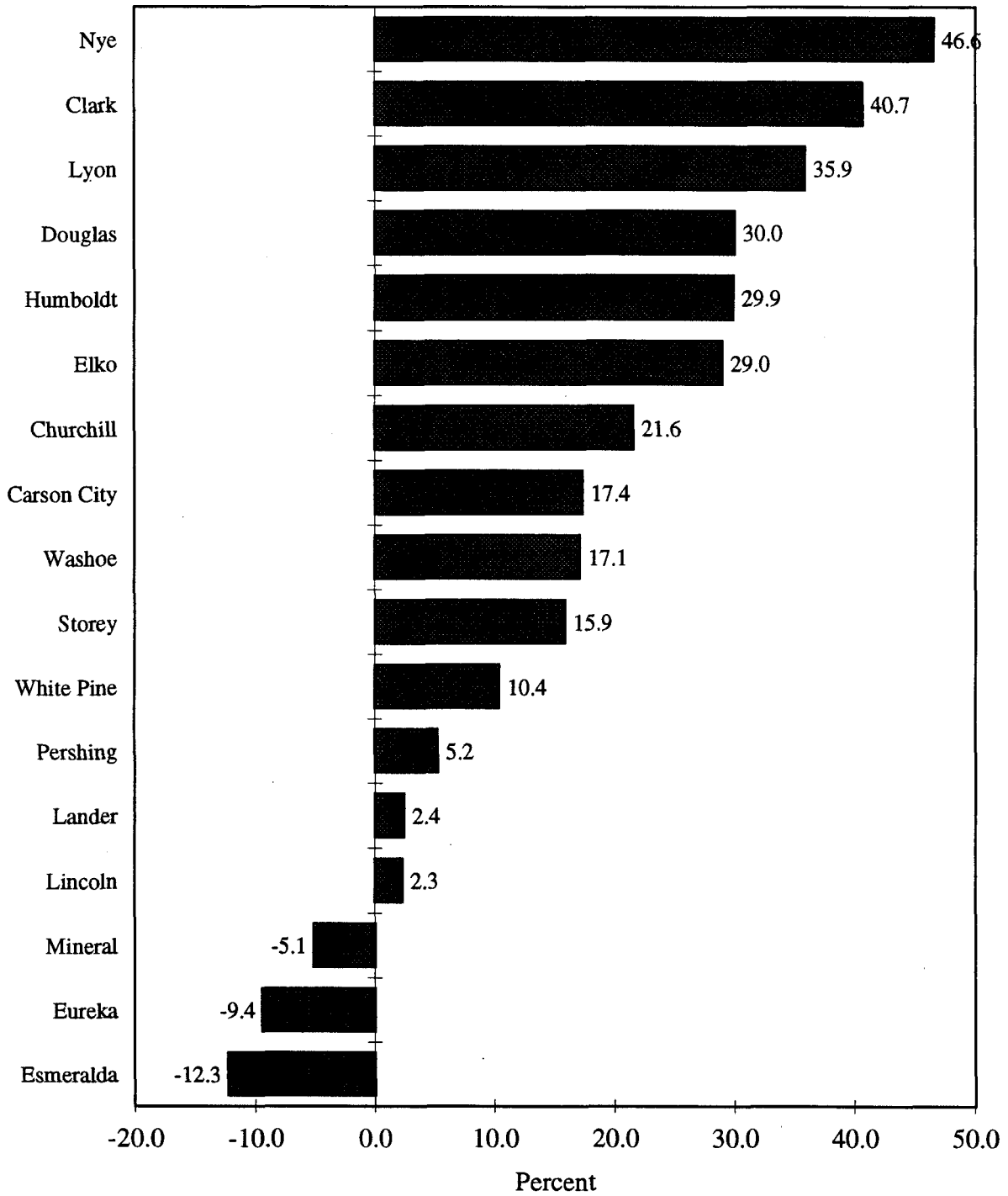

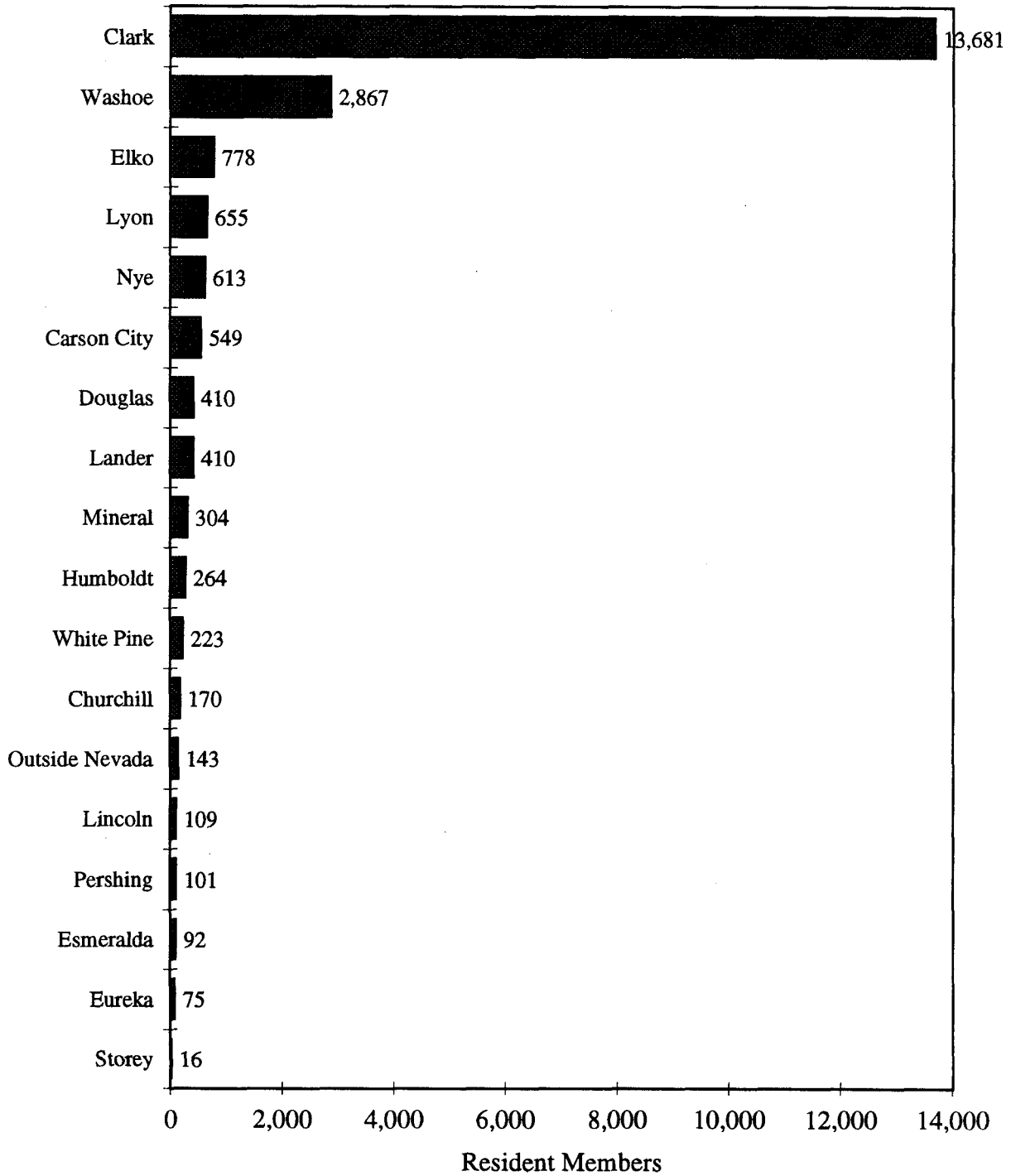

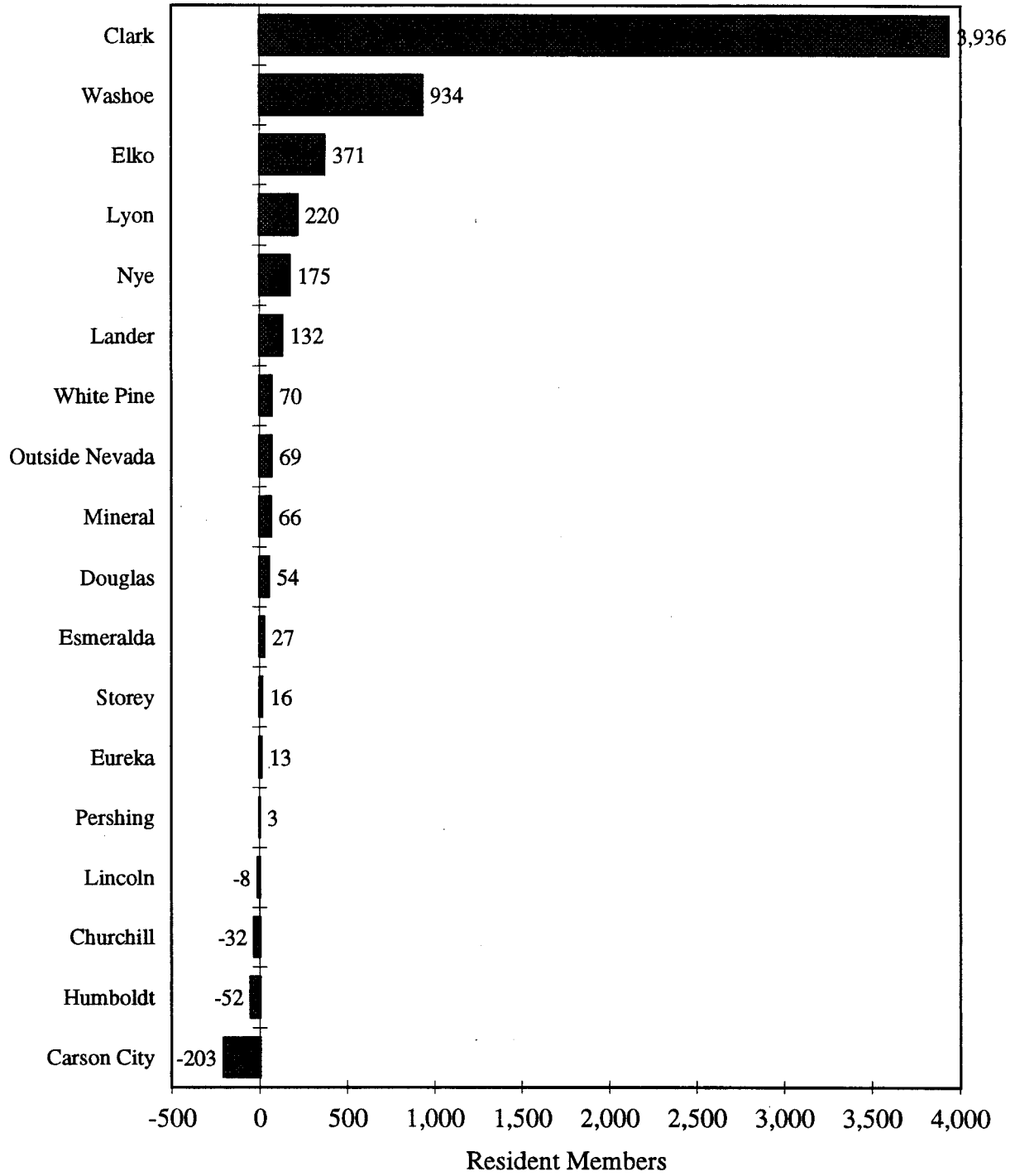

Nevada Baptist Convention Resident Members, 1996



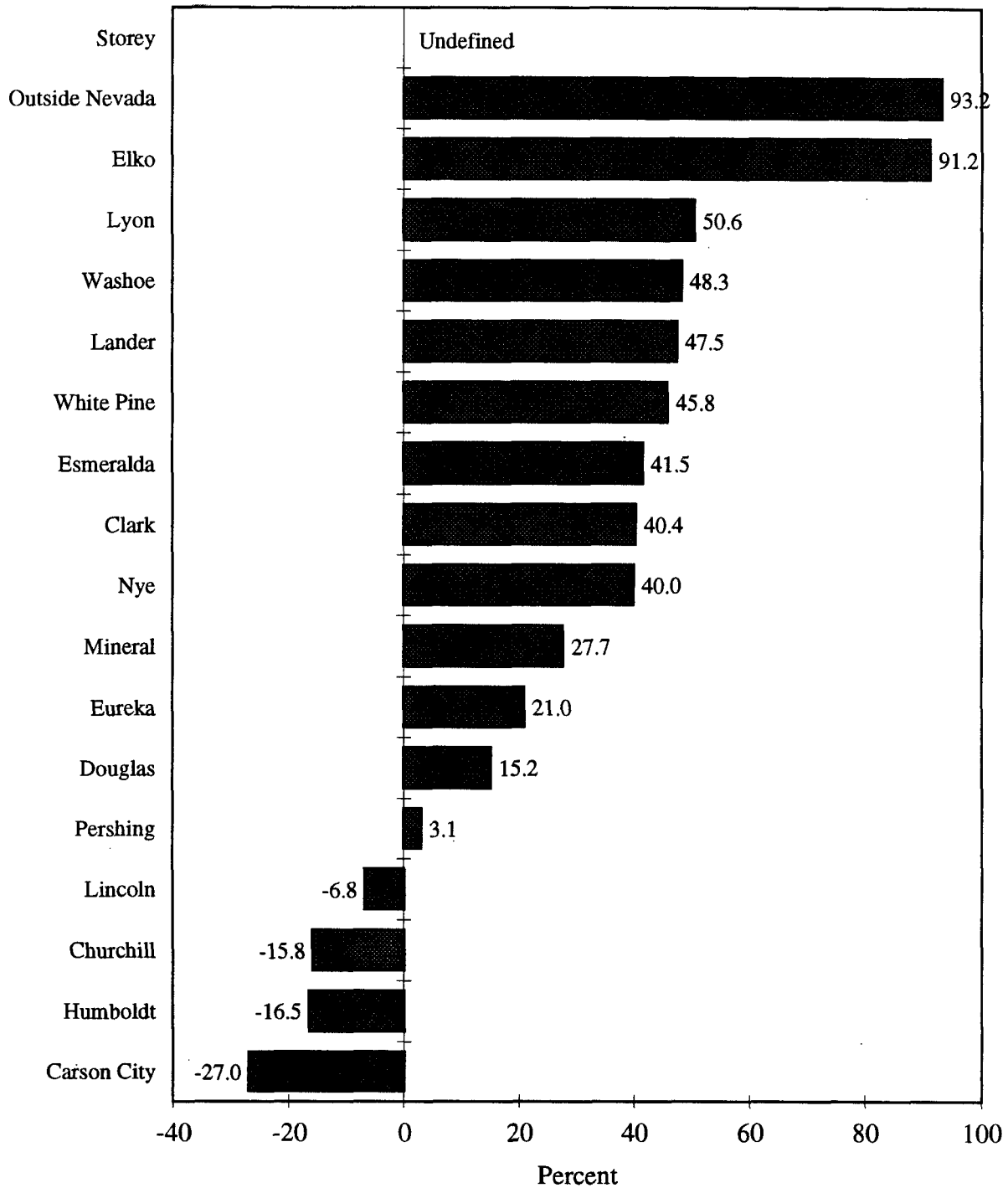

Percentage Change in Resident Members, 1990-1996



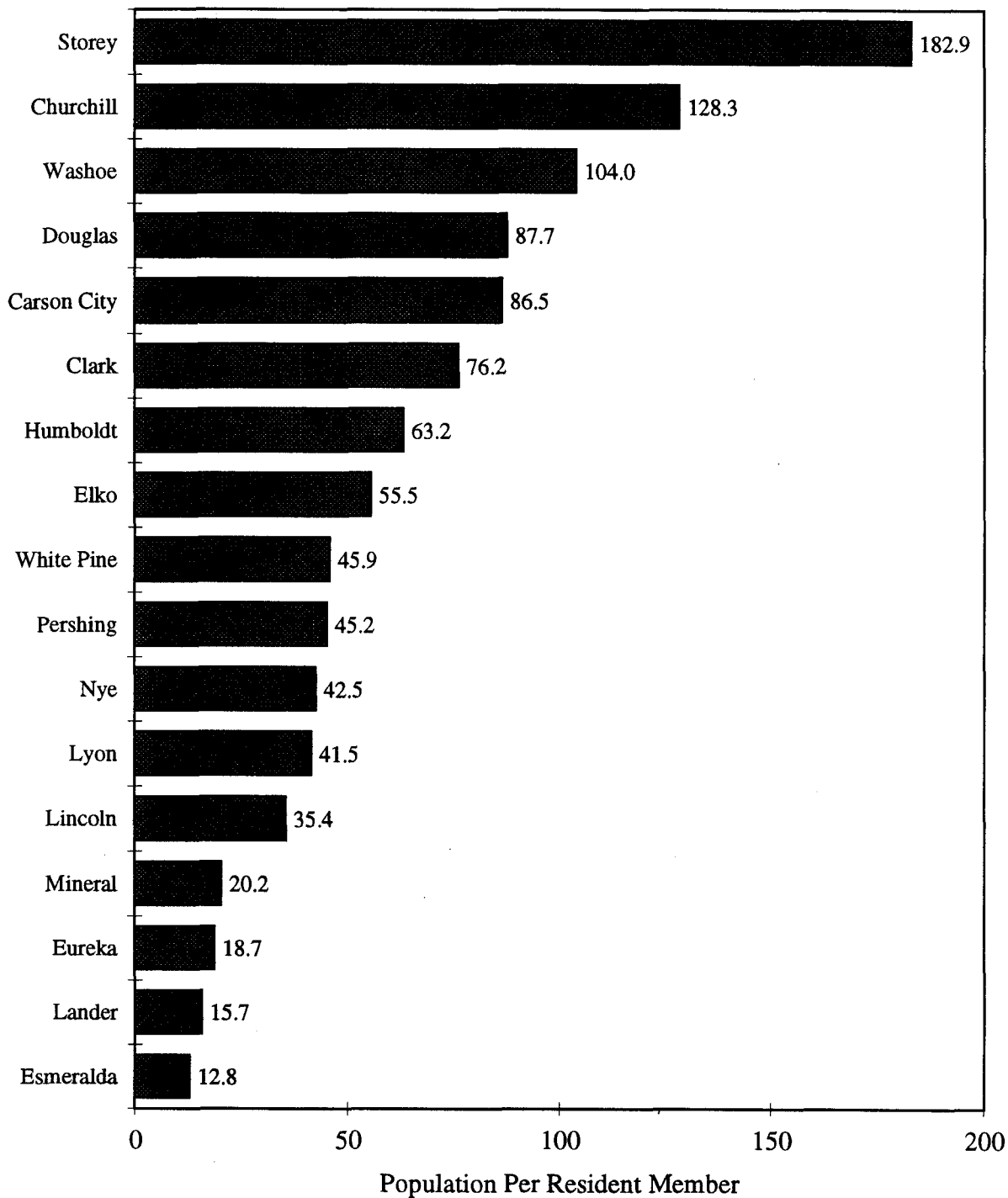

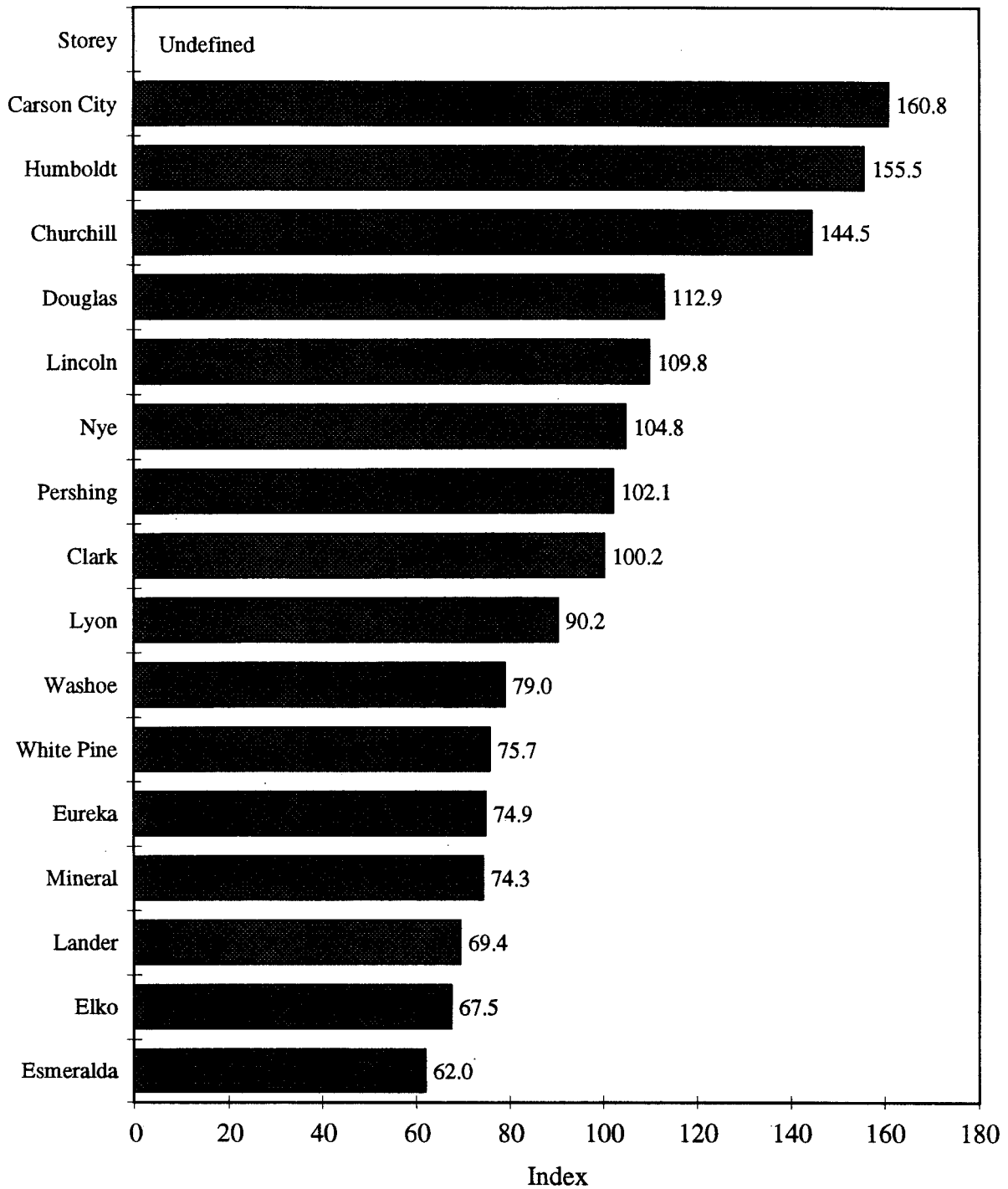

1990-1996



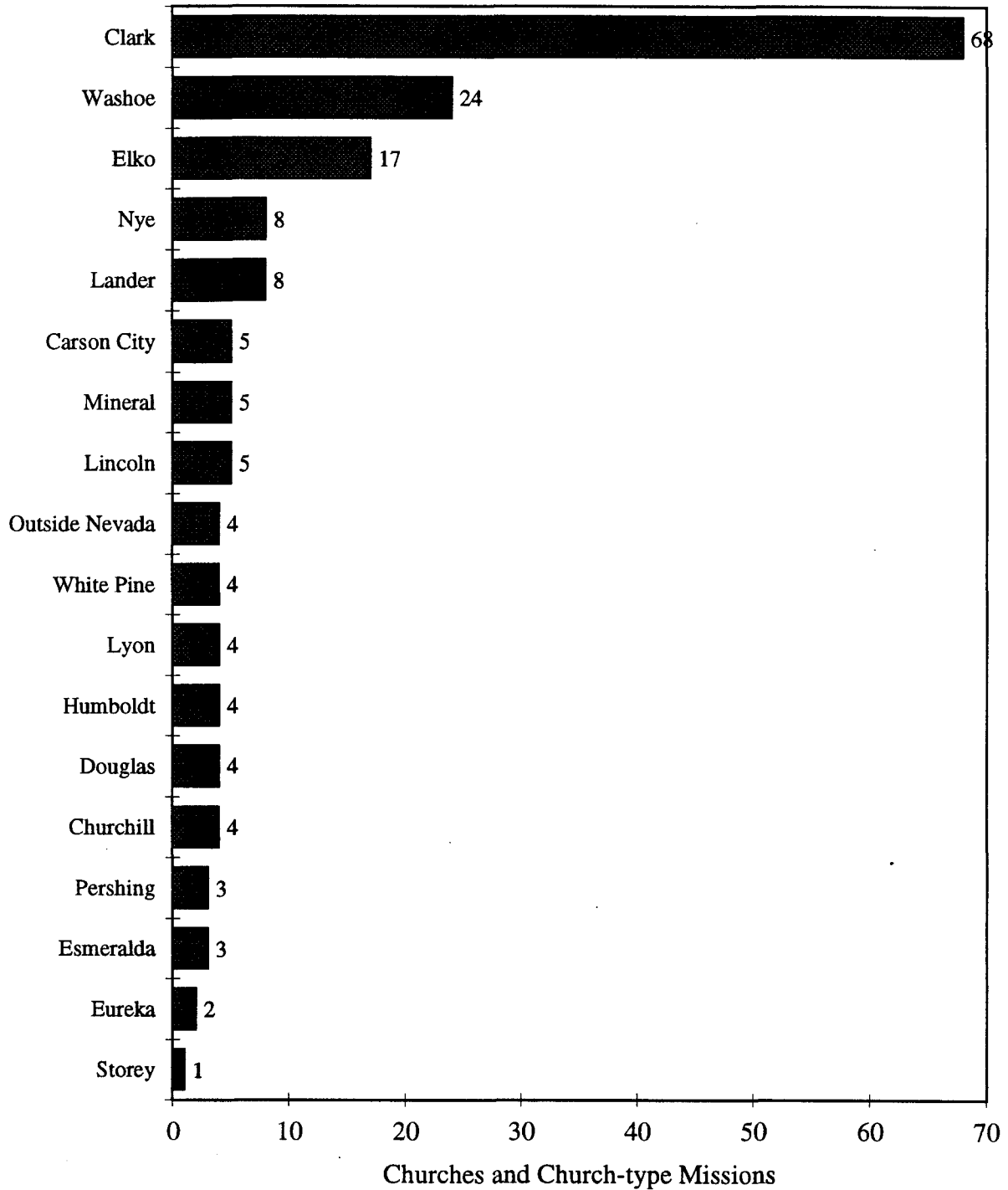

Nevada Baptist Convention Congregations, 1996



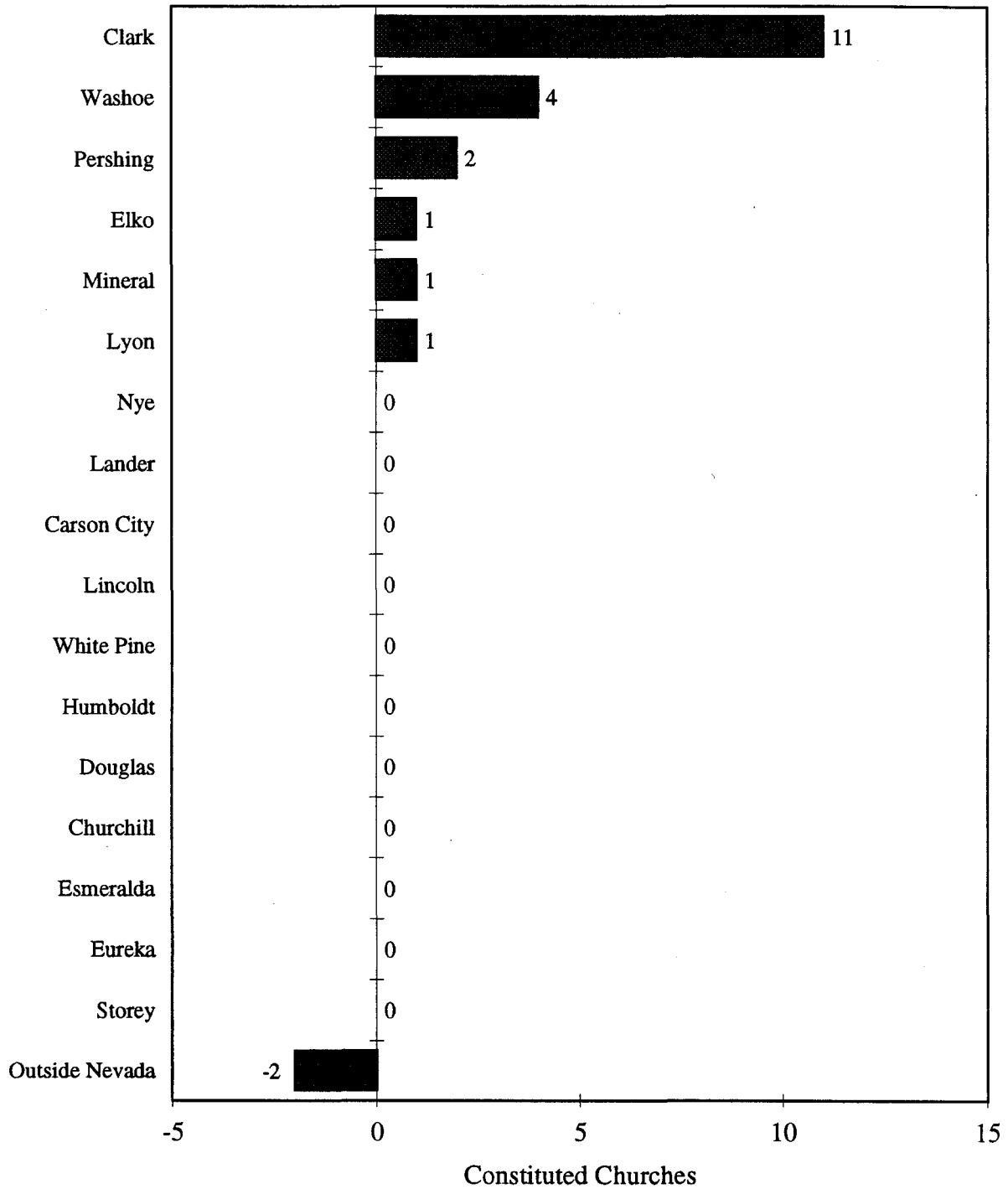

Net Change in Churches, 1990-1996



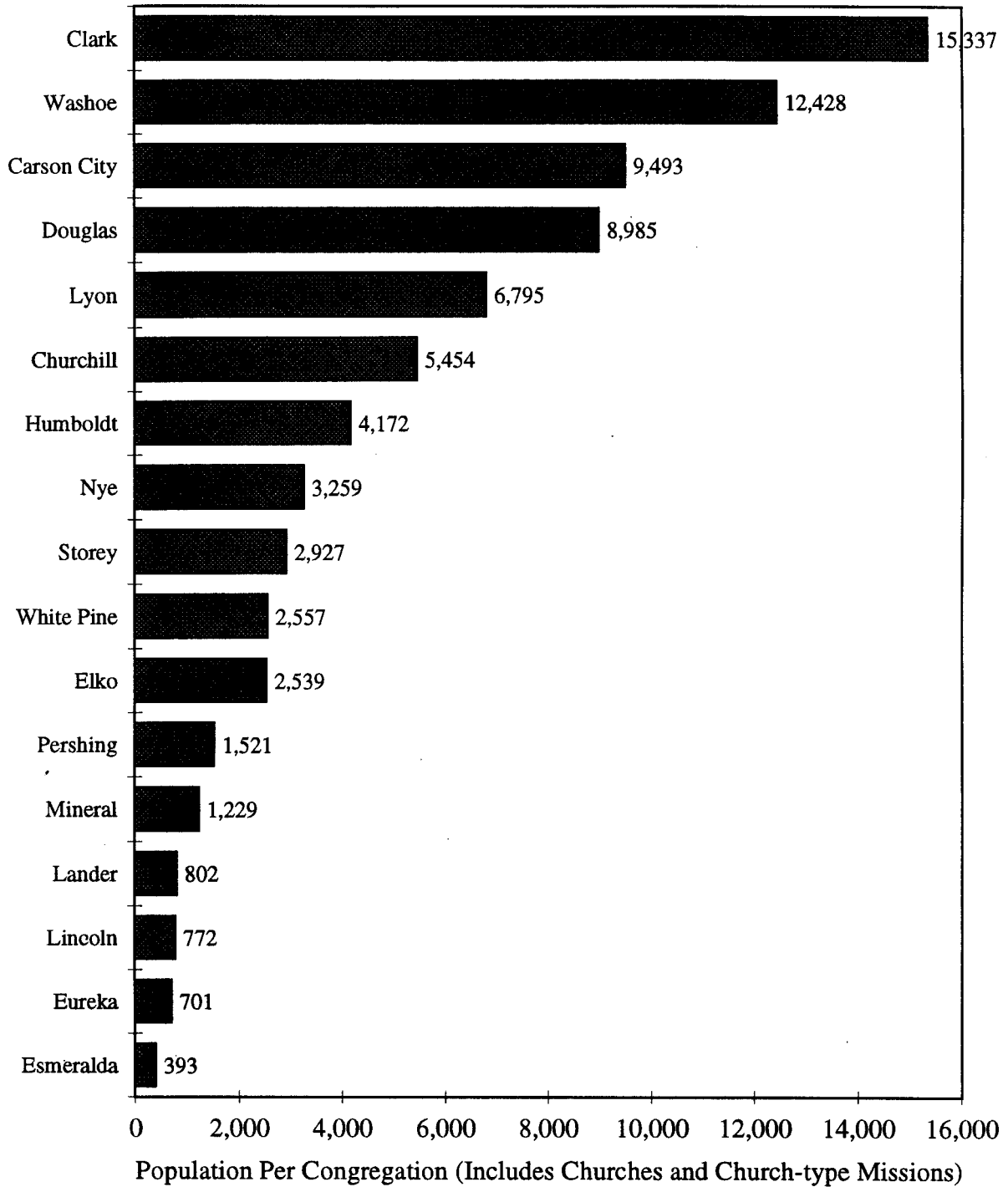

Population Per Nevada Baptist Convention Congregation, 1996



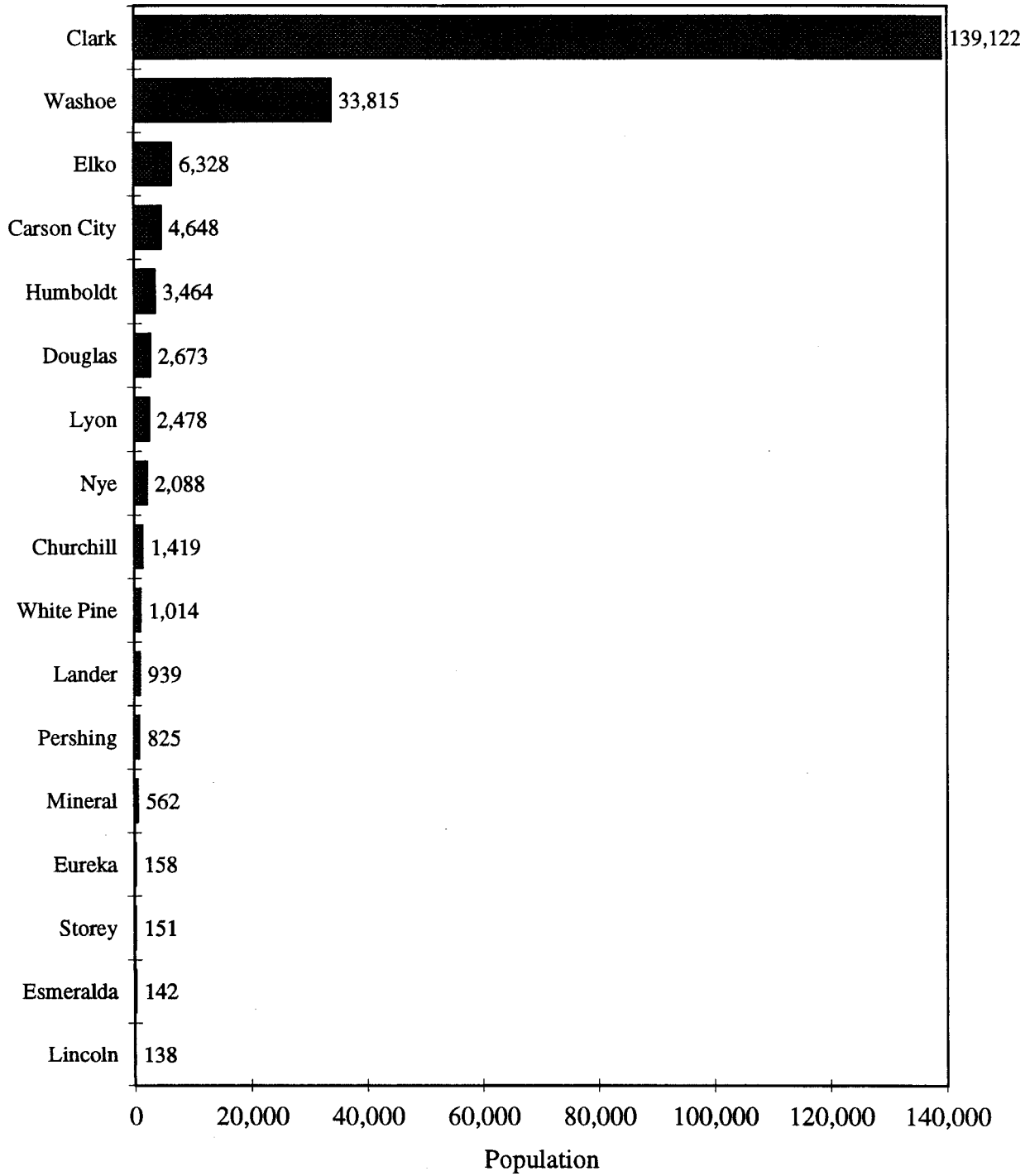

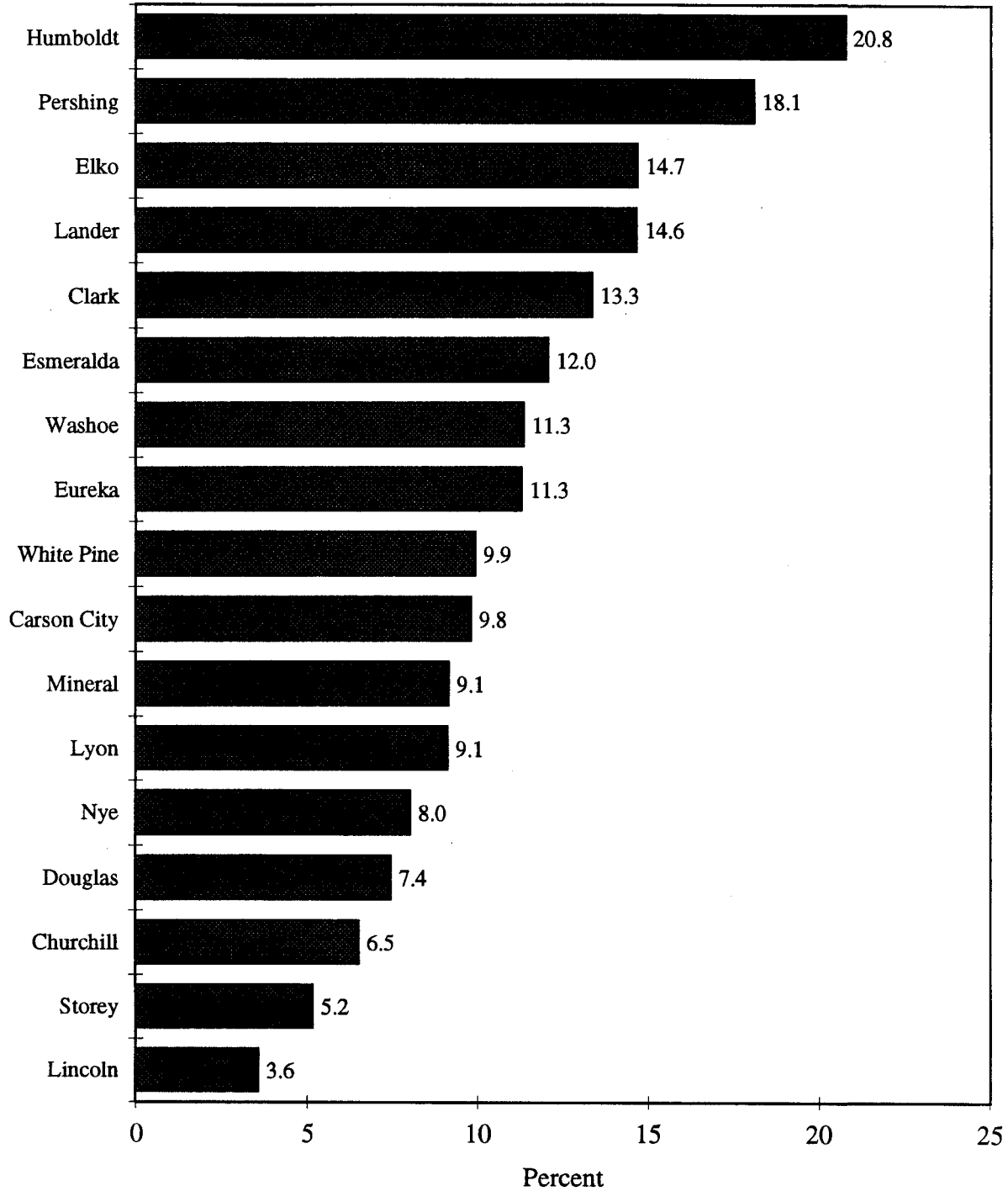

Percent Hispanic Population, 1996



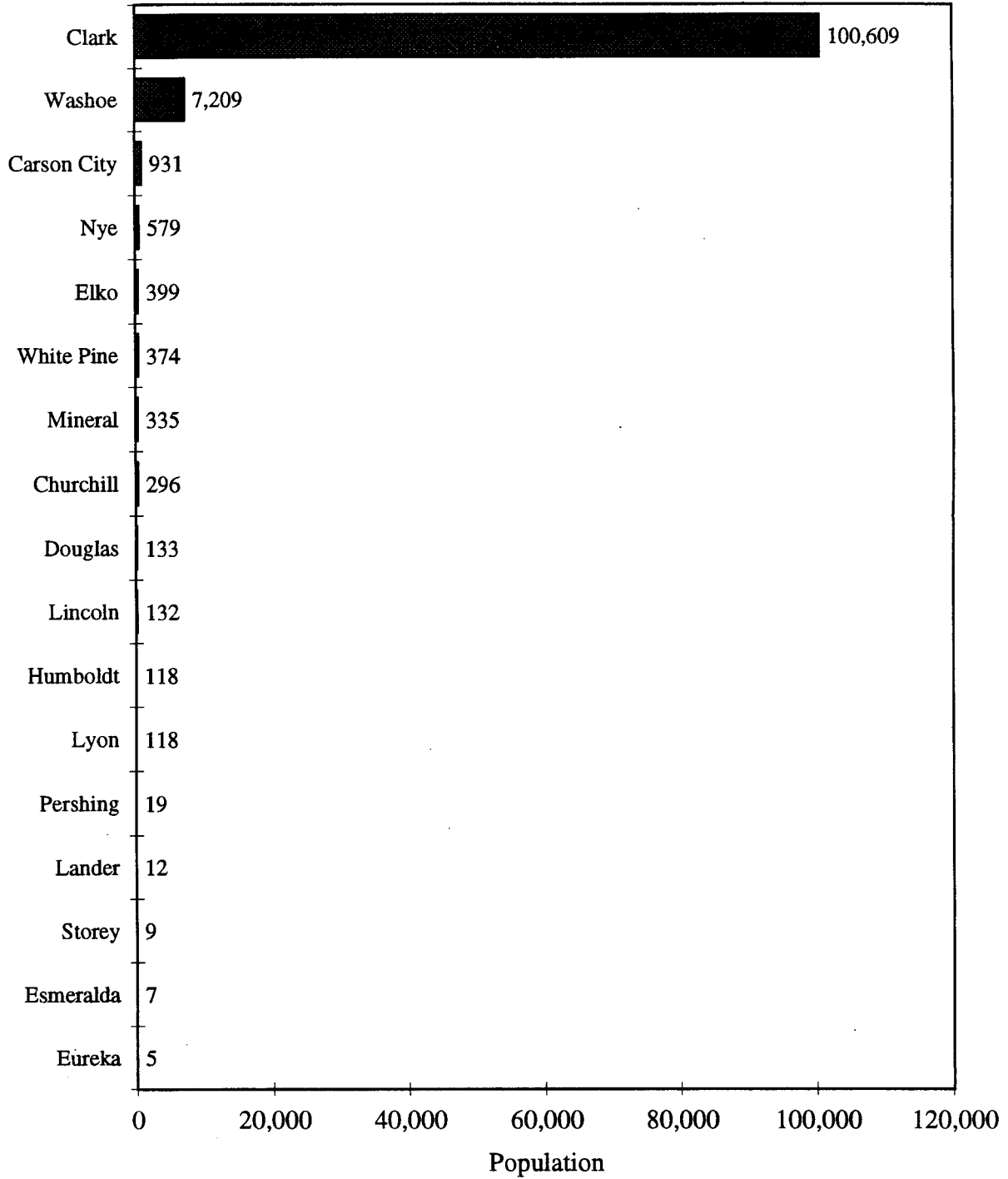

Black Population, 1996



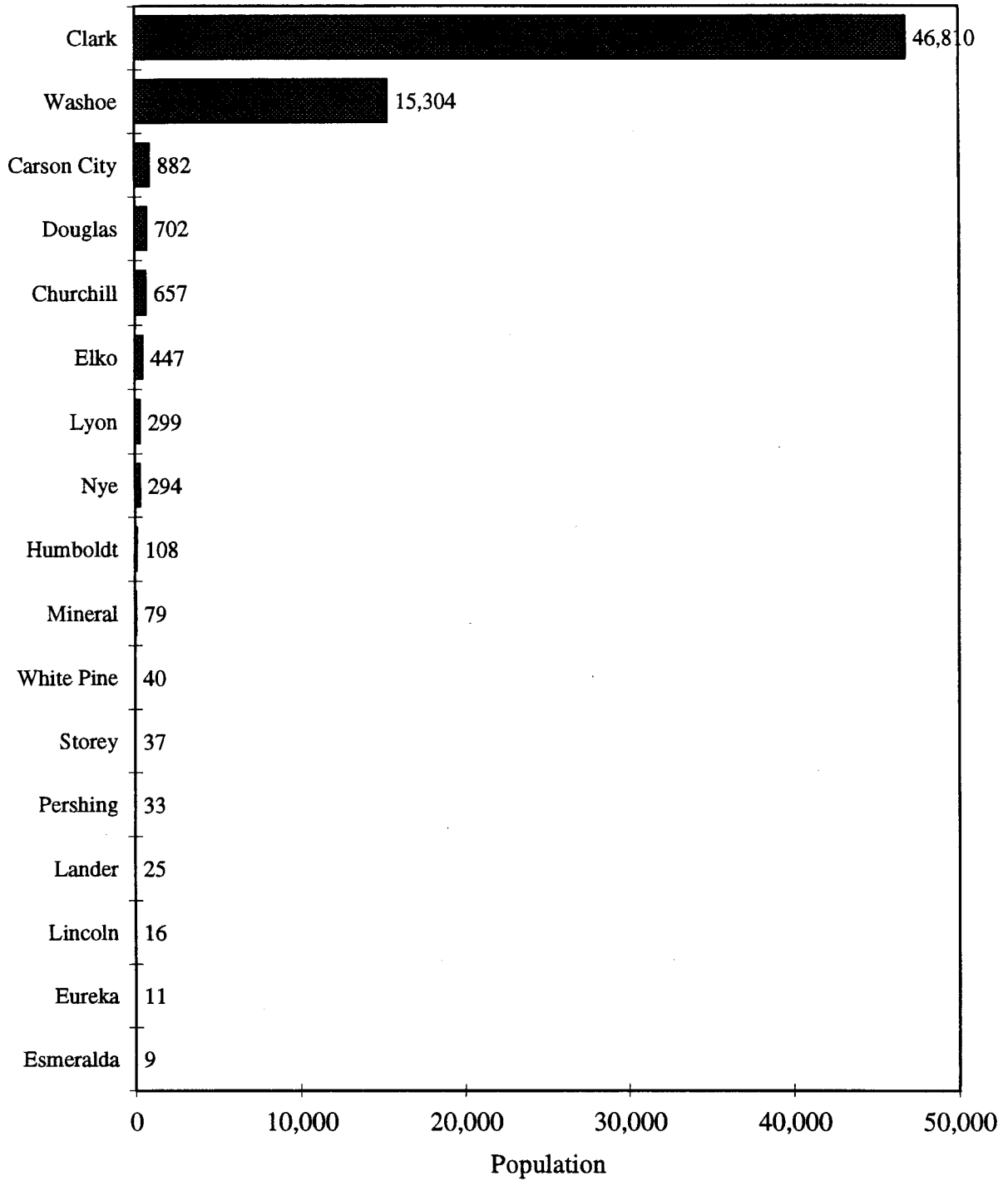

Asian and Pacific Islander Population, 1996



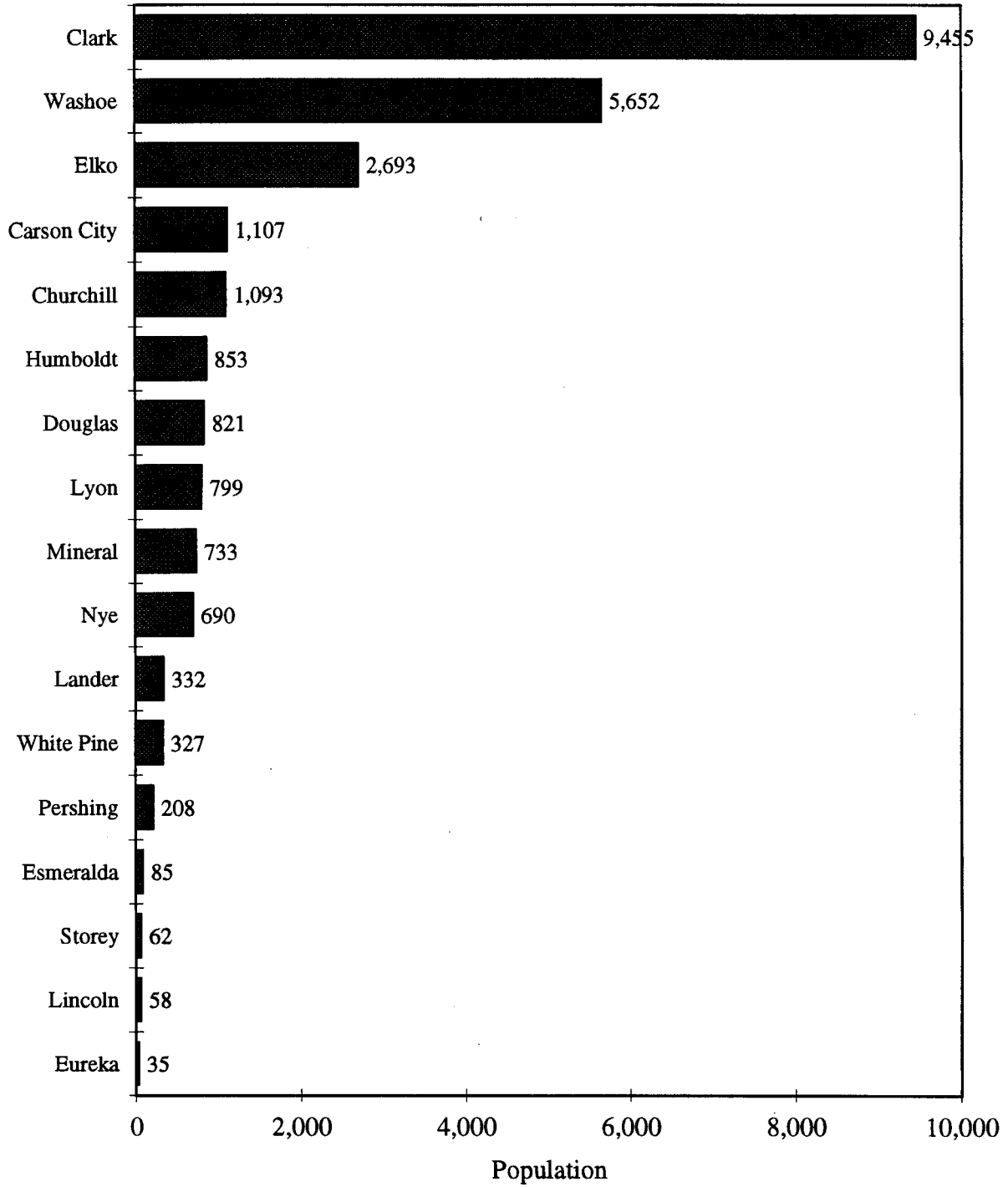
