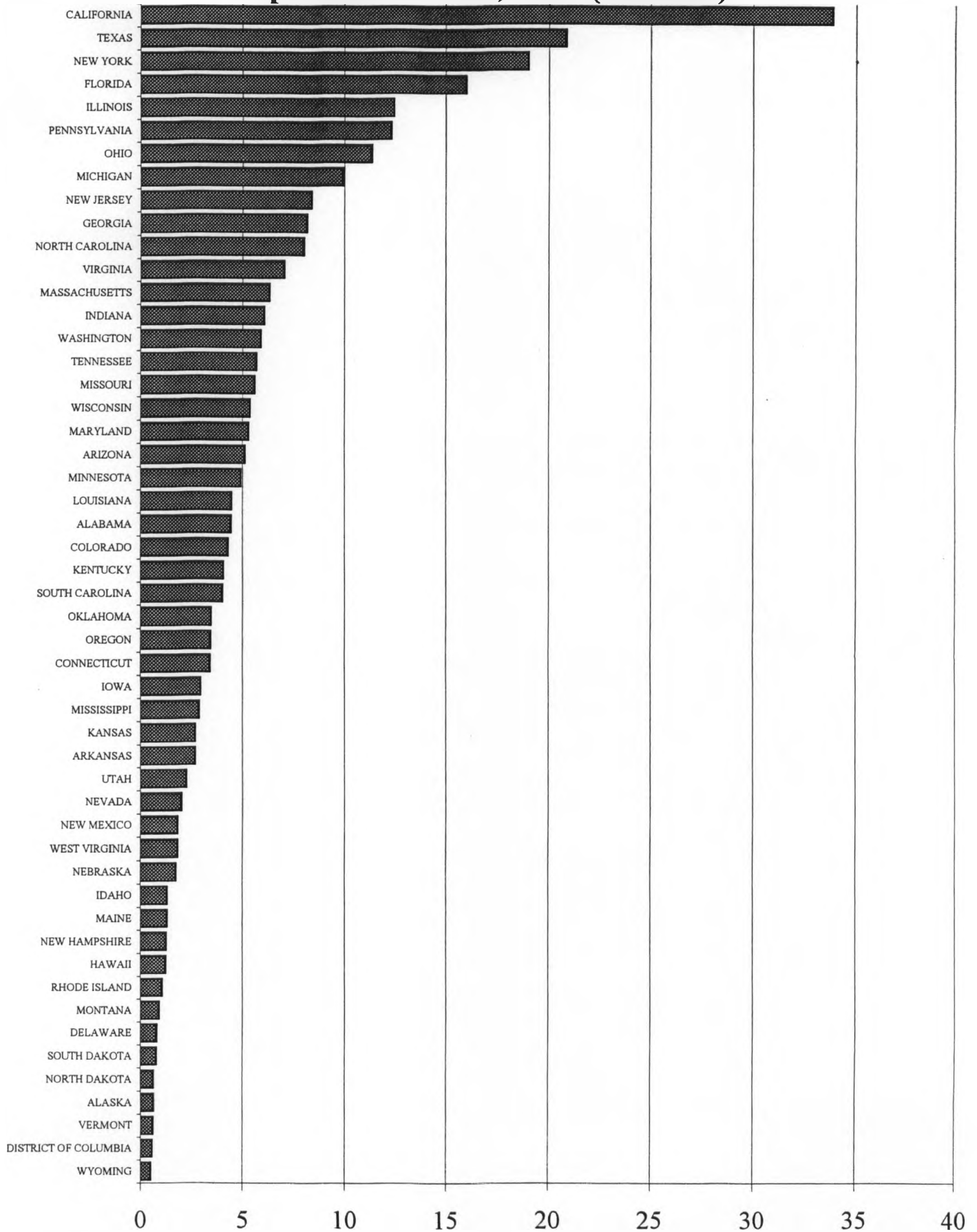

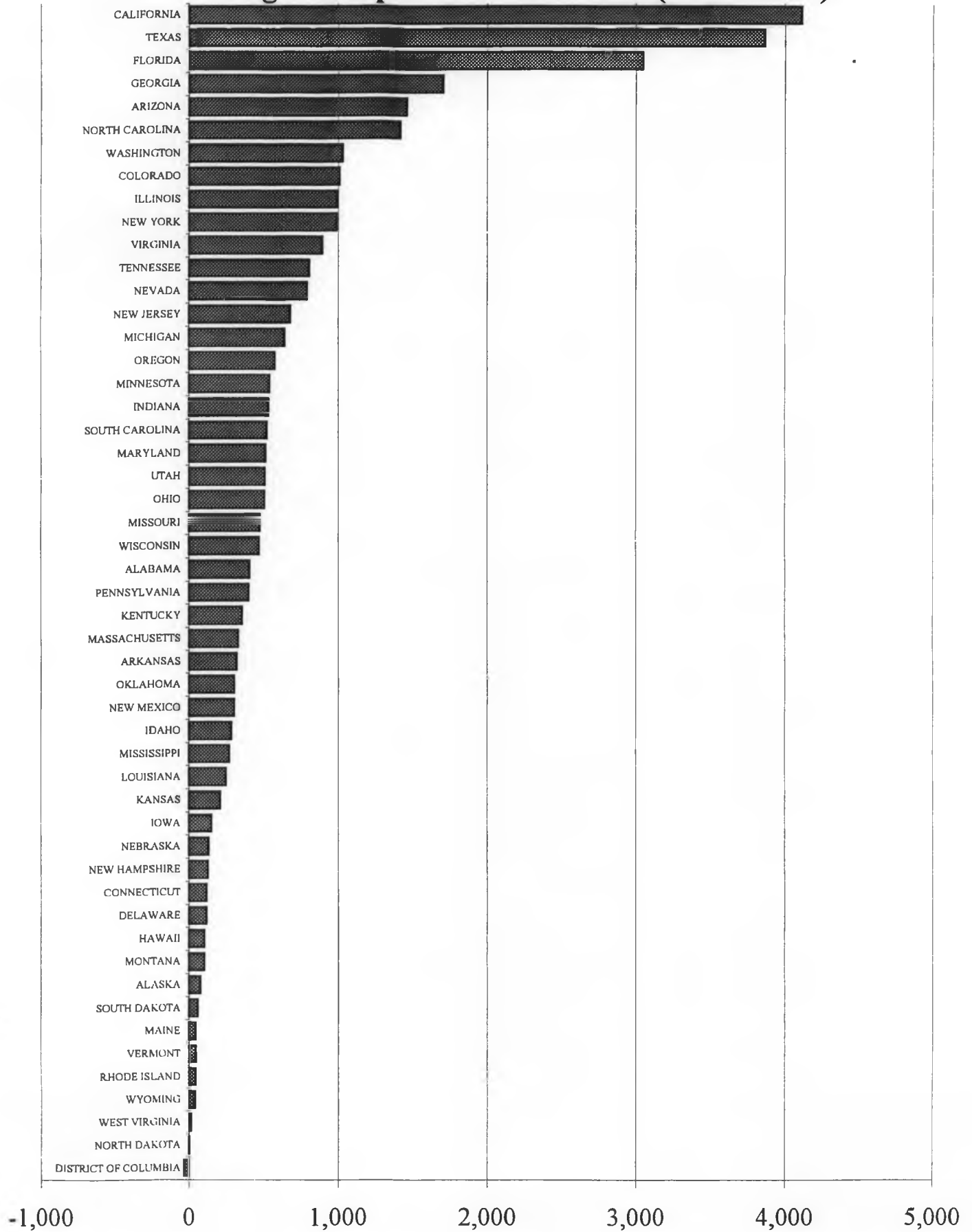

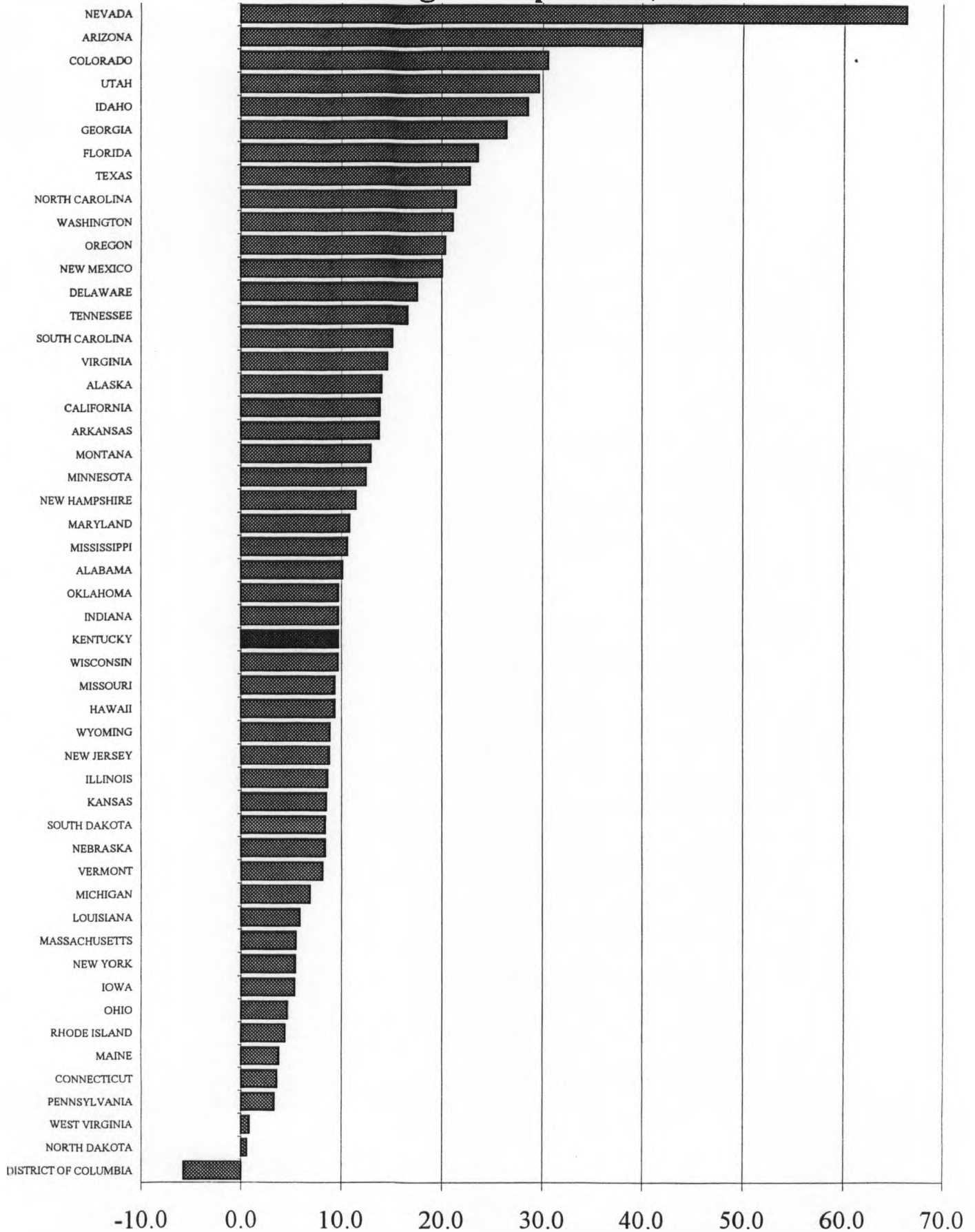
Population Counts, 2000 (Millions)



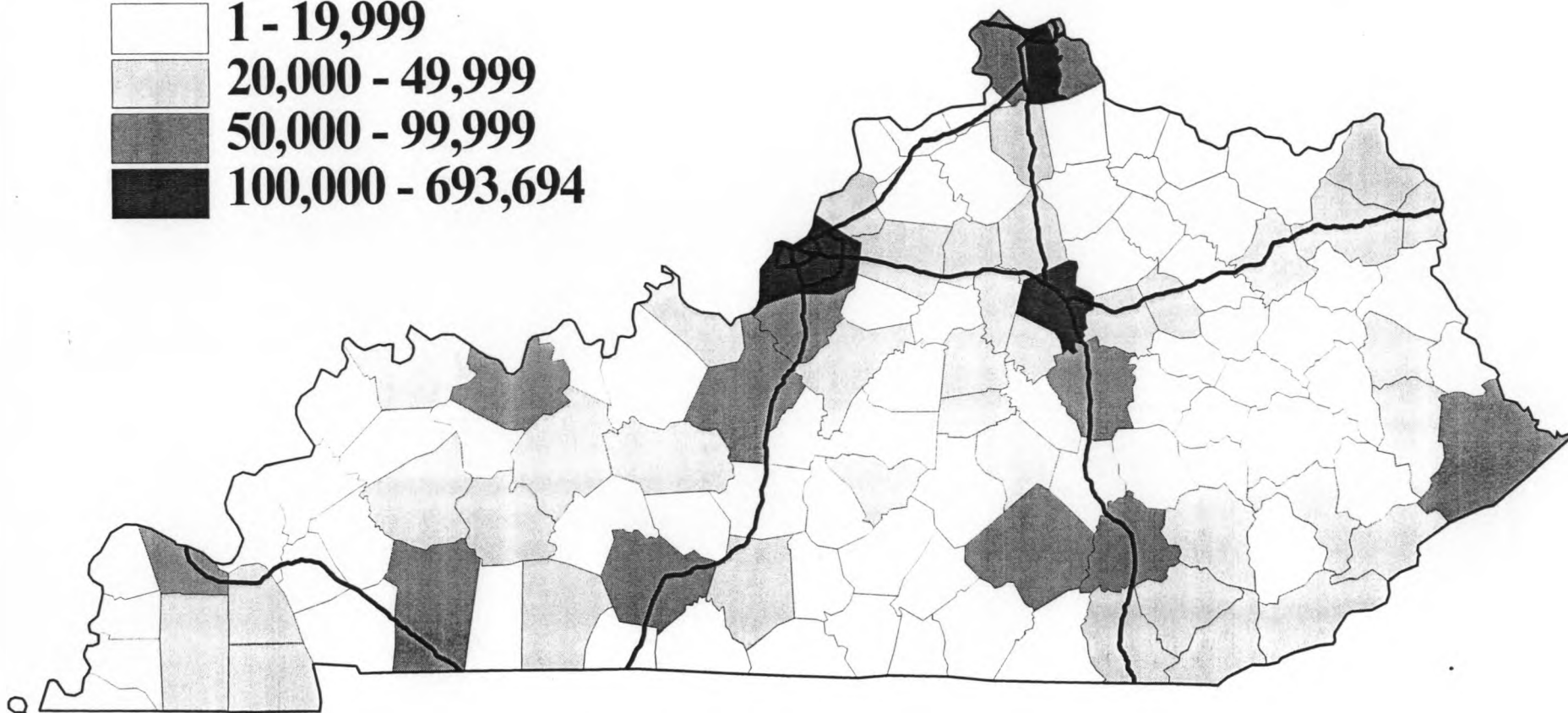
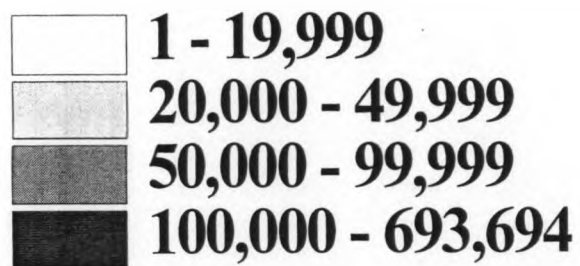
Net Change in Population 1990-2000 (Thousands)

Net Change in Total Population, 1990 to 2000

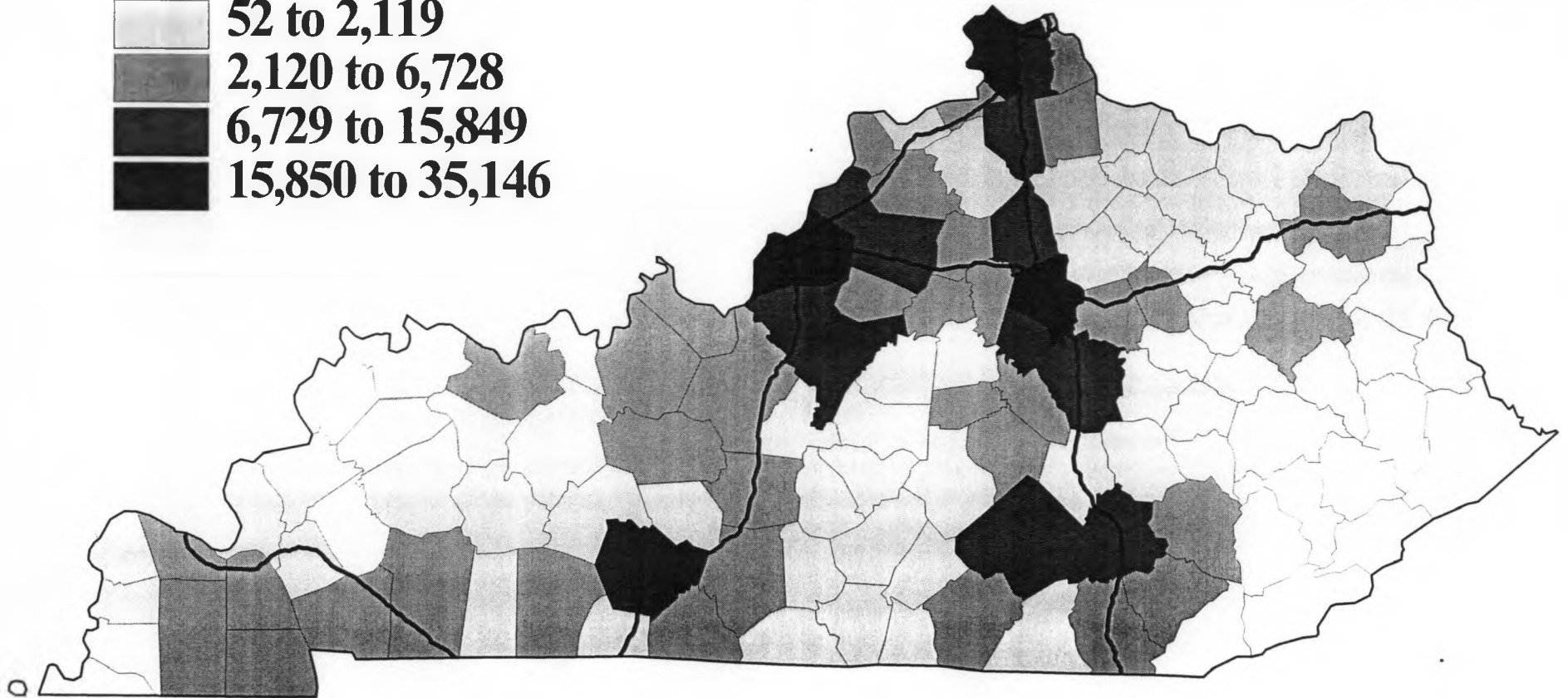

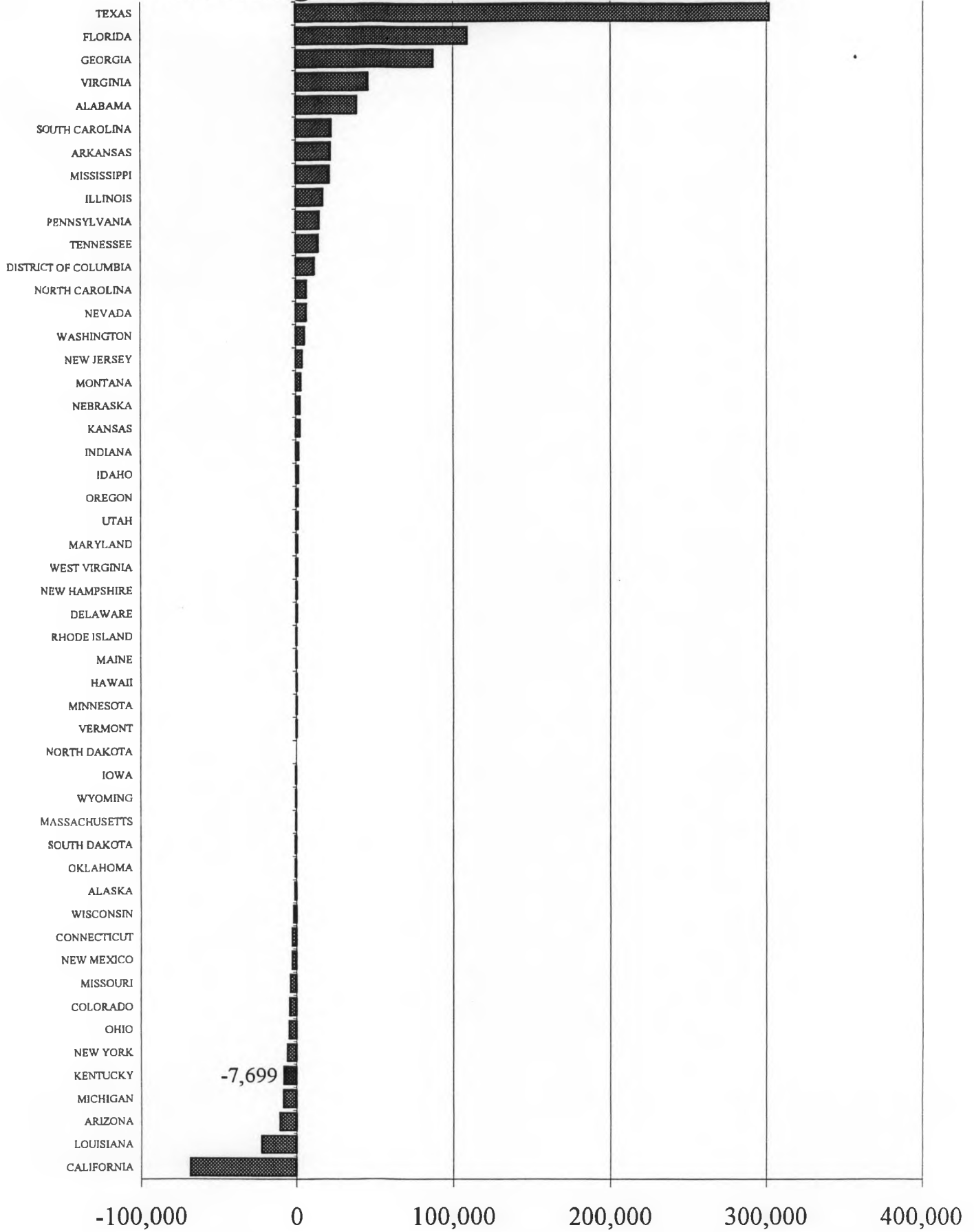

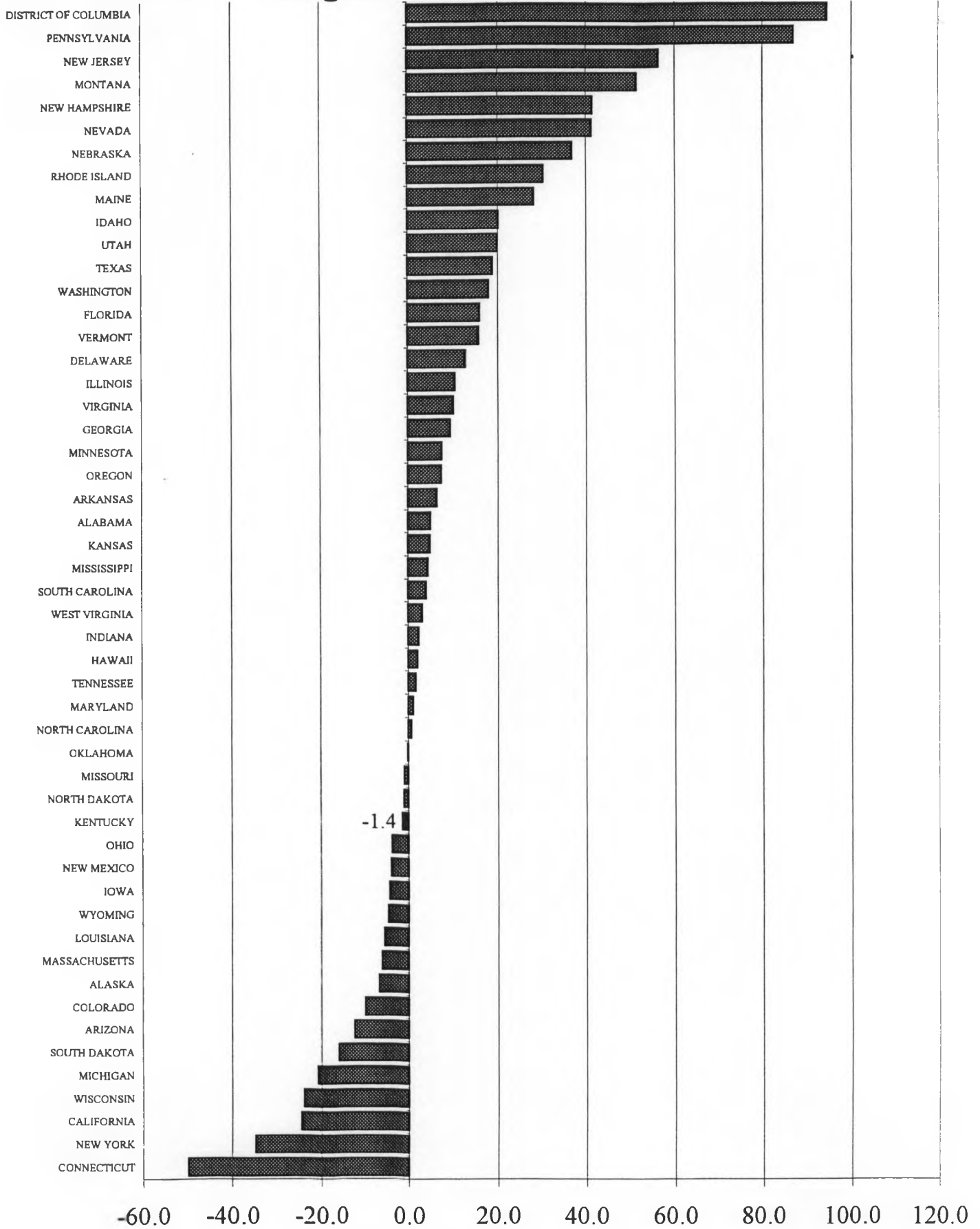
Southern Baptist Resident Members, 2000 (Thousands)



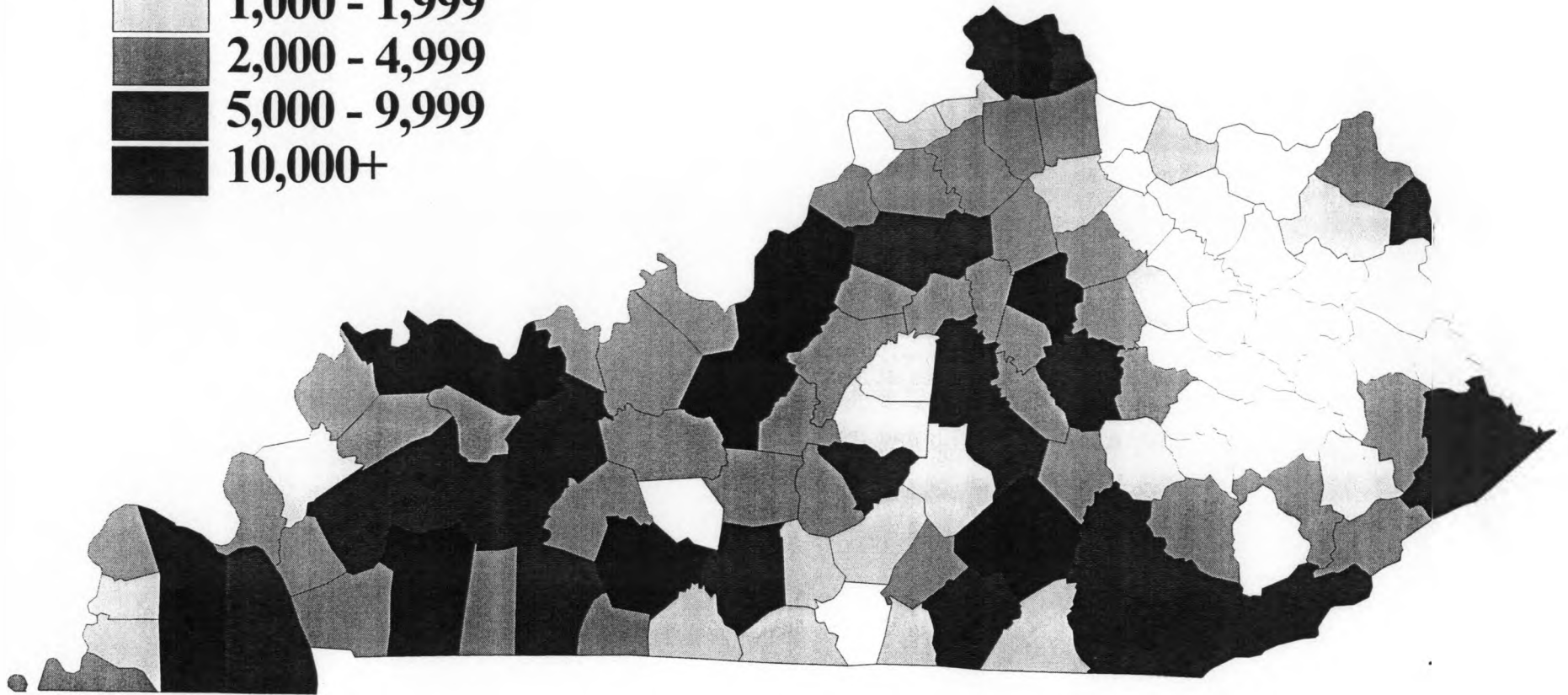
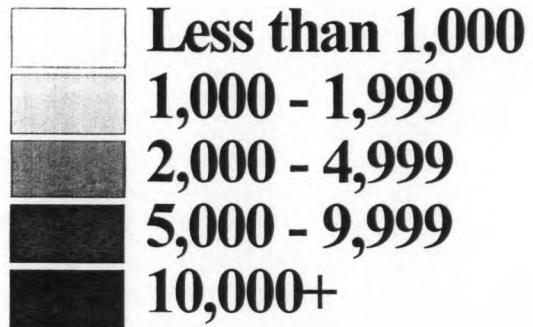
Net Change in Resident Members, 1990-2000



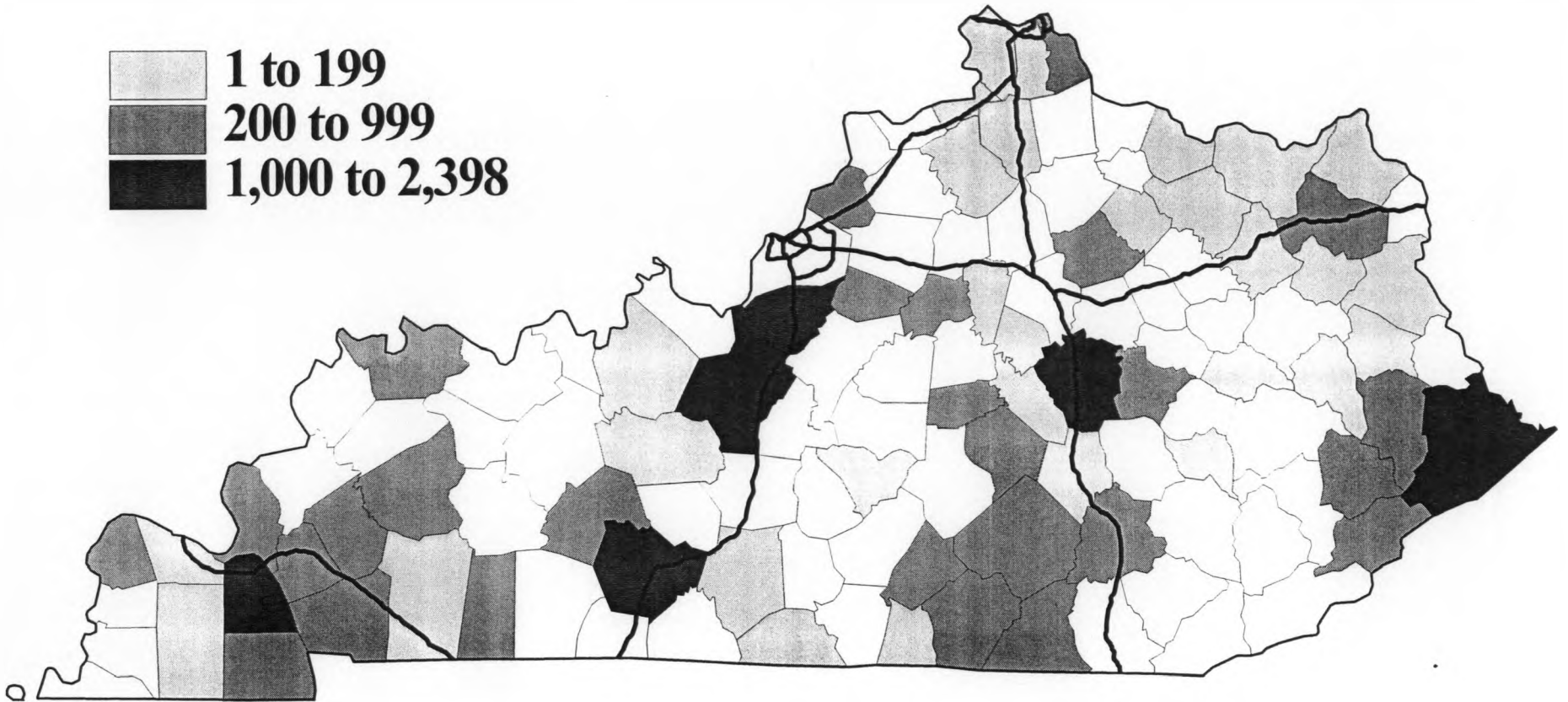
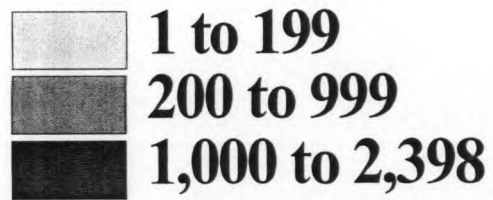
Percent Change In Resident Members, 1990-2000

Loss in Resident Members, 1990 - 2000

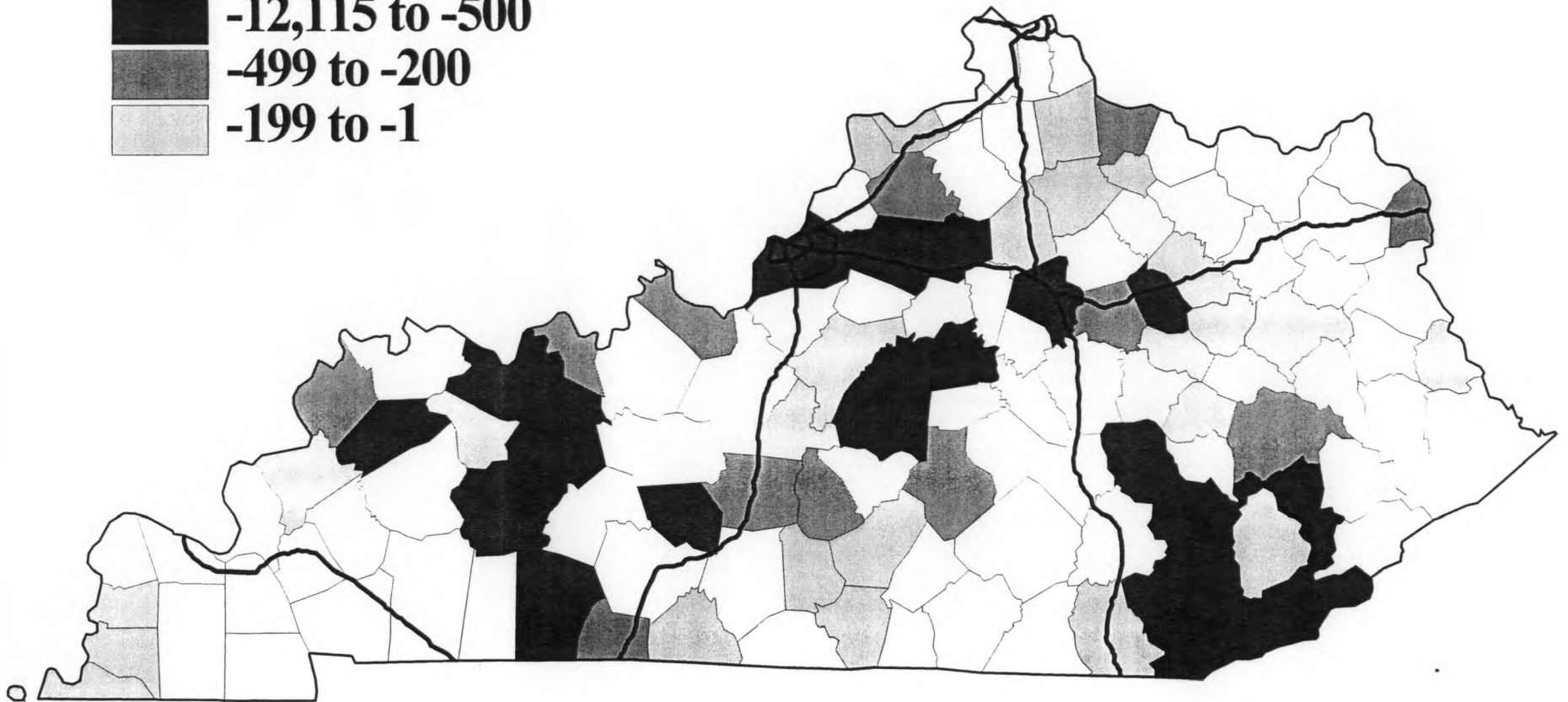
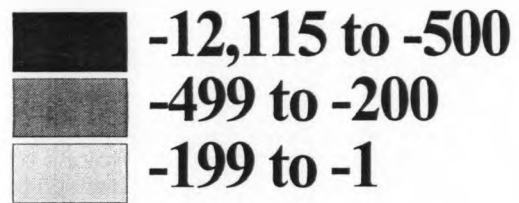

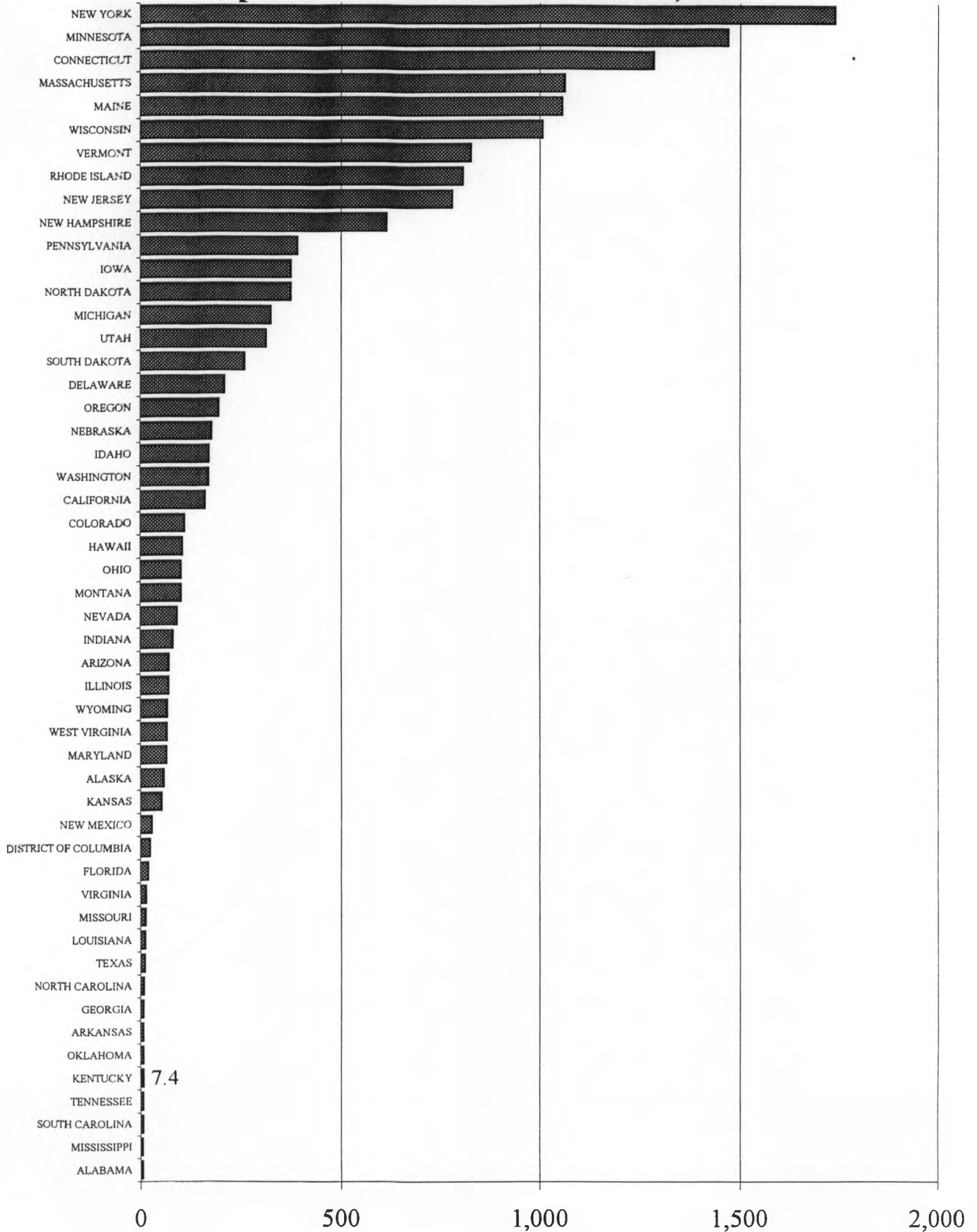

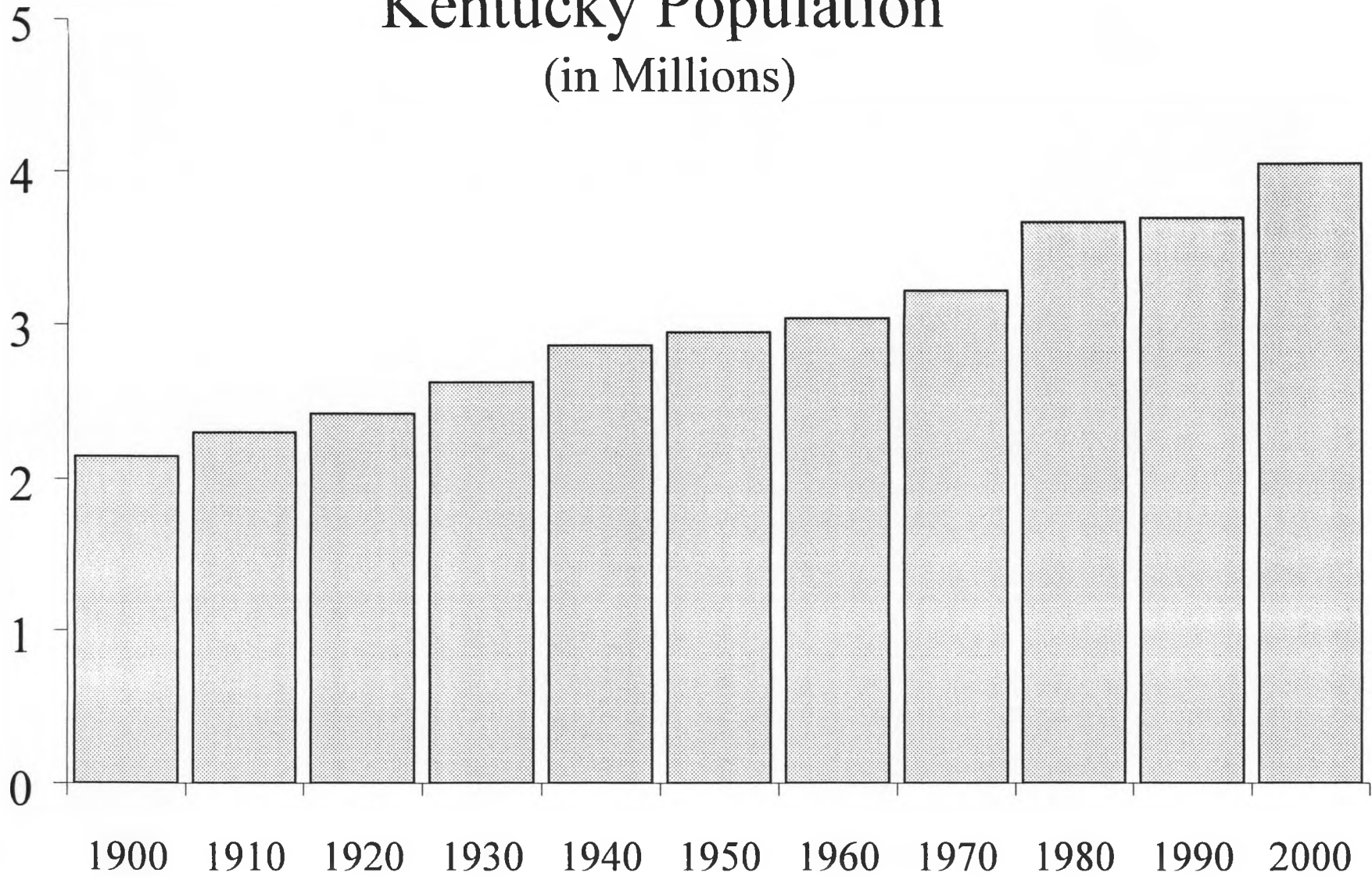

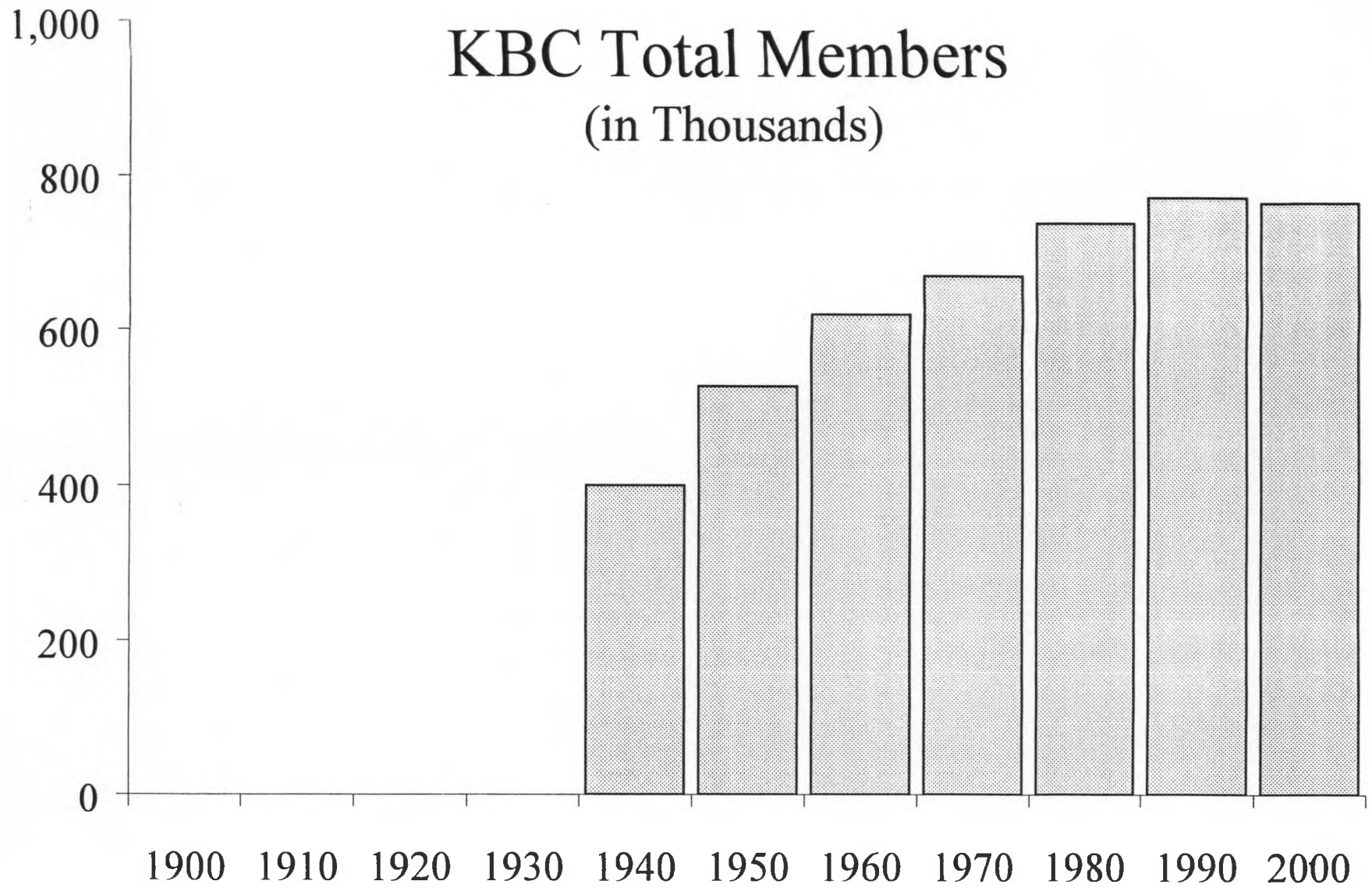
Population Per Resident Member, 2000
