FACTS OF IMPORTANCE RELATED TO THE CHINESE SITUATION IN OUR CONVENTION.

1. From 1940-1949 live births among the Chinese in the U. S. increased from 1,098 to 5,062, a fact which indicates the rapid increase of Chinese in the U. S.
2. Chinese population in the states of our Southern Baptist territory is as follows:

3. Out of the 117,629, 81,311 of these live in the territory now served by the Southern Baptist Convention. This is more than two-thirds of the total population.
4. Three states on the West Coast which now have organized Southern Baptist work have a total of 63,834 of these Chinese people. This is more than one-half the total population of the U. S. and almost four times the number of Chinese people living elsewhere in our Southern Baptist territory.
5. Five other states in our Convention territory with more than 1,000 Chinese people.

6. Our Home Board is doing mission work in five localities in our territory; namely, San Antonio, El Paso, Phoenix, Los Angeles, and Berkley, California. We have a total of nine mission workers on these fields.
7. During the past year we have entered new buildings in El Paso, Berkley and Phoenix. New land has been acquired for a Chinese mission work in San Antonio and funds are on hand to purchase property for our work at Los Angeles.
