We will be able to lend you some after a while, if you want them, as we are going to run a lot of them in the Atalaya. That is what I want these for. If you may not need them till after our National Convention in October, I should like to keep them here till then, as we want to get out a special number at that time, if possible.

We are now printing Dr. Frost's new book, The Memorial Supper, in the paper, and at same time in Book form. The History is just about ready to send to the binders. Will send you a copy as soon as it gets back. Am arranging for the translation of Grace Truman, which will be a great help to us down here.

We now have about 450 subscribers to our new paper, and are hoping for a great many more before the end of the ~~new~~ first year.

Expositor Bíblico is growing. We had to print 2000 copies this time, and new orders come in every quarter.

I hope the Board can give us that new press--cylinder press--we asked for last year. Brother, we must have it, if it is possible.
