heard from him any thing about it.

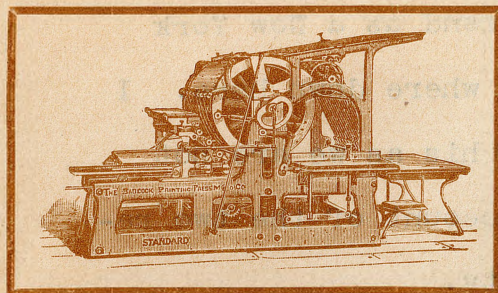
Have made a consolidation of papers. Will send you

Dear Brother:--

At last we have arranged the matter of the house, but we have had to draw on you at sight, as they would not take L. C. any other way.

There have been two bank failures in Mexico, and both of them were American Banks. This makes it harder to arrange matters. Mr. Mahon was here and we had no money. Hooker could not do anything for us. I sent him the L.C. to see if he could handle it, and there have been delays and delays. The deeds and titles are all O.K. and Mr. Mahon has signed the new papers, and the other party is to do it as soon as we can get the money. This will probably be about next Tuesday. I have changed the draft on you from 10 days to sight, as it was absolutely necessary. We were saving a thousand dollars by working and dillydallying and offering cash down. We have lost out on a part of this as we now have to pay the cost of transfer which will be some \$250 or \$300. Will use the rest in making the needed repairs as far as possible, and will render you a detailed report.

Hope this will be all right with you. It was

a pity ~~why~~ that you did not send us a New York draft which is good as gold any where down here. I think you will have to come to this as we are not able to stand the pressure on account of the two recent Bank failures in Mexico City.

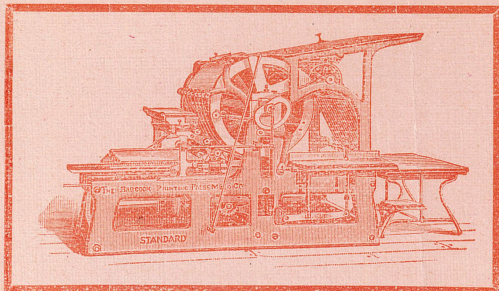
This house is a bargain. When we get it repaired as far as possible with the money we may have left over, it will be in good condition. Everybody says it is cheap at this figure.
