Dear Brother Davis:-

The Board yesterday passed the following
Resolution,-

"That \$6.00 (Mexican) a month from May first,
be allowed to Carlos Castillo, who works in connection with our
Publishing House, at Leon. War conditions seem to necessitate this
grant."

This is in compliance with the request you
make in your letter of June 9th, in which you ask that the above
named amount be granted to Castillo for rent. You can draw for this
amount, according to the plan you have been using lately.

I hope that the resignation of Pres. Huerta,
which is chronicled in today's papers, will go far towards bringing
about peace in Mexico.

May the blessing of God be upon all in this
trying time.
