Dear Brother Love:

Yours of the 29th received in due time and I thank you for the information you gave me with reference to the appropriation made for this plant for the next year. I feel that we are going to be in shape to do better work and more of it than ever before. We are going to try during the coming year to put the business at least partially on a self-supporting basis. While it will take some time to reach this objective, yet I am more and more convinced that with our present equipment and that which we are putting in we shall be able to help pay the expenses of this literature we are publishing.

I am going to give you an itemized report of how we spent this equipment fund in a short time. We do not yet know what it will cost for freight and installation of some of the machinery we have purchased and for that reason I think it best to wait yet a while before sending this report.

The way my predecessors were keeping the books it would be a great deal of work for me to send monthly statements as I had before, but we shall change our system the first of the year and then I will make these reports every month as formerly.

I am trying to arrange my ~~plans~~ *plans* so I can be at the Texas State Convention in Dallas and hope to see you there. I want to have a talk with you and feel that by that time I will have something more definite to say than at present.
