MOTHER IN ISRAEL

Aged Mother of Well Known Chanute
and Neosho County People Died
Last Evening.

Mrs. Anna M. Nelson, the aged mother of a number of well-known Chanute and Neosho county citizens, died just as the shades of night were falling last evening, at the home of her son, John L. Nelson, northwest of town. The funeral services were held there this afternoon, at 2 o'clock. Rev. A. Lagerquist conducted the service, which was attended by a large number of mourning friends. Interment was made in the cemetery at Swede Center, where she was laid to rest beside her husband who died eight years ago.

"Grandma" Nelson's death came in the evening of life like it came at the end of day. She was born in Sweden 75 years ago, where she lived till 1869, when she came across the ocean to Neosho county. Here she has since lived. She was a fine old Christian lady, and has raised a fine family of honest and industrious citizens. She was a member of the Swedish Baptist church, having with her husband been known to have been among the first of this sect in Sweden. In accordance with her request her children were the pall bearers. Six children are left to mourn her loss; five boys and one girl. They are as follows: Chas. O., Erick A., John L., A. G. and N. Nelson and Mrs. Chas. Lindquist. C. O. Nelson is the republican candidate for the legislature from this county and Eric is a missionary in Brazil, who has been
