Dear Dr. Rankin:

I am not quite sure to whom I should write this letter, but I know that you will see that it gets to the right person.

We have just had a long distance call from the CARE office in New York stating that as a member of the CARE organization we are entitled to share in the distribution of surplus for Israel in the amount of \$5,000 worth of food for January and \$5,000 worth in March. The one requirement they are making is that this distribution of relief be made to flood sufferers.

I told them that Mr. Lindsey was handling the distribution of relief for us, and that if this arrangement was satisfactory with him, it would be with us. I understand that they will get in touch with Mr. Lindsey. I hope that the distribution of this \$10,000 worth of food will bring great relief.

I hope that this distribution will not place too great a burden on Mr. Lindsey.
