Dear Mr. Knapp:

I have received your telegram asking me which obstacle hinders my trip to Cleveland, since the Foreign Mission Board of the Southern Baptist Convention had to pay my transatlantic expenses.

I thank you very much for your earnest interest and I think that I must give you some explanations. It is true indeed that the F.M.B. of the Southern Baptist Convention had promised to cover my expenses, but this was four months ago, when I was a worker of such a Mission. Yet, about two months ago, several circumstances obliged me to be disconnected of the Foreign Mission Board in Spain. When I announced my decision to the American representative of the F.M.B. in Barcelona, he told me what I supposed of course, that the Southern Baptist Convention Committee would not pay my voyage to Cleveland.

Other circumstances in my work here hinder my going out of Spain before next September. So I think it will not be possible for me to attend the World Institute and Council of Christian Education, even this being a disappointment that destroys my hope cherished during a long time.
