Dear Dr. Gill:

I am in receipt of your letter of December 19th, which reached me today.

I have looked the matter up, and in the 1940 list, the last one printed, giving a summary of statistics, membership, unions and so on, Dutch In 1914 a Baptist church was formed Paramaribo, with 79 Guiana is listed. members, one pastor, two other preachers and 80 Sunday school scholars. The last contact we had with this tiny mission was in February of this year, from J. Blufpand, P.O.B. 324, Paramaribo, Surinam. This letter arrived here on March 1st, giving information showing that the membership today is just 33. Mr. Blufpand attributes this decrease to the arrival of the Salvation Army, the Seventh Day Adventists, and the Pilgrim Holiness Mission Church. I am inclosing the letter for your perusal, asking that you kindly return it to me as soon as you have finished with it.

Re: Dr. Townley's Plans. I think I sent you a copy of the letter I wrote Dr. Lord concerning the conversation you and I had in Richmond. He wrote me back that he is prepared to go to South America for the months of September and October if it is your judgment that they are better for the purpose than October and November.
