It was a personal work -

"He brought him to Jesus"

2. His Interest in Boys -

"there is a lad here" -

- above all - bring them to Jesus -

3. Certain Greeks -

Philip asked Andrew who knew Jesus better

Some Lessons -

1. Value of developing our own gifts -

+ not allowing ourselves to envy others -
Room for envy, discontent, self-pity -

2. Value of personal touch in his work for Christ

3. Value of rich experience with Christ -

"makes a man a power" -

Why are you coming?

He had heard John -

After his interview with Jesus

The way the whole Christian movement began -
secret of the personal touch -

2. Discovered the hidden resources of a boy -

5 loaves & 2 fishes - Key to the situation -

3. Introduced a group of strangers to Christ -
Greeks - Andrew a man of decision -
