(Consider 33:27) -  
(Contrast v. 12 + 13:27)

v. 27 the way he is nursed v. 12 he is carried  
[mother bear at night with baby bear -  
at day he moves up between the shoulders]  
[mother + baby - in her arms] (Crossing st. on her shoulders)  
In such fashion God will carry us -  
It was Moses who chose this figure

1. He is in the place where he can speak  
with his Father - (Stay where you can talk with him)
2. He keeps in the place where His Father can  
speak to him - (Stay where you can hear him)
3. Only when the child so rides can he see  
things from the right proportion - sees an  
animal - No far - has time to think
4. No one rides between the shoulders of God  
if he rides there only when trouble appears  
Serenity comes because he has been on  
God's shoulders since boyhood.
