

Timothy - TIMOTHY ATR.
Paul loved Timothy - His home in Systra -
His Greek Father - 16:3
Timothy trained by his mother, ^{Eunice} & grandmother, Lois.
A home of Piety - 2 Tim 1:5. 2 Tim 3:14, 15
Eunice was "a Jewish who believed" 16:1
Paul & Silas to Systra -
a Protege' of Paul's - He was seeking young men -
Timothy found & converted during 1st m-tour
Paul called him "my beloved & faithful child in the Lord" 1 Cor 4:17
" " " "my child Timothy" 1:18
Timothy chosen on 2nd m-tour
at Systra - → acts 16:3 "him would Paul have to
forth with him" 1 Tim 1:6
Timothy inducted or ordained
Paul begs him to keep up his study & prayer habits
"Keep abaze" 1 Tim 1:6
Quote 1 Tim 4:13-16.
cf. 1 Thess 3:2 & 1 Cor 16:10 2 Cor 1:1
Col 1:1
Phil 1:1
Rom 16:2
Not without Honor at Home -
"T- was well reported of by the brethren that were at Systra & Iconium"
The First Campaign with Paul = (Paul, Silas, Timothy & Luke)
Useful to Paul in Macedonia & Achaia -
with Silas in bringing gifts from Philippi & Thessalonica & Berea

Timothy

Timothy in Corinth - (with Paul most of 3rd m-journey)
at Ephesus - (Trouble broke out in Corinth) -

Paul sent Timothy to Corinth - 1 Cor 4:17

" wrote 1st Cor. & endorsed Timothy - friend - full power to speak for Paul -

" put his whole case in Timothy's hands.
Quote 1 Cor 16:10f - (afraid Tim. could not handle them -

Storm raged on in Corinth -

Paul sent Titus to see what he could do -
Titus had more effect

Apparently the Judaizers brushed Tim rudely aside as a stripling -

Later Paul wrote to Tim - "Let no man despise thy youth" - 1 Tim 4:12

Loyalty in Rome (Timothy) -

Tim. was true blue & gave Paul the best that ~~he had~~ ^{was in him} -

He was faithful when others flickered
Paul wanted to send Tim to Philippi. He wrote to them: "Ye know the proof of him, that, as a child serveth a father, so I served with me in furtherance of the gospel Phil 2:12

Timothy lacked genius but he had goodness -

"was" a good minister of Jesus Christ" (1 Tim 4:6)

He could count on Tim to the limit -

Tim would stand true when others had deserted -

In Charge at Ephesus -
after Paul's 1st release from prison he left Timothy to have charge of the work at Ephesus 1 Tim 1:3
a heavy responsibility

Timothy

Paul went on to Macedonia & wrote letter to Timothy giving full instructions - This letter (1 Tim) valuable today for preachers.

Instructions about health, study, piety,
 "Paul, the aged" writes with tenderness, force, courage
 He wants Tim to come up to the highest standard as a man of God. 1 Tim. 1:18-20 3:14ff 4:6-16 5:2 6:11, 20f

Paul anxious about Tim's health - 5:23
 He did a great work in spite of his infirmities -

Paul Songs for Timothy - In prison In Mamertine Prison

Timothy still in Ephesus but Paul longs for him.

"Come before winter" 2 Tim 1:16-18

"Bring John Mark" 4:11

"The cloak" from "Troas at house of Carpus" 4:13

His "looks"

This last message of Paul is full of courage - 2 Tim 1:7
 2 Tim 1:8 2:3-13

"Preach the Word"

He wants to see Timothy -

In Prison for Paul

Came quickly to see Paul - Into prison himself - Heb 13:2

Maybe → Suke, Timothy, Mark had the privilege of accompanying Paul to place of execution outside Rome
