(Key words for victorious living) -

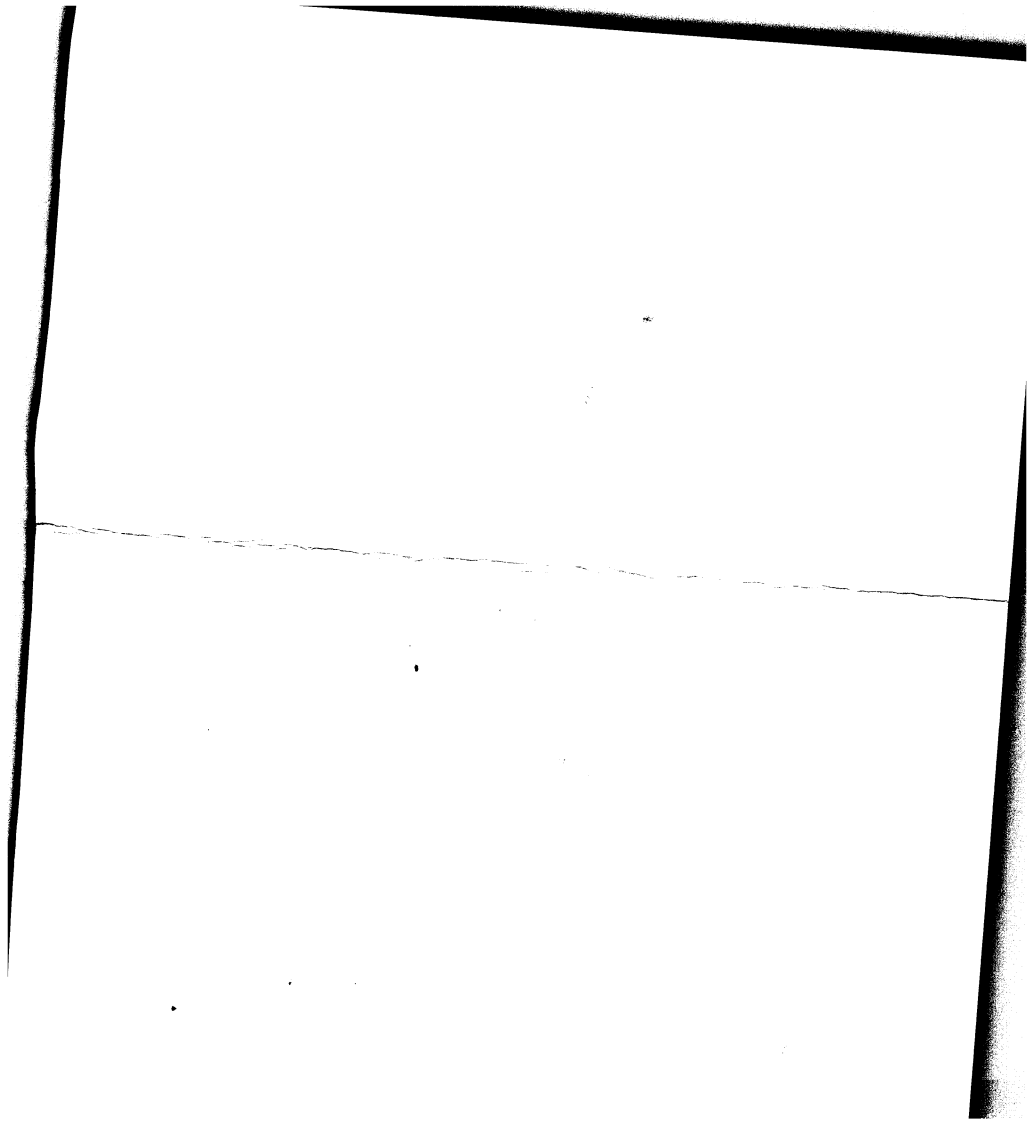
6:6 "Know"

Not promising a warless world - end of class struggle -
nor certainty of acceptance without criticism -

His peace is that serenity that will enable you to face
Death + all the tragedy of life unafraid -

You are the object of God's love + care -
neither betrayal of friends, triumph of foes, disappoint-
ment in love, failure in business, death of loved ones,
pain of lingering illness, destruction of hopes
for children or shattering of dreams for yourself

If you have Him -
