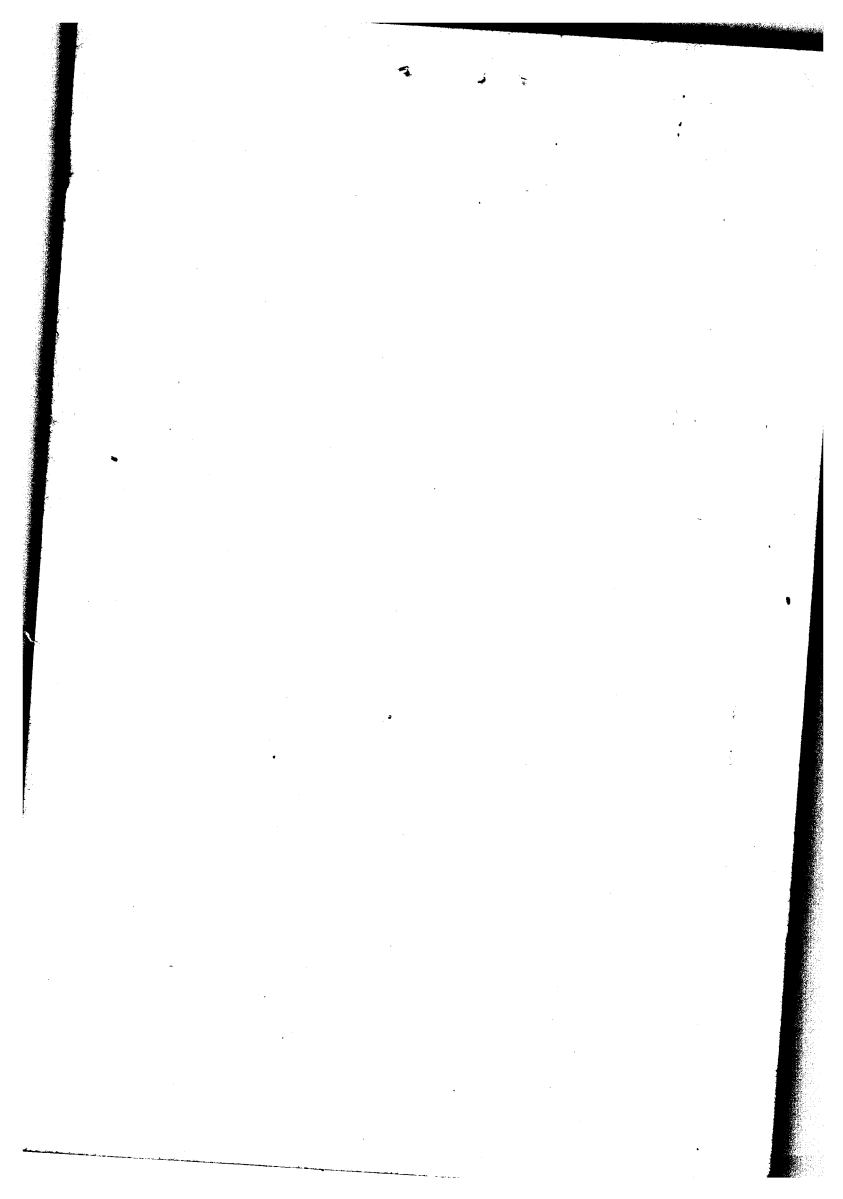

" is Paul's dynamo potential & actual

" infuses strength -

This power accessible to all who yield themselves
to Christ.

" place themselves in
the service of Christ

" make the full surrender

Paul leads the victorious life because he lets Christ
reign & rule in his heart.

The constant inflow of power from Christ allows
Paul to be a continuous supply of
energy for others -

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"Apart from me ye can do nothing" without Christ = 0

Certain Victory - Phil 4:13

The Source of Christian omnipotence -

"In him" - present tense = "he continues to pour his power into me."

"apart from me ye can do nothing."

Leave Christ out & you are helpless - (impotence)
If he keeps on pouring his power into us :: Omnipotence

The Scope of Christian omnipotence -

"all things" "I am strong" -

Every experience found Paul ready - equipped -
In all that God wanted him to do he was able -

1. Perform any service - "impossible" tasks - burdens -
Goliath & David -

2. Overcome temptation - Romans 7 .

3. face persecutions & endure sufferings - 2 Cor 11

4. meet death with a shout of victory
unafraid - "Thanks be to God who giveth us
the victory via our Lord Jesus Christ" -

The Call of Christian omnipotence - not a little thing - responsibility -

1. a call to faith - Abraham - "Looking unto the
promise of God, he wavered not thru unbelief,
but waxed strong thru faith, giving glory to God,
and being fully assured that what he had promised,
he was able also to perform."

2. a call to humility - no place for pride in Christian life -
By the grace of God he is what he is -

3. a call to Christian activity -
"a call to Christian Courage - "Fear not"

Phil 4:13. "I can do all things through Christ." cf. Mt. 28²⁰
He had Christ - He had victory - a mighty assurance

"In all things I am strong in Christ who empowers me".
God offers the same victory to us - 3 things suggested [C]
What Paul could do.

1. He could perform any service -
no matter how hard - how dangerous - power poured into him.
[Goliath & David] - Triumphs of men & women who have
gone forth in his strength -
2. He could overcome temptation - victory - not in his own strength
but not above temptation -
3. He could face persecutions & endure sufferings - 2 Cor. 11:
(in Philippian jail) (Roman prison)
4. He could meet death with a shout of victory -
