

## NOTES FROM THE CENTERS

One of our new centers is located in Bartlesville, Oklahoma. It is under the direction of Rev. Jess Ditmar and Rev. Joe Ray Land, Dean. Dr. Roger D. Hevard is a teacher.

At Abbeville, South Carolina, Rev. LaFon Campbell gathered a group of Negro preachers together and initiated a school there, and Rev. Marshall G. Mines began a center in Tampa, Florida. We expect this type of school to increase.

We now have a center in Jacksonville, Florida, which was begun by Rev. Elwin R. Anderson. The Pastors' Conference has joined in with their full support.

The Tulsa-Rogers Association has established a center under the direction of Rev. Leo Perry, Superintendent of Missions. Teachers include: Dr. J. W. Storer, Dr. Allen W. Graves, Dr. Charles Black, and Rev. Bluford Sloan. In this center two sessions are held, morning and evening.

The San Antonio Baptist Association has begun a center under the direction of Rev. Joe MacNamee. Dr. Richards is Dean, Rev. Mack Rotan is Registrar, and Rev. Edward Garrett is Treasurer. Teachers include: Dr. Vernon Elmore, Dr. W. S. Birnie, and Rev. Joe MacNamee.
