Scientific Notes.

Water: The great capacity for heat, its power in warming heat, its influence on climate, water is so common.

I have already commented upon the great proportion of water specially adapted to be the performance of specific functions in the natural world and in the art—namely the exceptional property of this fluid expanding, with retention of heat, when passing from the liquid to the solid form.

of its capacity for heat in consequence of which few feet in taken from surrounding substance and converted into latent heat in the aqueous vapor formed by evaporation.

The self-repellancy of the molecules of water is, in some extent, counteracted by the atmospheric pressure, some 15 pounds to the square inch, but for which our lakes and ponds swell, in July, become so many beds of boiling water, freezing while in the very act of boiling.

It is by this means—constant evaporation of water, or perspiration, at the surface of our bodies—that a uniform temperature of 98° is maintained.

As an illustration of the agency of water in transferring heat from one place to another, and in this way naturally modifying the climate of the vast regions, take the famous Gulf-Stream. This, probably the largest river on the globe, flows northward from the Gulf of Mexico towards Newfoundland.

It is proposed to erect this as an addition to the present Training Hall, at the south end of it, so as to form a Jackson street, the street by which most persons approach the college.


