Service Cures for Rheumatism.

It is the best of the white thistle for rheumatism. Follow taking the tea for a few days and you will effect a cure: don't drink it after the sweat, but either warm or cold.

6. Extract of gamboge (yellow jamaica) is a good remedy for rheumatism. Rubbe the fruit down in a mortar, and strain it through a cloth. It will relieve very severe attacks.—Christian Messenger.

Carrot Feeding.

The American Farmer has the following: At Carrol University they have been feeding their work teams liberally with carrot roots, and winter, and the experiment has proved the crop to be one of essential value for feeding to horses.
