That infant baptism is without the shadow of foundation in the Scriptures is distinctly avowed by many of the first Bible scholars and interpreters in the Pedobaptist ranks. Thus says Dr. Jacob, of the Church of England: "Notwithstanding all that has been written by learned men upon this subject, it remains indispensible that infant baptism is not mentioned in the New Testament..."
