In celebration of this wonderful increase in the American production of cotton, the long talked of "World's Industrial and Cotton Centennial Exposition" will be held in New Orleans next December.

The act of Congress creating the National Board requires that the city chosen as the location for the exhibition shall subscribe the sum of not less than \$100,000 toward defraying the cost of the enterprise.

A bill has just passed that body, appropriating \$1,000,000 for the purpose, on condition that the State should contribute an equal amount.
