KENTUCKY ITEMS. Gen. Scott Brown, of Franklin county, has imported a lot of Holstein cattle.

The Lexington hemp mills have closed temporarily on account of the scarcity of making material.

The sale of showstomps on the 16th inst., at Millersburg, belonging to Mr. Johna Bates, did not prove a success to the good part.

There has been some sales of corn in the field here at 85, equal to about 25.25 delivered.

Although the corn crop in many portions of the county suffered very materially from the drought, the yield is being reported about the usual crop of ordinary years.

In Bourbon county, H. R. Marks sold 50 bush averaging 24 1/2 pounds, at \$4 7/8 per bush.

Mark & Branch, of Bourbon, shipped a consignment of young cattle to the vicinity of Nashville to be fed on corn which they expect to buy at \$1.50 per bush.

John R. Carpenter, of Fleming county, and a calf of black leg, a disease which has been almost universally fatal among cattle by bleeding it in the neck, just as horses are bled.

The cabbage that escaped the worms are maturing too early to keep, and the prospect for home-made sauer kraut is not encouraging.
