Dr. Dobbs on the Sabbath.

Among the many good articles in the Standard, I found one which has attracted my special thought, because it presents opinions which have become so widely and so generally held before our churches...

By way of strengthening the fourth commandment, or of reconciling the people to it, that God having finished the work of creation in six days, and resting, or ceasing from his work, on the seventh day...

And the views of the preacher were so far acquiesced in by the association, that no voice was raised in opposition. I ventured to say to him privately that I thought the tendency of his sermon was to loosen the foundation of an institution without which the Christian world would go backward.

But even admitting that neither the order of thought in preparing his books, nor the order of writing, would naturally have led him to place Genesis first in order; and conceding that he actually did write the Book of Exodus first, yet, under this last assumption, even more than under the first, it is not most probable that he would have enlarged his parenthetical statement...

And now, assuming that Moses was not left entirely to his own discretion in the order of his thought preparatory to writing, nor to his own discretion as to the order in which he should write his books...
