TOBACCO. (Reported by J. S. Phelan & Co., Planter's Warehouse, Louisville, Ky., April 8.) The last week closed the most successful and satisfactory week of the year. The dark grades of noncondensed leaf and logs were about as low as they were in 1895, while the better grades of rich, good leaf and logs were in good demand, and black wrappers led at all prices. Premiums from us to stockholders, looked all for rich leaf and logs are closely watched and sell very well. In fact, the market has been a long time of good, dry and choice stock, and such have sold very well. The wrapper makers are keeping close in price with the black wrappers, and have sold as high as \$2. The common low grades of dark and greenish leaf and logs have sold very well. The bright trash market is in good, dry order, and sold well. We return to us often reports of heavy rain, and we are sure the first day of last January, viz. that we have strong faith in the good, fine and choice grades of all types of tobacco, and do not believe there will be any more of such sorts than will be wanted and taken at fair prices. Of course we can not undertake to say what future prices will be, that is a great measure will depend on the general business of the country, the settlement of the troubles between our large manufacturers, the development of the crop of 1896, and last but not least, our supply and demand for the week to come.
