TOBACCO. Reported by J. B. Phelps & Co., Planter's War House. LOUISVILLE, Ky., November 6, 1886. Last week our tobacco market gained strength all the week. The activity and competition was decidedly stronger and prices firm, and on some of the staple sorts, better. In respect to the demand we are strong for all low leaf, white goods, medium and fine leaf were about as the week before. Color and bright trash, fine and leaf of fine very firm. In dark tobacco the demand was unchanged and prices remain about as last week. Stocks that have gone through too heavy a sale are more restricted than other kinds. Shocks are being rapidly reduced and so far receipts of new tobacco amount to nothing. A new variety leaf sold during the week at \$7.00.
