The administrators have decided to locate the Oxford State Normal School at Frankfort. It is now \$2,000.

There is great discussion in Canada on account of the heavy public cost of \$20,000,000. The voters are for annexation with the United States. There is also a great deal of additional business and new business in the Dominion.


