Dr. James Petterson Boyce died in Dr. Francis Bell Friday. A cable dispatch Wednesday announced that he was dying, and another on Friday told that he had died.

Dr. Boyce was born in Charleston, S. C., January 11, 1857. Despite great wealth and luxurious surroundings he grew up to a pure and noble manhood. What are temptations to others were opportunities to him. His attitude was great and varied.

He was a born leader. In whatever circumstances he was placed he naturally stepped forward as a leader. This was not because of any self-will on his part, but because of his own conviction.

He was great as a speaker, and would have made an admirable secretary. He was adapted to the pulpit. To have been placed in charge of the Episcopate of the British Empire would not have overtaxed his financial resources.

His far-reaching wisdom was illustrated to the founding and carrying forward of the Theological Seminary. The Baptist ministry is peculiar, and has special needs.
