INTERNATIONAL Bible Lessons, 1891. FIRST QUARTER.

SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 11. ELIJAH TAKEN TO HEAVEN. 2 Kings 2:1-11.

THEY SAID: "And Enoch walked with God; and he was not; for God took him." (Gen. 2:24.)

Eight or ten years have passed since the death of Enoch. Elijah has appeared twice in the Scripture narrative.

Once he was sent with a message to King Ahab to have him to come to the death of having sent to come to the death of the god of Ekron in regard to his recovery (1 Chap., 2 Kings 1:1-16).

Again he sent a letter of warning to King Ahab, and he was slain at the battle of Ramoth Gilead (2 Chron. 18:1-40). He had occupied his time, it is thought, in preaching to the people, and in bringing into new life the souls of the people. Elijah had been his companion during these years.

And came to pass when the Lord took up Elijah by a whirlwind. "All our lives are in God's hands, and he has appointed the hour of our death. Yet we who are mortal, are doing anything which has a tendency to shorten our lives: God's sovereignty is to be put on man's responsibility for his free choice of his own life."
