"The Choice," as the new book is called, is the number and quality of its hymns, its sufficient evidence of its excellence of worship.

We rejoice that Dr. Manly will speedily issue another edition of his book which will include music suited to the voice, and which will be equally qualified for his task. His musical genius, his experience as a composer, his devoutness as a worshiper, and his liberality as a contributor to our people all combine to fit him for the work which he had in hand.
