Don't fall into the popular idea of weaning a child at the first appearance of teething...

Don't permit a child to nurse from the breast after the eighth month.

Don't wean a child during the summer season, unless absolutely unavoidable.

Don't give a baby which must be raised artificially food preparations containing any of the following: glucose and dextrine.

Don't fall to thoroughly sterilize the milk used in the preparation of food for the infant.

Don't permit the bottle, which should be very simple in its form, to become in the slightest degree unclean.

Don't permit the baby to remain in the bottle. Throw what stands away after each feeding.

Don't fall to thoroughly wash the nipple, tube and each feeding, and keep them in a bottle of soda until the next using.

Don't get angry with the baby for its toothless crying and fretfulness of nature. Such a proceeding is always harmful.

Don't expect that infants are liable to take cold easily, owing to the relative feebleness of the heart and circulation.

Don't limit the supply of fresh air and sunlight. A child can never get too much of either.

Don't permit a child to assume a sitting posture at an early age. Spinal curvatures may be produced, especially if the infant be carried.

Don't anticipate the natural efforts at locomotion, especially when carrying the limbs may result in disarranging later operative procedures.
