Extract from Dr. Geo. A. Lott's 44th Anniversary Address, given at Central City church, Nashville, Tenn., Sunday, May 1st, 1892. "There have been 375 members added to the church in the last four years—about 200 of these by baptism. During this time thirty-eight members have died; and your pastor has honored six persons, celebrated sixty-five marriages; made over 4,000 visits; preached more than 400 sermons; delivered over 100 black-board and other lectures; and taught a Sunday-school class every Sunday except in vacation. In this sense the church has raised for all purposes over \$22,000; and, considering our financial ability, but few churches will compare with you in liberality. Our church and Sunday-school attendance has averaged large, and the Sunday afternoon black-board lectures have been crowded beyond the capacity of our auditorium upon all occasions. Our prayer-meetings have been well attended, and the Young People's Meeting is one of the most attractive features of our work—especially in the mission which has been projected on Spruce street. Our women have done most nobly in all the work of the church, and most of the money raised for missions and extraordinary projects has been raised by them.
