Our pastors, editors, evangelists and colleges are almost indifferent to such work. There is perhaps a Democratic club in every county. The one in mine has as its motto "The Sabbath is for the people." In one of these clubs should be set up to be a church, it would seem very absurd for any pastor to recognize and affiliate with it as such. There are thirty-two Methodist and fifty Presbyterian denominations and others whose name is legion, which have no better claim to churchship than these Democratic clubs, and yet our Missionary Baptist leaders are prone to recognizing them. God is not pleased with it.

We have no way of securing unity among the Christians in all these congregational sects but to enforce the Bible law of organization. The Bible only can do it. Will it draw them? God says yes all through his Word. Who says not? The Missionary Baptist Church is the only one that has a claim for two Sabbaths a week. Yes, our hope of saving the Sabbath is in getting the Christians to recognize the Bible law.
