He Shall Suffer Loss.

"If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss." Read the third chapter of first Corinthians, and say what it means by that word. Evidently there is in connection with the Gospel and the Christian life loss as well as gain. Loss in connection with, not by the means of the Gospel, but in the midst of grace. Paul had preached the Gospel in Corinth, and with it laid the foundation of the Christian faith and the Christian church. In the very foundation Jesus Christ was the chief Corner Stone. Others had followed him in the ministry of truth, not to lay another foundation, but to build on that which he had laid. Some may have built more wisely and more successfully than others. The foundation is of established and accepted truth, but the various builders might not use equally good material. In the use of a stone, some might build of gold, or silver, or precious stones, and others of wood, or hay or stubble. These various and diverse materials stand for different degrees of truth, and represent either the doctrines they preach, or the lives they live, or the Gospel, or the morals they inculcate as the fruit of the Gospel, or the character of persons they gather into the church, or the testimonies of Christ and his cause. The gold, silver and precious stones stand for the pure and the good as the outward life of the people, the wood, hay and stubble stand for the outward life, the perishable in connection with Christian work. Those in the day of fire will reveal the history of a man's life and the value of his labor. The day shall disclose it. A day of both hope and trial.

But what is the loss such a man suffers? He will suffer. This is the loss of his life's labor. Every man has an interest in his work, though he does it for another. Can he not be interested in the work he does, be it secular or sacred, and not have a sense of bereavement? The loss of opportunity for good and noble services, and the loss of the joy in gathering wood, hay and stubble; gone beyond the hope of recovery. The loss of life, at least of what we really mean. He will have his life in a selfish way shall lose it, the loss of reward. What this means no man can tell. He whose work abides shall have a reward, but whose work perishes in the fire shall suffer loss.
