FROM THE RECORD VOLUME BY DR. H. K. CARROLL on the Religious Forces of the United States based on the census of 1890, we have gathered the figures showing the religious forces of Kentucky. Similar tables can be made out for the other states by carefully reading the census report. We have the denominations named we have the following: the first column of figures showing the number of members and second showing the value of houses of worship of each denomination:

MEMBERS. CHURCHES. Baptists 209,848 2,077. Methodists 100,000 1,000. Presbyterians 50,000 500. Catholics 100,000 1,000. Episcopalians 50,000 500. Lutherans 50,000 500. Unitarians 50,000 500. Jews 50,000 500. Quakers 50,000 500. Friends 50,000 500. Adventists 50,000 500. Spiritualists 50,000 500. Total 600,000 6,000.

The entire number of church-members in Kentucky is given as 606,442, or a little less than one-third of the population. The segregated values of the houses of worship are \$12,094,820. One of the most striking things connected with the religious condition of Kentucky is the fact that infest many other parts of the land, and the very small representation of several of our denominations.
