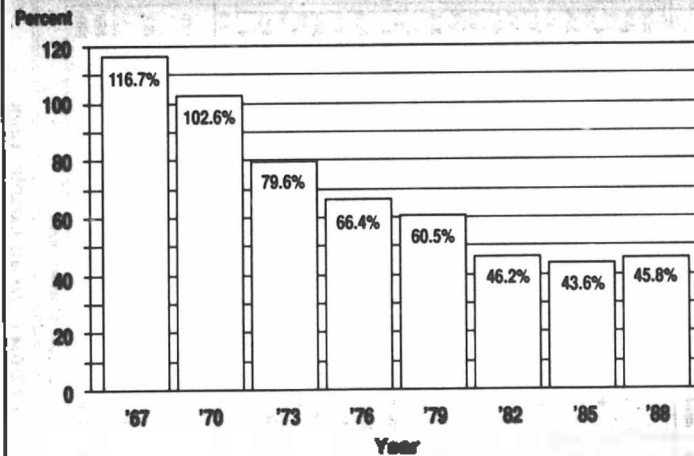

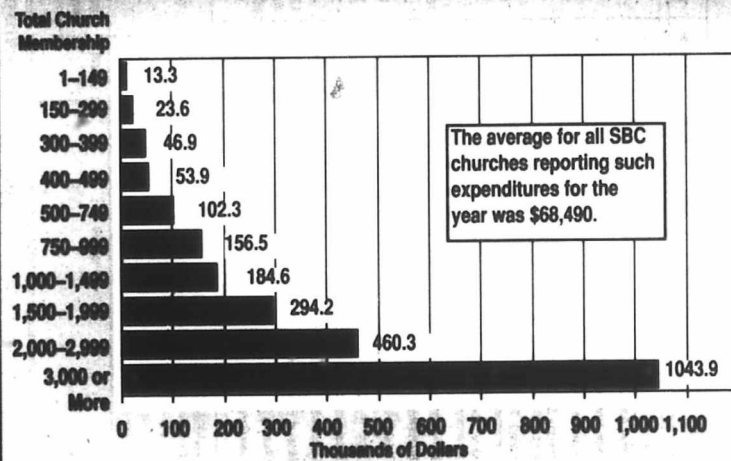

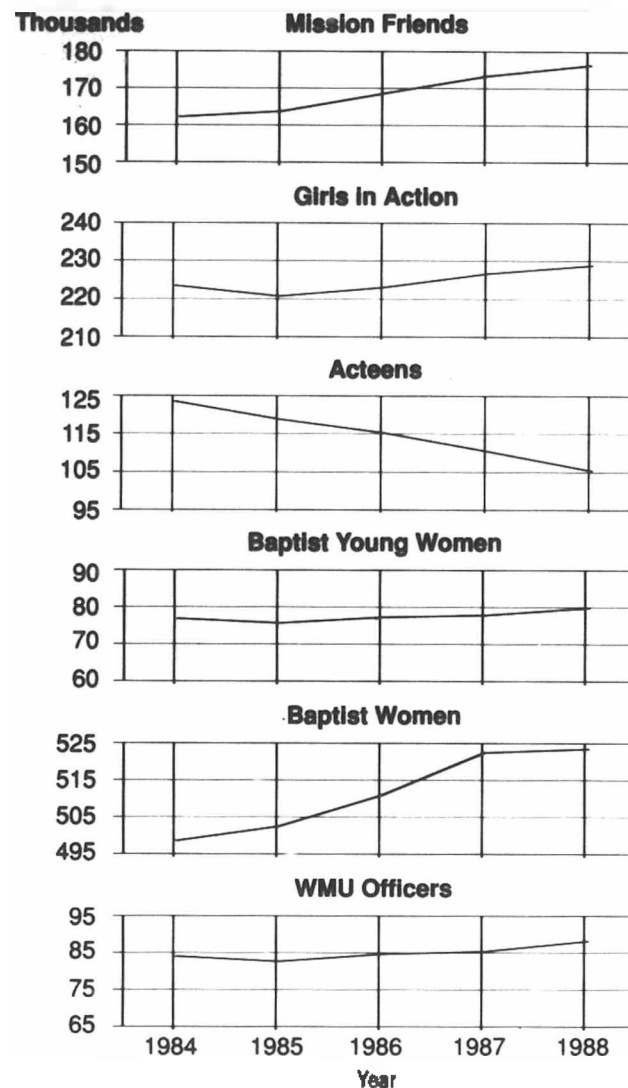

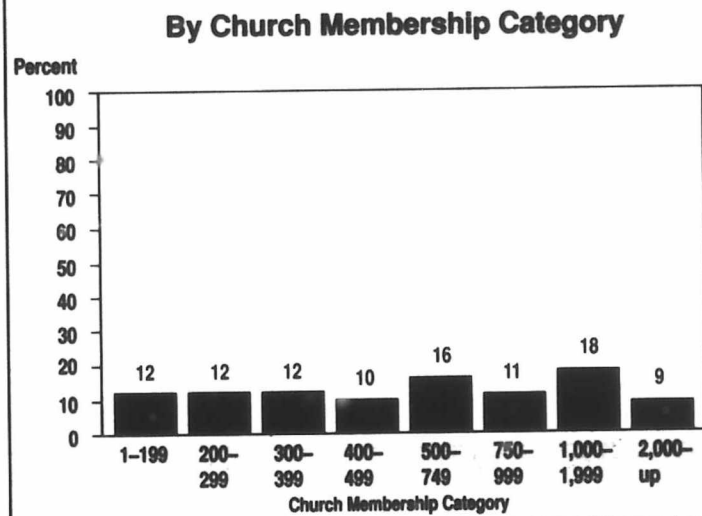

Distribution of Brotherhood Enrollment, 1988

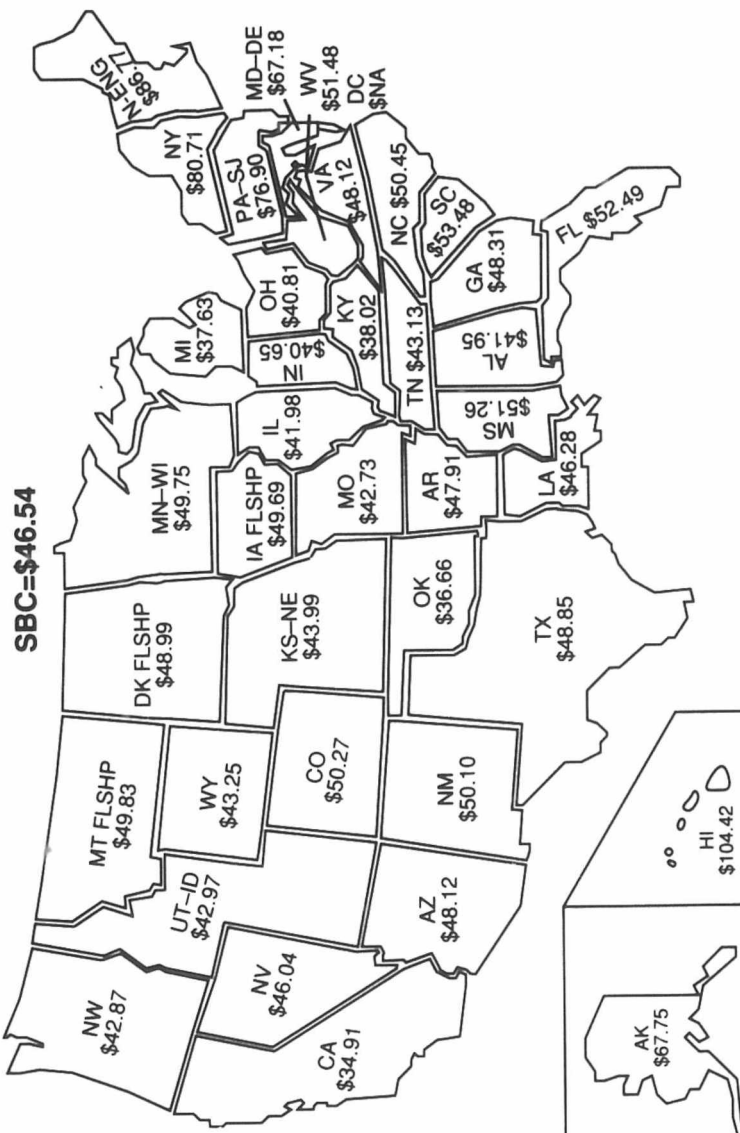

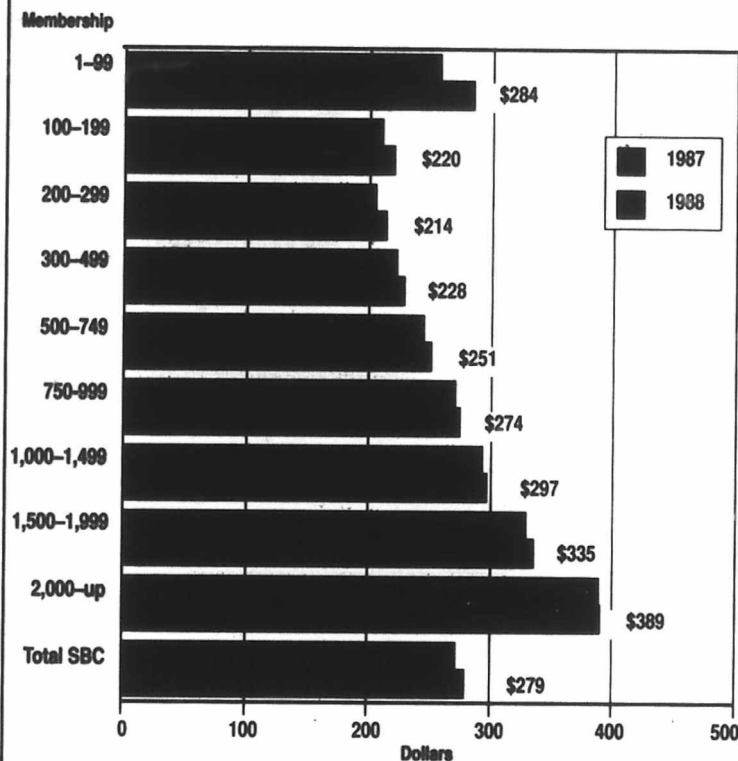

Per Capita Mission Expenditures by State Convention, 1988

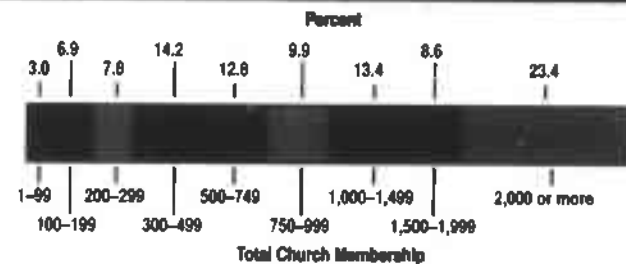


Per Capita Tithes, Offerings, and Gifts

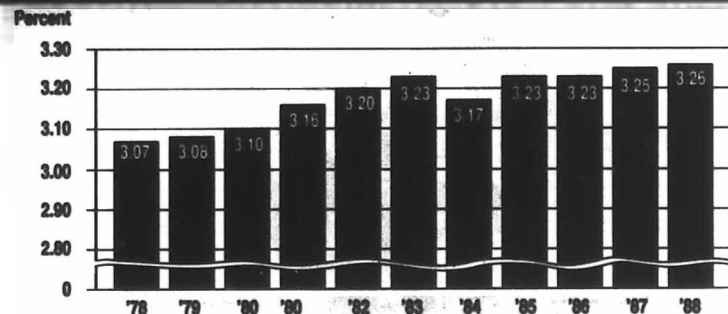

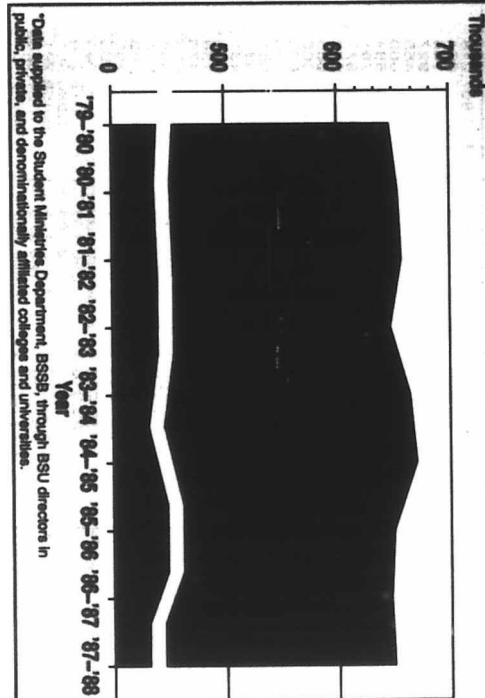

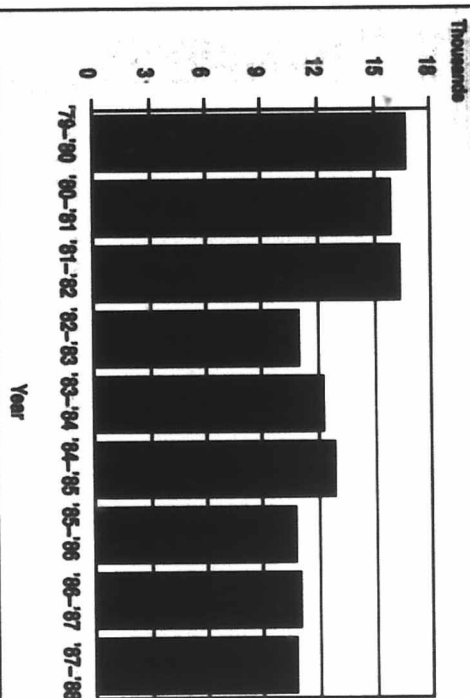

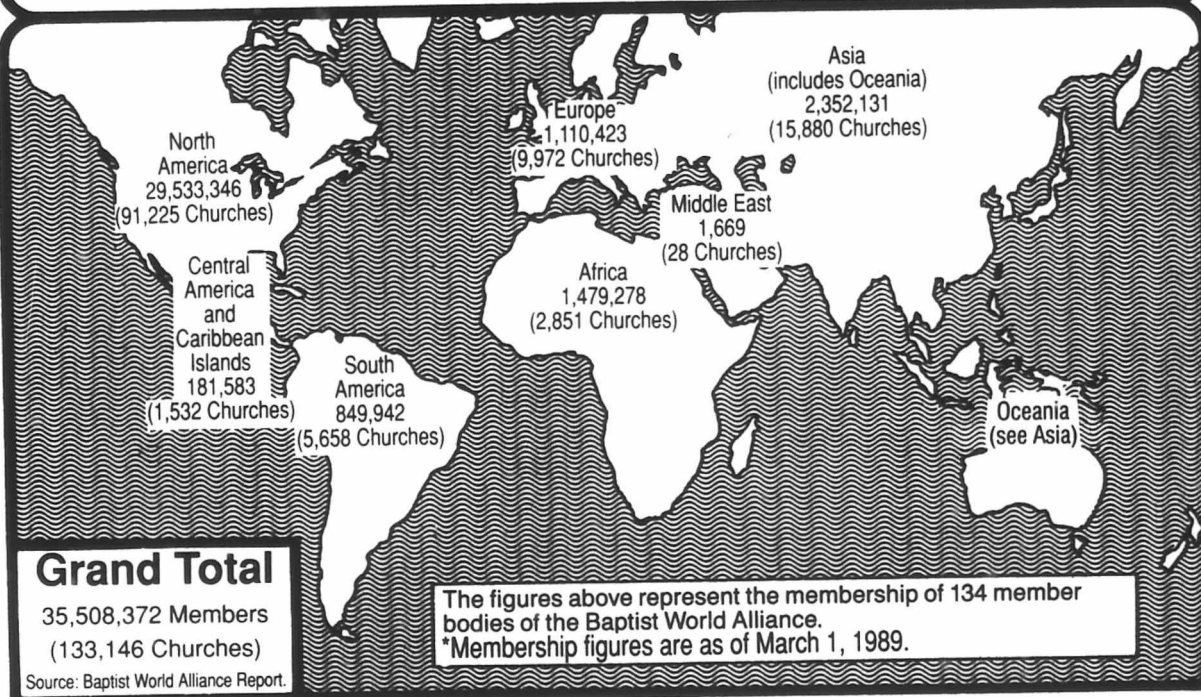

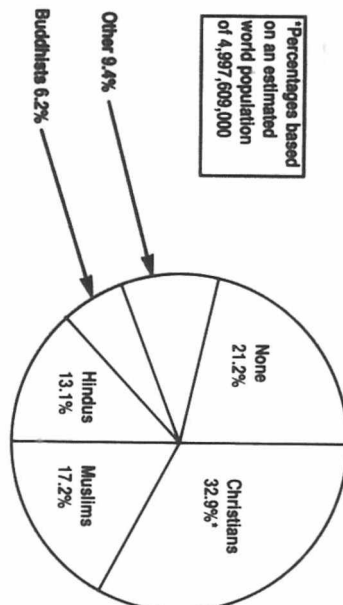

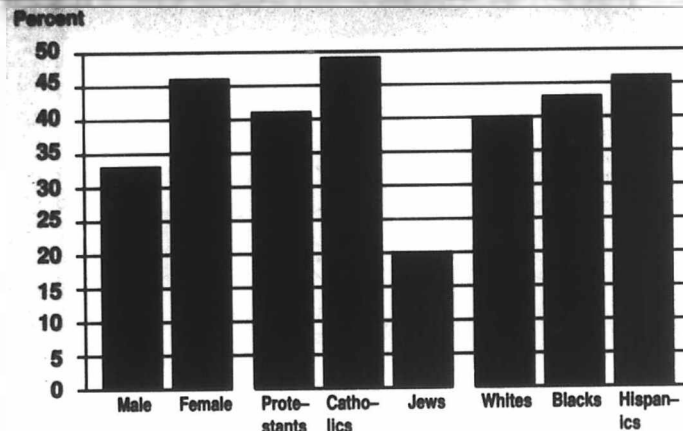

Statistics of the world religions are only very rough estimations. Aside from Christianity, new religions, if any, appear to have remained obscure, and even Evangelists employ different methods of counting members. All persons of whatever age who have experienced baptism in the Catholic Church are counted as members, while in most Protestant Churches only those who "join" the Church are numbered. There is no common standard for counting statistics, either complicated by the fact that in China one may be at the same time a Confucian, a Taoist and a Buddhist. In Japan, the Shinto religion is not counted as a religion, but as a sect of the Japanese nation. In the United States, the Census Bureau includes Central America and West Indies as part of the United States, and therefore counts the population of these countries as American. This includes the U.S. and other countries, with established majority religions, where counting religious adherence is difficult to estimate. Includes Australia and New Zealand as well as statistics of the South Pacific.

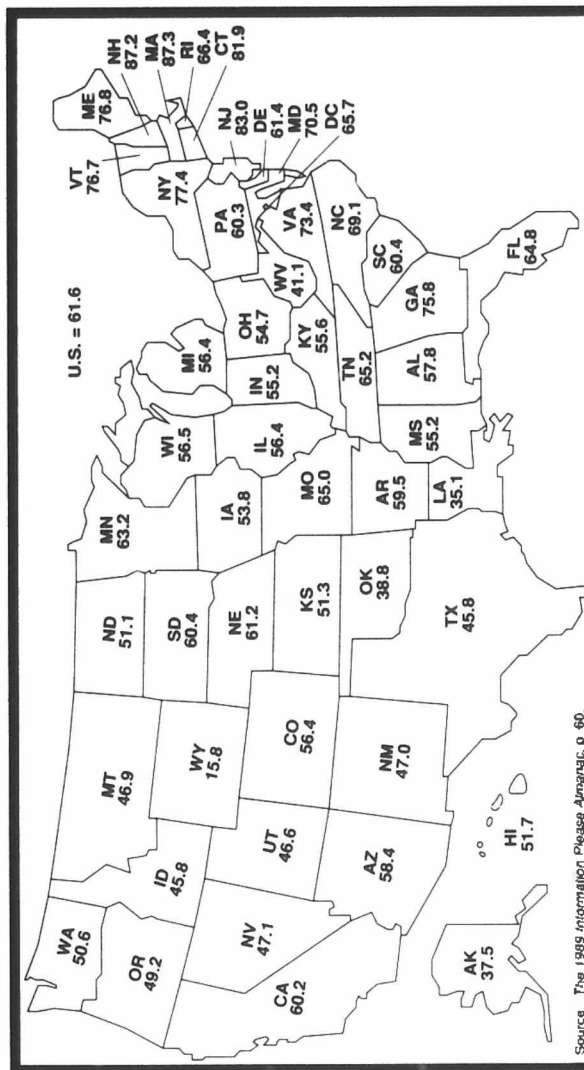

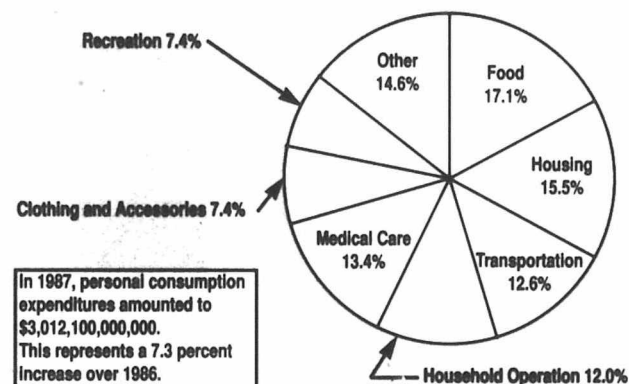

Percent Increase by State and United States, 1980-1987

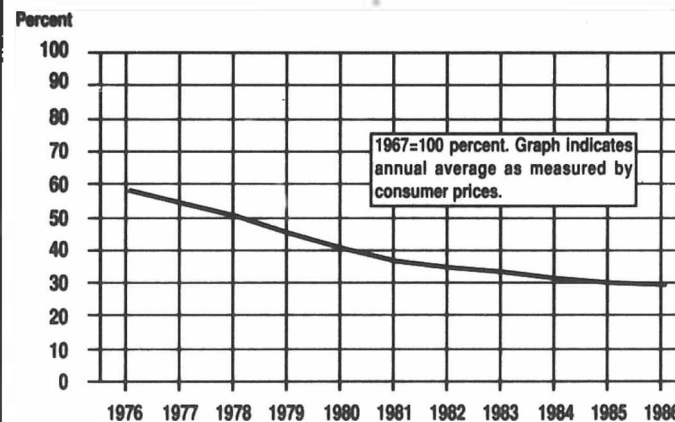


Personal Consumption Expenditures for the United States, 1987



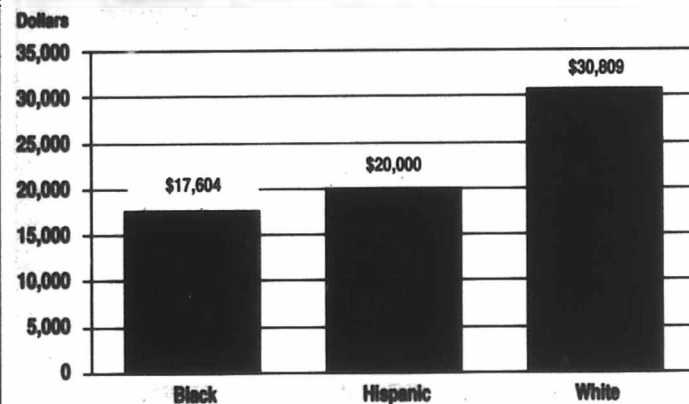

Purchasing Power of the Dollar, 1976-1986



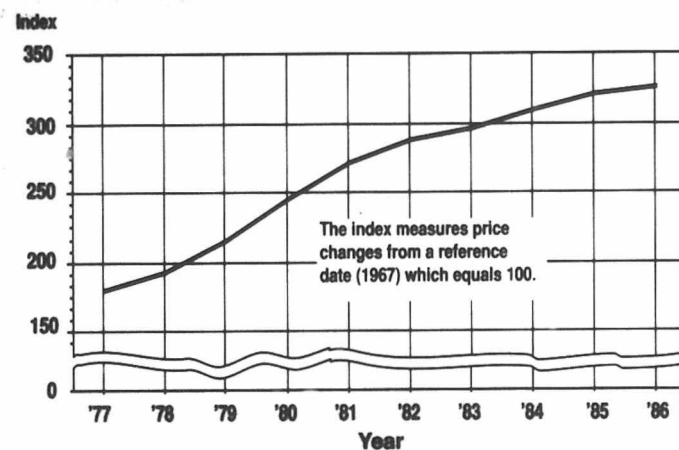

Median Income of Families, United States (in 1986 Dollars)



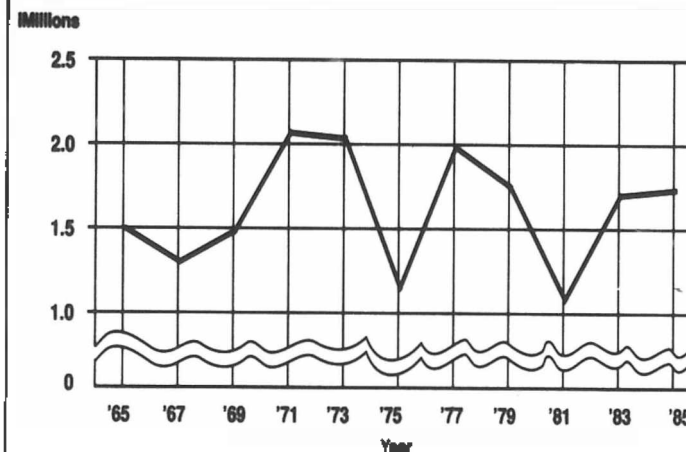

Average Consumer Price Index for All Items, United States, 1977—1986



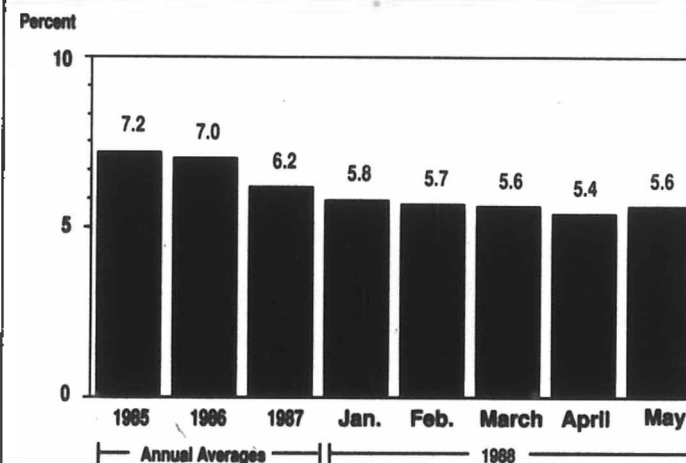

New Housing Units Started, United States, 1965—1985



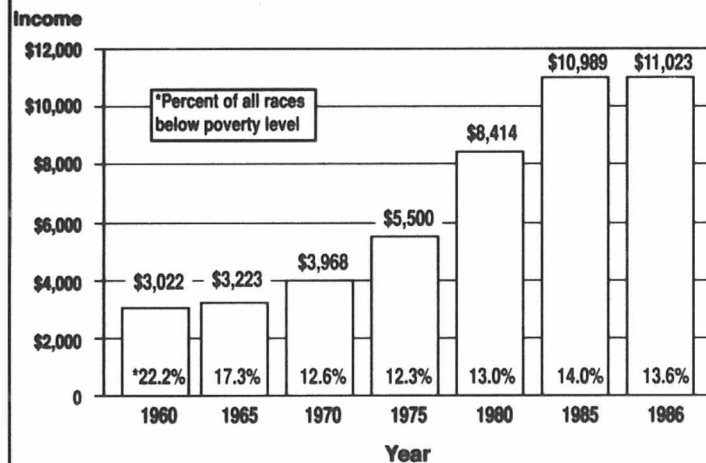

Average Income for Nonfarm Family of Four at Poverty Level. U.S., 1960-1986



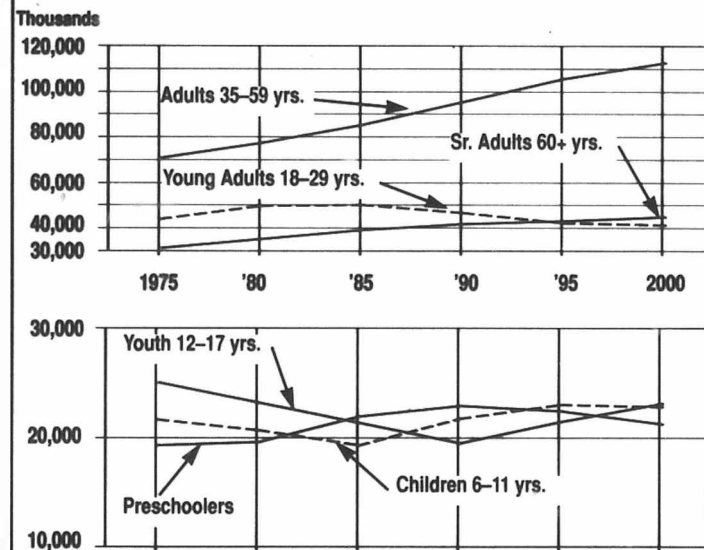

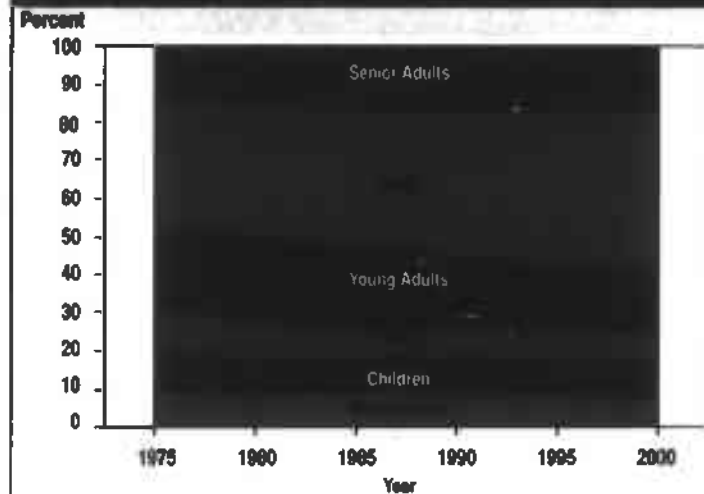

Population of the United States, 1975-1985, and Projections for 1990-2000, by Age Group

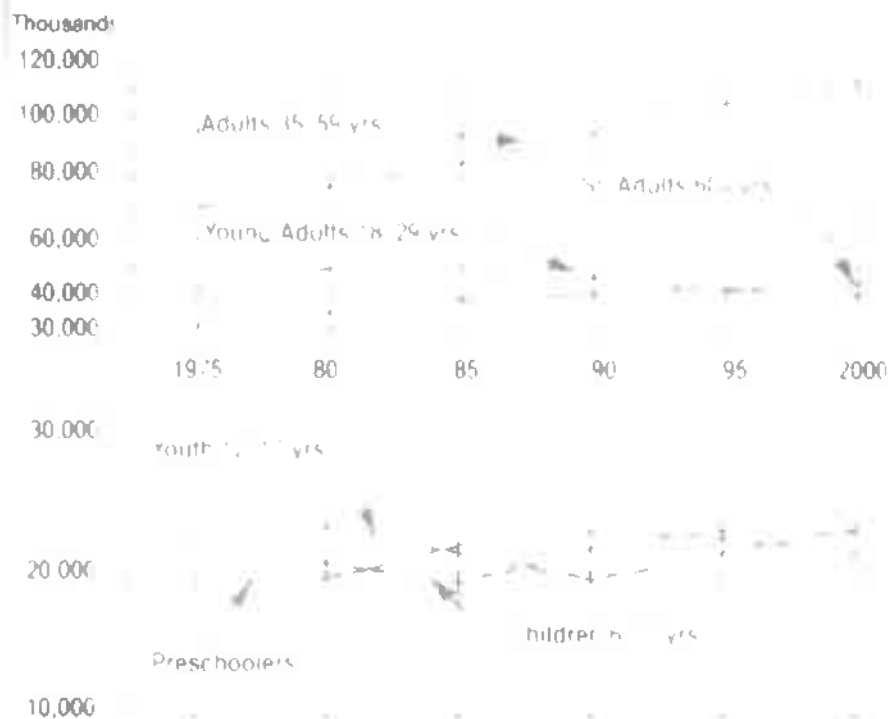


Percent Distribution by Age Group

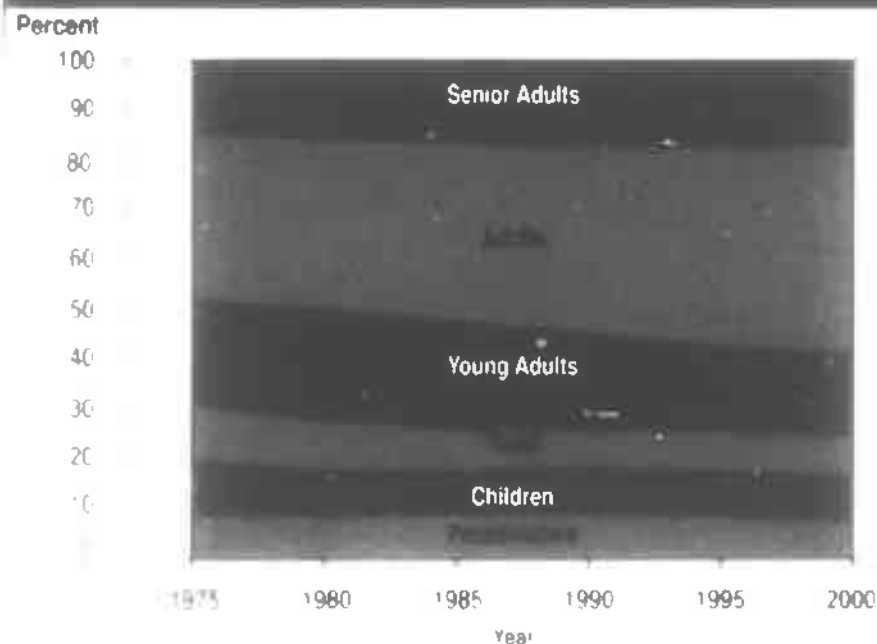

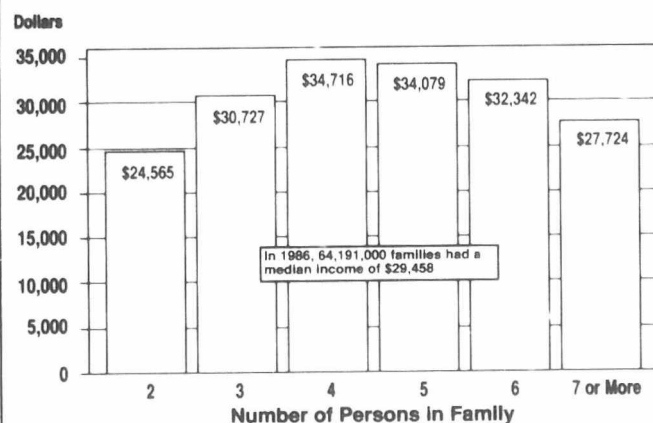
Population of the United States, 1975–1985, and Projections for 1990–2000, by Age Group



Percent Distribution by Age Group

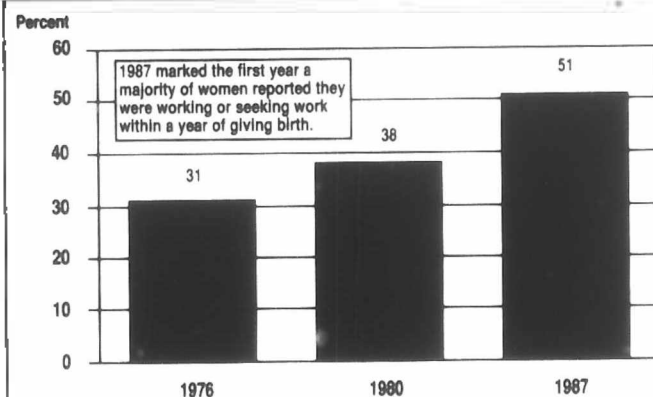


Median Income by Size of Family. United States, 1986



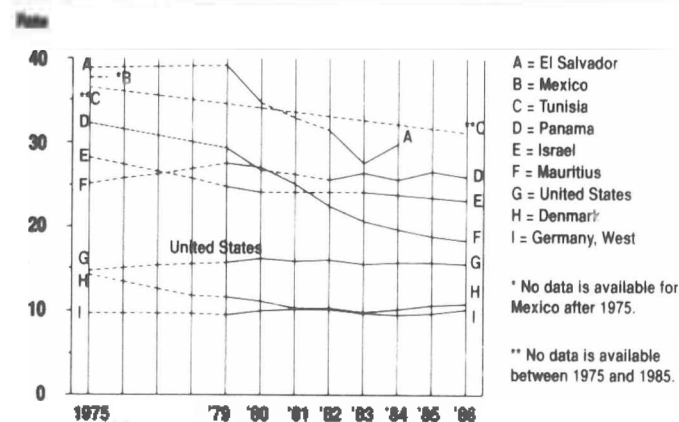

Women Returning to Work Within One Year of Childbirth. United States. 1976, 1980, 1987



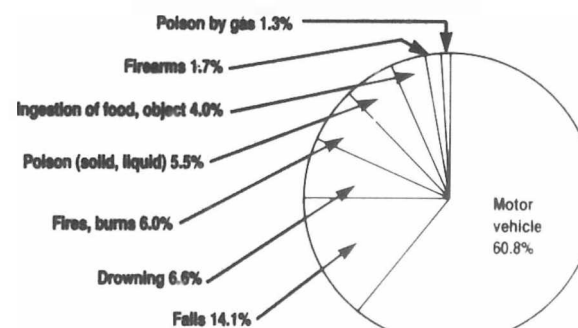

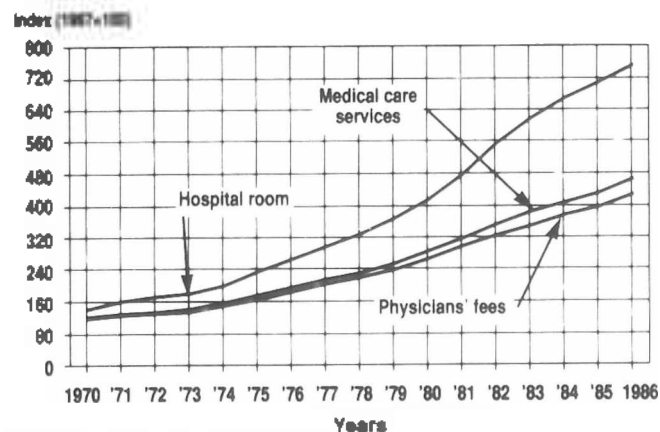
Distribution of Principal Types of Accidental Deaths. U.S., 1987



Principal types of accidents accounted for 80,100 deaths in 1987.

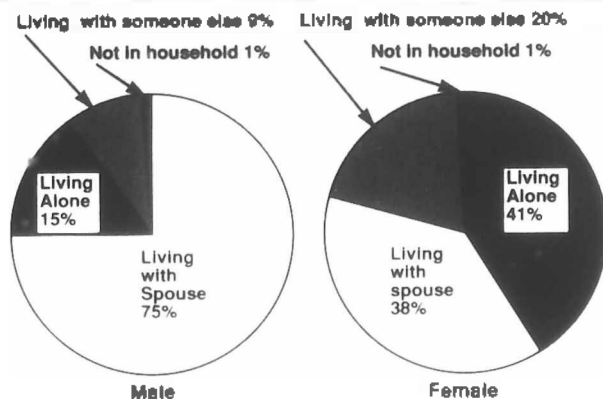

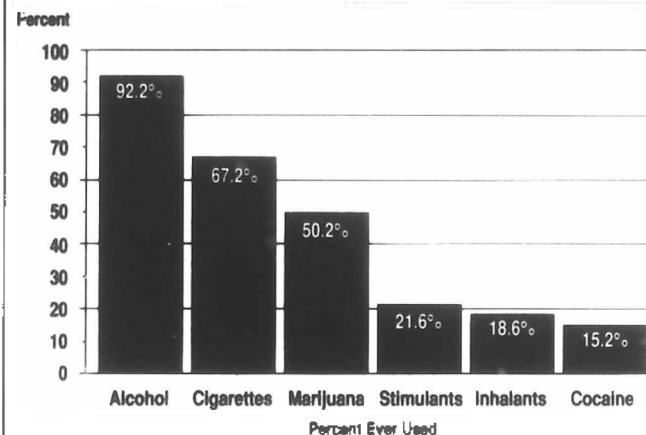

Drug Usage—America's High School Class of 1987

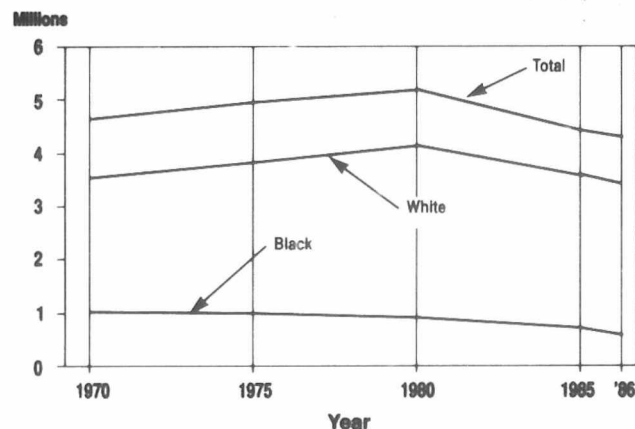

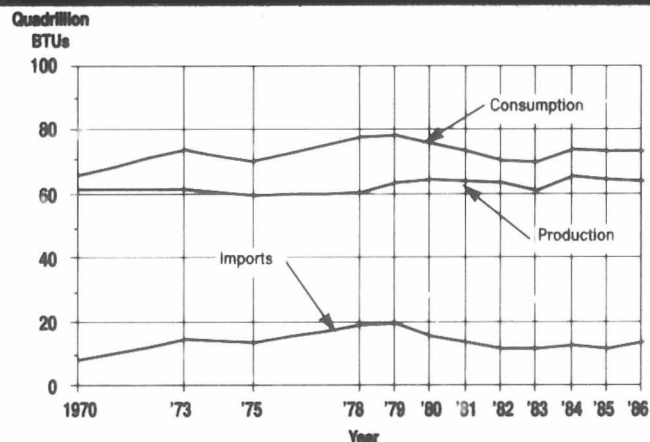
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High School Dropouts, U.S., 1970 — 1986

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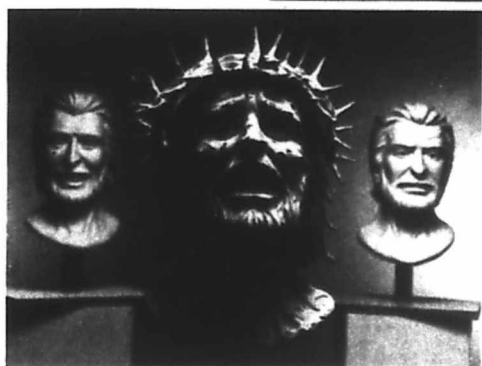
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
