J. B. JERRE'S LETTER.

Massachusetts. In your issue of Sept. 4th, in a note, appeared an article from the pen of President Crawford, the following passage occurs:

"We do not believe that the Foreign Board has any right to call upon the missionaries that they should go to China or Africa, to take a journey to Richmond, to be examined into their experience, call to the ministry, and send them on their way. It is a high-handed act, and degrades both the judgment and authority of the Church and presbytery that ordained him, and practically declares itself above both. Nor do we believe the Board has any more authority over the missionaries to send them to any place, or to dictate to them in their work, or how to do it, than has Bro. M. Smith, the Financial Agent in Boston."

Before I notice this extract, I wish to make a few remarks concerning the main points in Bro. Crawford's article. The subject of the Foreign Board, as we have seen, comes before the Foreign Mission Board. We have heard it repeatedly, and it has never been presented to us as a practical question. I have myself no objection to the subject discussed by Bro. C, not having given to it the careful investigation which I justify the formation of an opinion upon it. I have no knowledge of the views of the members of the Board, touching this matter; but I presume their minds are in the same direction as my own.

As it regards the plan of conducting missions, much may be said. Every true friend of the cause desires that the simplest, cheapest and most efficient method should be adopted; but I do not feel that it is for our common good to see defects in existing plans, then to devise new ones, and then to attempt to carry them out. When they undertake the task of arranging the details of a foreign mission they will find many perplexities of which they have never thought. I cannot see how it is possible to see defects in existing plans, and not formally to act on them, and may not be entirely correct.
