Two weeks since we referred to the appointment of a committee to draft a plan for organizing the churches as auxiliaries to the State Mission Board. The following is the report of that committee.

TO THE PRESIDENT AND MEMBERS OF THE STATE MISSION BOARD OF THE GENERAL ASSOCIATION OF TENNESSEE AND NORTH ALABAMA:

DEAR BROTHERS: At the last regular meeting of your Board, it was your pleasure to appoint a committee consisting of Geo. C. Connor, A. C. Dayton and H. O. Sowell, to draft a plan by which the churches of Tennessee and North Alabama should be organized as auxiliaries to the State Mission Board. We have the honor to report to you the result of our labors.

RECOMMENDATIONS.

1. That each church within the influence of your Board, be asked to organize itself as a church auxiliary to the State Mission Board, for the purpose of raising funds to support the preaching of the Gospel in the State.
2. That a corresponding Secretary be appointed by you, to carry on the necessary correspondence with the pastors of the different churches, in reference to the organization of church auxiliaries.
3. That the necessary funds be raised by the churches, and the same be forwarded to the State Mission Board, for the purpose of supporting the preaching of the Gospel in the State.
