## This Generation Is Like

Matthew 11:16-19.

"But whereunto shall I liken this generation?"—Matthew 11:16a.

Jesus characterized his generation as one that was insensitive to the activity of God in human history. The people wrote John the Baptist off as a madman (Matt. 11:18). In similar fashion they pigeon-holed Jesus as a libertine—"a man gluttonous, and a winebibber, a friend of publicans and sinners" (Matt. 11:19). Rather than confront the demands of God uttered by John and by Jesus, the people remained unresponsive, insensitive, adamant in their own notions of what constituted a right relationship to God.

What is this generation like? Do we who live in the seventh decade of the twentieth century deserve the indictment which Jesus heaped upon his contemporaries? Are we not likewise spiritually deaf to the word which the Lord articulates in the present train of historical events?

The battle is half won if our answer to these questions is an unequivocal YES! But this is our dilemma. "We grope for the wall like the blind, and we grope as if we had no eyes: we stumble at noon day as in the night; we are in desolate places as dead men" (Isa. 59:10). *All this we are like, and we do not know it!* We are insensitive to our insensitivity. We are unresponsive to our lack of genuine responsiveness. We are unconcerned about our unconcern.

Is God dead? Has He ceased speaking to us? "Blasphemy," we piously retort, "to even think such a thing!" And yet, practically speaking, ours is the generation of distraction. We no longer wonder at that which is wonderful, no longer weep over that which is heart-rending, no longer

Townley Lord, Former  
BWA President, Dies

GREENVILLE, S. C. (BP)—F. Townley Lord, president of the Baptist World Alliance 1950-55, died here February 9. He was 68.

Lord had served since 1958 as visiting lecturer at Furman University, a Baptist institution. He came to Furman following retirement from the pastorate of Bloomsbury Central Baptist Church in London, where he served 28 years.

Funeral services were held at First Baptist Church here February 16, with Dotson M. Nelson, former pastor, in charge.

Lord was editor of the Baptist Times, Journal of the Baptist denomination in Great Britain and Ireland, 1941-56. He also served as president of the Baptist Union of Great Britain and Ireland and as president of the British Sunday School Union.

He was elected president of the Baptist

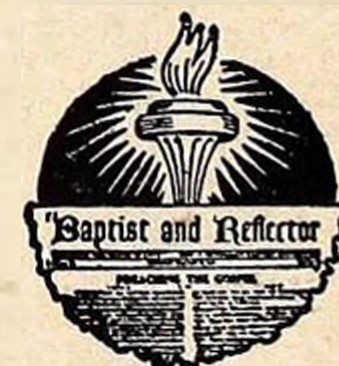
World Alliance at its meeting in Cleveland in 1950, succeeding C. Oscar Johnson of St. Louis. He saw the Baptist population of the world increase from 17 million to more than 20 million before turning the gavel over to Theodore F. Adams of Richmond, Va., at the Jubilee Baptist Congress in London in 1955.

Lord was the author of several books, including "Baptist World Fellowship," A short history of the Baptist World Alliance.

He is survived by Mrs. Lord, Greenville, and two children, Marcus Townley Lord and Mrs. R. S. George, both of London.

MEMPHIS—Ground was broken for the new addition to Calvary church's educational plant located at 136 Lamar. The building is expected to cost approximately \$150,000 and will join the church sanctuary and educational building. It will provide for 490 increasing the educational space to 800.

This addition will be called the J. G. Lott Memorial as a loving tribute to Calvary's beloved pastor emeritus, Rev. J. G. Lott, who served the church faithfully for 35 years as pastor. It will house the Adult, Junior and Beginner Departments along with modern Nursery facilities and the church offices.

The building program recently included the complete renovation of the sanctuary. At that time the decor of the church was changed to colonial and the seating capacity increased to 500.

# Editorials

## Looking At The News

Atheistic propaganda isn't doing all it might as presently conducted in the Soviet Union according to a *Religious News Release*. A revival of the pre-war Militant Atheist League is now being urged. Despite the fact enrollments in theological schools have dropped from 15 to 20 per cent in Russia, even many non-religious families are turning to the churches for religious rites and the new Soviet "rites" including non-religious name giving ceremonies, youth dedication rituals, and non-religious weddings have failed to reduce the number of religious christenings. This is the complaint of a leading member of the Society for the Propagation of Scientific and Cultural Knowledge. He calls for the publication of more atheistic material in Soviet newspapers. This communist also denounced what he called the "bad example" given by "fanatical Baptists" who recently distributed leaflets in Leningrad until they were brought to trial. Baptists in Russia have been jailed for proselytizing.

## Christ And Color

The rising tide of color and intense nationalism are evident in a statement by the Kenya nationalist leader calling the Bible "anti-Negro". Jomo Kenyatta at a public rally in Taveta, Kenya near the Tanganyika border charged that parts of the Bible and many illustrations in religious books are "anti-Negro." "When our party comes into power in Kenya," he said, "we shall re-write these Christian falsehoods." This nationalist leader who was imprisoned as the top Mau Mau commander in the British colony took offense at pictures in the Bible which he said always painted the angels white, while the devil is always black with horns and tail.

Perhaps this is another illustration of the fact that religious art giving an imaginary picturization of spiritual reality is fraught with great danger. A white person is shocked when he sees a picture of the so called "holy family" in which Joseph, Mary, and the Christ child are pictured as Negroes. We should be careful to present the truths of the Bible without any addition on our part either pictorial or verbal which mars or distorts. Christ is the Saviour of all men no matter their race. He is neither anti-Negro nor anti-white. He is *not* the white man's Saviour. He is *not* the Negro's Saviour. He is the Son of Man and the Saviour of *all* who will in humility receive him as the Son of God.

## Growing Interest In The Bible

Resulting from the questions asked by laymen, "what they could do to help Christian unity," one Roman Catholic editor recently said, "We can help in the distribution of the Bible." Writing in the national Catholic weekly, *America*, Father Walter M. Abott said "It has impressed Protestants that there is a wide and growing interest in the Bible among Catholics," and "it will impress them even more if we prove our love of the Bible" by joining Protestants in distributing it. This Catholic editor did not think his recommendation a "fanciful one." He said, "It is perfectly possible within the laws of the Church, provided, in accordance with the decrees of the holy office, the local bishop approves."

We believe it is a commendable work to distribute the Bible. We accept it as the Word of God. We believe that in the Bible there is the basis of Christian unity as the Bible is interpreted through the illumination of the Holy Spirit.

# The Clean Life

**TEXTS:** Exodus 20:14; Matthew 5:27-30; Mark 7:14-23 (Larger and Printed)—Proverbs 4:23 (Golden).

Our Golden Text comes from the inspired pen of the Wise Man of antiquity. His use of the word "heart", as well as other uses found in the Bible, comes close to our use of it today when we say one gives his heart to a cause or to a person. Devotion and loyalty are involved. Indeed they become central. We do well, in this connotation, to think of the heart as the very center and citadel of one's being. And this has special significance when considering the above topic.

A study of individuals, of groups and even nations, furnishes a sober word of warning in this all-important matter of sex (for this is the emphasis of this lesson). For it has been found that when individuals become careless, even cynically indifferent to Biblical teachings in this regard, disaster and defeat become inevitable. A person, or a group, weak and rotten at this point soon deteriorates to weakness and rottenness at other points. Space limitations do not permit specific citations, but the reader of these notes can readily supply them.

## Revere the Source (Ex. 20:14)

The source of human life is of course God. He has created and designated sex as the agency or channel for its propagation. The mutual love of one man and one woman lies at the foundation of its sanctity. This was His plan in the very beginning of the existence of the human race on the earth. Those who seek to pervert reliable scientific data so as to rationalize and cover sinning just here are in serious error. It is perfectly proper to know Freud, for instance, for sound guidance; without forgetting Moses. The Seventh Commandment stands, and has stood, far longer than has some of the pseudo teachings of men like Sigmund Freud. To revere the source of human life is to respect and honor all of its human channels. The same One who said, "Thou shalt not kill" also said, "Thou shalt not commit adultery".

## Rule the Self (Mt. 5:27-30)

Jesus formulates His teaching in these verses in very striking language. After He has said that the lustful eye is sinful in God's sight, He goes on to say how one must subdue his passions and make them servants instead of allowing them to become his masters. Of course He does not mean that one should actually pluck out an eye or cut off a hand as a means of not committing sin. Rather He is teaching that one must be in absolute control of all of his appetites, with

particular emphasis here upon that of sex. There are some scenes one should refuse to see. David, for instance, would have been far better off if he had not been looking in the wrong direction on a certain evening. Little children today sing a little song that carries this idea in: "Little feet, be careful where you take me to". Sex has been given by God. It is intended for high and holy purposes. It is physical but it is also far more, when seen through the pages of the Bible. An appetite that has been given by the Lord can never be thought of as evil within itself. The evil emerges when its satisfaction is sought by methods outside of the teachings of Jesus Christ.

## Renew the Spirit (Mk. 7:14-23)

Our Lord here gives a shortened parable which He later interpreted for them as the little group entered the house which was close by. He begins by reminding them, and us, that sanitation is not enough for one's well-being. The serious defiling takes place, He says, not by what enters the body but by what comes out of it. The only way to avoid this real and eternal harm is to see to it that the heart of a man is made and kept pure. He mentions adultery here but He also mentions murder, stealing, covetousness as well as other evils. He begins the list with "evil thoughts". The human spirit, when brought into contact and kept so with the Holy Spirit, must be so renewed that such evil thoughts are overcome and thus the other evils will not emerge from one's inner being. The teachings of Jesus, when grasped at least in part and conscientiously applied, contain the essence of purity in matters of sex as well as in other regards. And this, it would seem, is being seen by more and more people at present.

## BAPTIST BELIEFS

### Angels

Some people insist that belief in angels is merely a residue from heathen and primitive beliefs, since such beliefs were held by all ancient peoples. But universality of belief does not mean a false concept. We cannot assume that God did not create other intelligent beings besides man.

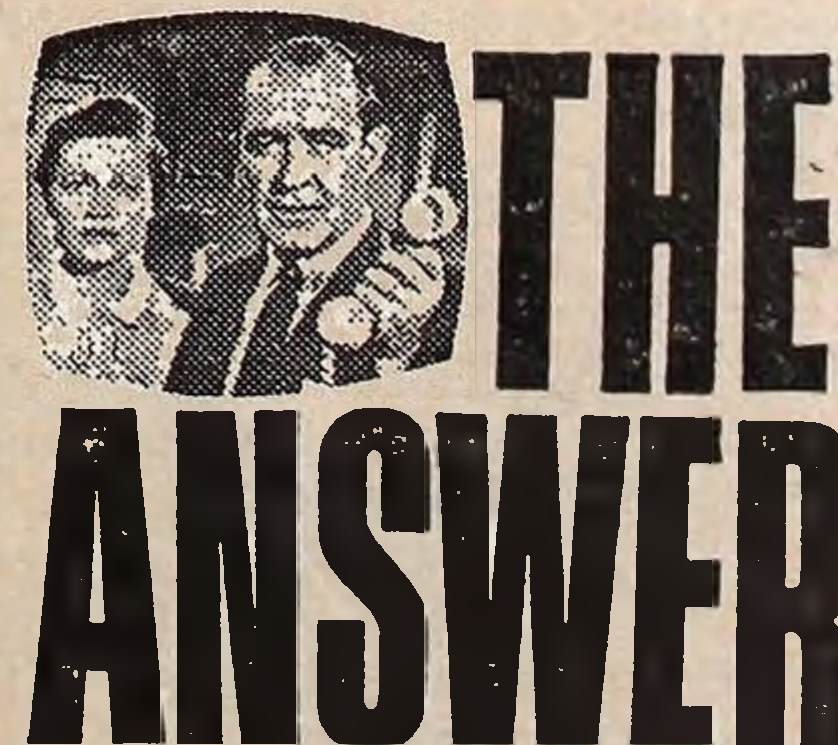
The Bible clearly teaches the existence of angels as created beings (Ps. 148:2-5). In the Bible angels appear in human form (Gen. 18:2; 19:13), but in other ways also (Matt. 1:20; Luke 2:13; I Cor. 6:3). The word "angel" (Hebrew, *malak*; Greek, *angelos*) means "messenger." Angels are God's messengers to do His work and will (Heb. 1:14). The "Angel of the Covenant" or "Angel of the Lord" is usually identified with God or the Second Person of the Trinity (Gen. 31:13; 32:30; Judges 2:1-5; 6:11).

The "angels of the seven churches" of Asia Minor are usually regarded as their pastors (Rev. 1:20). Jesus speaks of the angels of little children, or those who believe on Him, as being before the Father in heaven (Matt. 18:10). Are these guardian angels?

The Bible forbids the worshipping of angels (Col. 2:18). Instead it teaches that the saints shall judge the angels (I Cor. 6:3).

The Bible speaks of fallen angels. Angels were created as holy beings, since a holy God could create no other. But Jude speaks of "angels which kept not their first estate"

(v. 6). Peter refers to "angels that sinned" and were cast down to hell, bound in "chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment" (II Pet. 2:4). Pride seems to be the cause of their fall (I Tim. 3:6). The arch-fallen-angel is Satan. With the fallen angels he shall be cast into the lake of fire (Matt. 25:41). All lost sinners as children of their father, the devil, will be cast into the lake of fire prepared for the devil and his angels (Matt. 25:41).

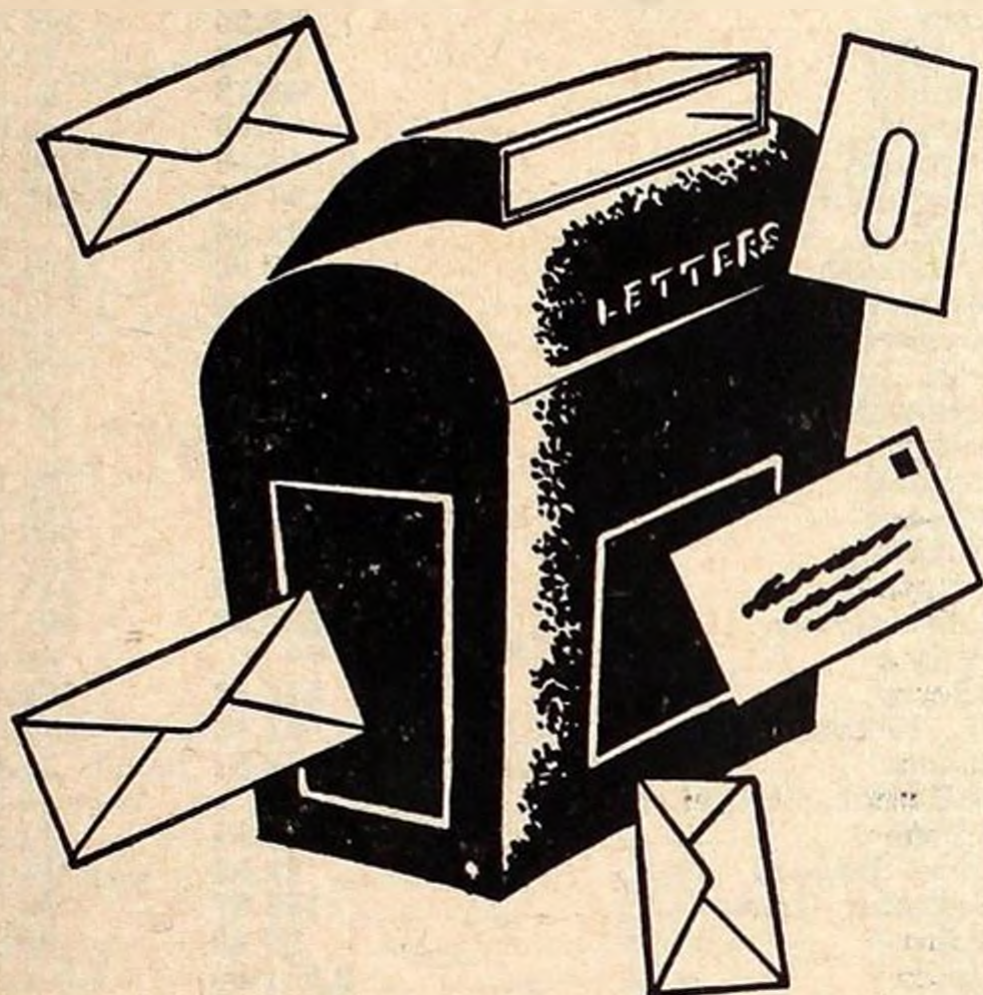
Mrs. Lake Pylant, secretary of the Church Recreation Service, directed the annual meeting in Nashville recently.

## Children's Page

### When Washington Sent a Letter\*

When you want to send a letter to someone, you write the address on the envelope and put a stamp on it. Then you give it to the postman, put it into a mailbox, or take it to the post office. What did George Washington do when he wanted to send one?

When Washington was a boy, he lived on farms on the Potomac River and near Fredericksburg, Virginia. No mailboxes were on street corners or along country roads. In fact, there were few roads. Probably there was not even a post office in the village of Fredericksburg. There were only seventy-five post offices in all the thirteen states when Washington became President fifty years later.

There were no stamps or even envelopes. The sheets of paper on which the letter was written were folded, sealed, and addressed on the outside. They were sent by special messenger or taken to one of the few post offices.

If Washington wanted to send a message to some of his friends or relatives, it might have been just as easy to visit the people himself. More likely he asked someone who was going that way to deliver the message.

When he grew older, many times he carried important letters, sometimes to and from the royal governor of Virginia. In 1753, when he was only twenty-one years old, he was sent by Governor Dinwiddie as a special messenger to warn the French not to come any farther into British territory.

In the same year, Benjamin Franklin of Philadelphia was appointed deputy postmaster general for the British colonies in North America. He held this position twenty-one years and in 1775 was appointed postmaster general by the Continental Congress.

During this time mail was carried from New York to Philadelphia three times a week in summer and once a week in winter. Your letters now travel by car, truck, train, ship, or plane. In Washington's day mail was carried by horseback riders, in horse-drawn vehicles or on ships or boats.

Charges for delivering letters were set up by the Continental Congress in pennyweights or grains of silver. A pennyweight was five-ninetieths of a dollar. Sending a letter less than sixty miles cost one pennyweight and eight grains if the letter was written on only one sheet of paper. If there were two sheets, the cost was doubled. For three sheets, it was tripled.

If the letter was to go more than sixty but not more than one hundred miles, the charge was two pennyweights for a single sheet. Between one hundred and two hundred miles, it was two pennyweights and sixteen grains. An additional sixteen grains was added for each hundred miles after that. Postriders (mail carriers on horseback) could be licensed by the postmaster general to carry newspapers for a fee.

The Continental Congress provided that the commander in chief of the armed forces and certain officers of the government could have their mail carried without charge. Washington probably did not have to pay any postage after he was appointed to command the American Army, at least until the

## Medical Missionary Dies Enroute To Liberia

WASHINGTON — (BWA) — Carl A. Frode, a member of the volunteer Christian medical mission enroute to Liberia, died of a heart attack aboard ship February 5, Robert S. Denny associate secretary of the Baptist World Alliance, reported here.

Denny said that word was relayed to him by Mrs. Robert A. Hingson, wife of the Cleveland Baptist deacon who heads the staff of 27 physicians and technicians who volunteered to spend two months in Liberia treating prevalent diseases in the West African nation.

The mission is known as "Operation; Brother's Brother II", named for the round-the-world medical mission sponsored by the Baptist World Alliance in 1958.

Frode, of Cleveland, was a representative of the Eli Lilly Co. which donated much of the \$2 million in drugs scheduled for use in Liberia.

Dr. Hingson reported that Dr. Frode's death came suddenly, despite the services of four physicians traveling with him. The body was carried on to Monrovia, where the ship, the USS Diamondhead, was expected to dock Sunday, February 11. The ship sailed from Norfolk, Va., on January 31.

The body was returned to Cleveland for burial.

## Are You Labeled?

Labels have a strange and fascinating place in our society. A label is placed upon every item. Babies, when born are immediately labeled by the beaded name on their wrist. Footprints and handprints are made. Surnames and given names are registered. These labels leave no doubt as to the identity of the bearer.

When I was eight years old, my mother wanted to send me by train from Sevierville to Corryton, a distance of about fifty miles. It was necessary to change trains in Knoxville. In order to accomplish this, I was labeled with a large tag which stated my name and destination. Because of this label, I was put off the train safely in the arms of my grandfather.

The identification of a young child usually depends on the labels which the parents wear. But soon young adulthood is reached and our own distinction is accomplished.

Our reputation is our label which soon overbalances all else.

The training of a child has much to do with spiritual labeling. The Holy Spirit convicts and we accept or reject the label of Christ. It was my privilege to have this understanding early, at the age of twelve.

Once the Christian's label is accepted, it should be worn with pride. Christ will inspire the label of a smiling face and a useful life. We are further labeled as Christian parents, and my husband bears the label of minister of the Gospel and pastor.

Our Christian duty demands that we wear the label of soul winner. It is a joy to lead people to say yes to the Lord and to turn from the label of sinner to Christian.

The drunkard exchanges the label of a bleary eye, and red nose to that of sober Christian. The woman who wore the label of resentment toward God for the death of a beloved infant, now sees God's plan in helping achieve the label of trusting Christian.

The murderer, having paid his debt to society, exchanges his numerical label for a spiritual one.

Our Saviour was given a label, "The King of the Jews", which He wore proudly. He gave His life for us that we may wear the label of Christian.

Are You Labeled?

If you have not exchanged the label of sinner for that of Christian, please do so today.

Ramsey Pollard of Memphis, immediate past president Southern Baptist Convention, said, "One of the great problems of our day is the sin of neutrality."

He declared religious liberty "is the foundation of all other liberties in the world" and a greater number of citizens must be enlisted if it is to be preserved.

Walter Pope Binns, president, William Jewell College (Baptist), Liberty, Mo., reminded those attending this two-day conference that "Whenever the state has claimed to be above the church or the church has claimed to be above the state, people have suffered. There has been a loss of freedom."

Louie D. Newton, Atlanta, former president, SBC, and president of this church-state group, was honored at a closing rally. Glenn L. Archer, Washington, executive

director of the agency, paid tribute to Newton as "one of the great statesmen of our time, who stands firm against all who would break down the wall separating church and state."

Archer, in a closing address, described America as the last bastion of full religious freedom left. He said it will be preserved only if "every thoughtful and freedom-loving American unites to keep religion pure from man's selfishness." He denied his organization exists to fight Roman Catholicism but said when a church enters the political arena, "It is difficult to deal with the political issue without seeming to scuff the church."

C. Stanley Lowell, Washington, associate director of the agency, declared, "Protestants have closed ranks on the issue of federal aid to church schools as I have never seen them on any other issue in my time."

He predicted advocates of tax funds for public schools would suffer a greater defeat in the current session of congress than they did last year.

James M. Windham, who resigned pastorate of First Baptist Church, Maryville, Tenn., to become Chicago regional director for the group, attacked the proposed transfer of a 79 acre tract of federal property. It would go to Loyola University (Roman Catholic) near Chicago as equivalent federal gift of \$2 million.

"Substance for such political charity is extracted from purses of all citizens," he said.
